We buy direct from the manufacturers in large quantities and sell direct to all consumers, having only the legitimate cost of handling added.

## In Reference to Consignments.

The produce consigned to us during the past season is about double of what it has been previously. We are always ready to receive produce from any farmer, and will remit promptly when sold. Our city trade has so increased that we want all the good butter, fresh eggs, poultry, pork, etc., that you can send us. Butter is best in tubs or rolls, but do not work tub butter into rolls. Always send eggs in cases; never pack in boxes with chaff, they do not carry safely. Do not feed fowls for 24 hours before killing. Do not scald or draw them, leave the head and feet on, and do not pack until the animal heat is out of them. Have everything in as good shape as possible, and we will get you the best market price. If you have not dealt with us send us a small consignment as a trial, remembering the larger the consignment the less the express or freight in proportion. When shipping send us a card with your address and what you are sending. Put your name on box also.

## TO THE MANITOBA AND N. W. PATRONS.

In the future, as in the past, we will always be glad to receive your esteemed orders, and we shall do our best to fill them satisfactorily to you. Club together and make your orders as large as possible. But we will not refuse an order from an isolated farmer. The cash will have to accompany all orders from strangers. We will allow you 3 per cent. off our list prices on all orders of \$10 and over in lieu of freight, except in goods marked F. O. B. We would call your special attention to our sewing machines and harness; there is a big saving by buying these from us.

Wheat is so very low that we cannot hold out much inducement to have you consign any cars to us. But should any of our customers wish to send to us, we can get you the highest market price, and will be glad to do so.

In sending us grain consign all cars to the Grange Wholesale Co. (Ltd.), Toronto, to hold at North Bay for further orders, and send sample out of car and freight bill direct to us, and on receipt, if required, we will remit you one half value for car, and balance as soon as we get returns. Our commission is one cent per bushel.

## TO OUR CITY CUSTOMERS.

We will be pleased to sell you any goods quoted in the Catalogue, but we would especially draw your attention to the fact that we can supply you with choice Butter, Eggs and Poultry in season, as we have them consigned regularly to us from farmers, and you can rely on them being fresh and good.

We deliver goods free through the city every day, and to outside points, such as Deer Park, we deliver twice a week. Deer Park every Tuesday and Friday, leaving at 10 a.m. Western limits of the city every Wednesday and Friday, leaving at 3 p.m. Little York and other outside points, whenever the orders are large enough to warrant delivery. Letter or Telephone (1126) orders will receive prompt attention.

## In Reference to Freight.

We pay freight on all orders amounting to \$10 or over, as far north as Gravenhurst, east as Kingston, or West as Sarnia, excepting on goods marked F. O. B.

To further points, or to customers taking goods from the store, amounting to \$10 or over, we will allow 3 per cent off in lieu of freight.

## Syrups.

We have a splendid lot of syrups in for the coming season, at prices that cannot be surpassed, quality considered.
