How to Order. Please do not cut this catalogue. Simply state the catalogue number of the article wanted. Give full name, stating whether Mr., Mrs. or Miss, (with Mrs. always use husband's initials) and post office. Be accurate and write distinctly and we can assure you a prompt and satisfactory service.

Terms. The prices quoted are net cash, and money must accompany the order, unless you already have a satisfactory monthly account with us.

Agents. We have no agents. All prices quoted are absolutely and positively net, no discounts being allowed even to those in Kindred lines of trade.

Remittances. Remittances may be sent by express, post office order, postal note, bank draft or cash. If in cash, however, we cannot assume responsibility unless sent by registered mail.

Delivery. We prepay all charges for delivery upon orders of one dollar and upwards. Upon orders of less than one dollar, postage must be added to the prices quoted. If articles are to be mailed to foreign countries add 25c. for extra postage charges. If charges for delivery are ever demanded by the transportation companies we will consider it a favor if our patrons will at once advise us of the fact in order that we may reimburse them and make a claim for the amount unjustly collected.

Refunds. We cheerfully refund money upon the return of goods should they not meet with approval; when manufactured to special order or engraved with initials, however, we do not undertake to make such refund.

How to Send the Finger Size of a Ring. Full instructions for giving the proper finger size when ordering rings will be found upon page 9 of this catalogue.

Engraving. We do all ordinary engraving of initials free; also monograms on watches, charging only for inscriptions, special work and monograms other than on watches. Where extra lettering is required, a charge of 3 cents per letter must be added. During the Christmas rush we endeavor to fill all engraving orders promptly, and advise the placing of orders early, as between the 15th and 25th December we cannot undertake to do any engraving.
