


F. Fox.

This strange, long-necked animal comes from Africa.



The Horse can truly be called the friend of man. He works for him in many ways at all seasons of the year.


The Hippopotamus lives by the banks of the rivers in the hot parts of Africa. It spends most of its time in the water.

The Ice Bear or Polar Bear is found in the cold North, amidst the frozen seas.




The Ibex is an animal of the Alps.


L. Lion — Leopard.

the King of Beasts,


he belongs to the Cat




M. Moose.



The Pig is kept on all farms and by many cottagers.




Q. Quail.

This is a brown bird, and very good to eat. There are plenty of Quails in Egypt and the East.



Sheep give us wool, and mutton; their skin makes excellent leather, and their fat is turned into tallow.




The Squirrel is a pretty little creature that lives among the trees. It builds a nest, and collects a store of nuts for the winter.

V. Vole.


Voles of different kinds are known all over the world.

W. Wolf.




The Wolf is a native of most countries. It is very like a large dog but it is a savage animal particularly when it hunts in packs. It will then attack anything.




Weasel.

The Xema is a sea bird, and you can see that it can swim because of its webbed feet. It lives in the cold region of the frozen seas.



a very useful animal to the people of that country for it is to them what our oxen are to us. I really do not know what we should do without the Ox and the Cow.


