THE illuminating power of the Art Garland is one of its main features of beauty, and so greatly in excess of that attempted by other manufacturers that no comparison can be drawn.

We have utilized the bottom flues to give greater radiating surface than has ever yet been attempted.


The cold air is admitted to the stove through the opening in the base at the front, the supply being regulated by the indicator shewn upon the ash door. By this means PERFECT VENTILATION is secured, and the air so used is made to pass through the fire the same as air which is usually introduced through the draft slide.

The entire back of these stoves is utilized as a hot air chamber, the cold air entering at the base of the stove being discharged highly heated through openings on a level with the pipe collar, adding greatly to the heating capacity of each stove.

This forms, with our double heating attachment, the best, most perfect and scientific double heating arrangement yet produced.

The fire pot can be taken out through the front mica doors. Above the mica section are three reflectors, which cast a blaze of light from the entire top of the stove.
