RULES.

1. Games shall consist of fourteen ends.
2. Rules of the O. B. A. shall govern
3. All games must be played as scheduled unless prevented by rain or by matches with other clubs.
4. The rink first named on the schedule shall lead
5. Games shall begin at 4.15 p. m. sharp, but by mutual agreement of opposing skips, any game may be played at 6.30 p. m.
6. If any skip fail to appear on the green together with at least two eligible men at or before 4.30 or 6.45 respectively, the game shall be given to the opposing rink.
7. Skips are expected to play their own men only, but in case of necessity may borrow one man as lead
8. The committee shall post up on the green the names of players who may not be borrowed.
9. Any rink borrowing ineligible players shall lose the game, even if such borrowing be done with the consent of the opposing skip. This rule will be strictly observed.
10. If any rink has only three eligible players on the green, the lead shall then play four bowls, the opposing rink to score one extra point in every four ends or fraction thereof
11. If both opposing rinks have not sufficient men to play, it shall count a loss against both.
12. When ten or more ends have been played, and rain prevents further play, the rink then in the lead shall win. If ten ends have not been played, it shall be treated as a postponed game
13. The committee shall set dates on which postponed games shall be played, and it shall be deemed sufficient notice to have said dates posted up on the green
14. Results of games must be reported to the Secretary by the skips.
15. The President or his deputy shall be umpire at all games.
16. PLAYERS MUST WEAR RUBBER SOLED SHOES WHEN ON THE GREEN WHETHER PLAYING OR NOT. This rule will be strictly enforced.
