Dancing in the air.

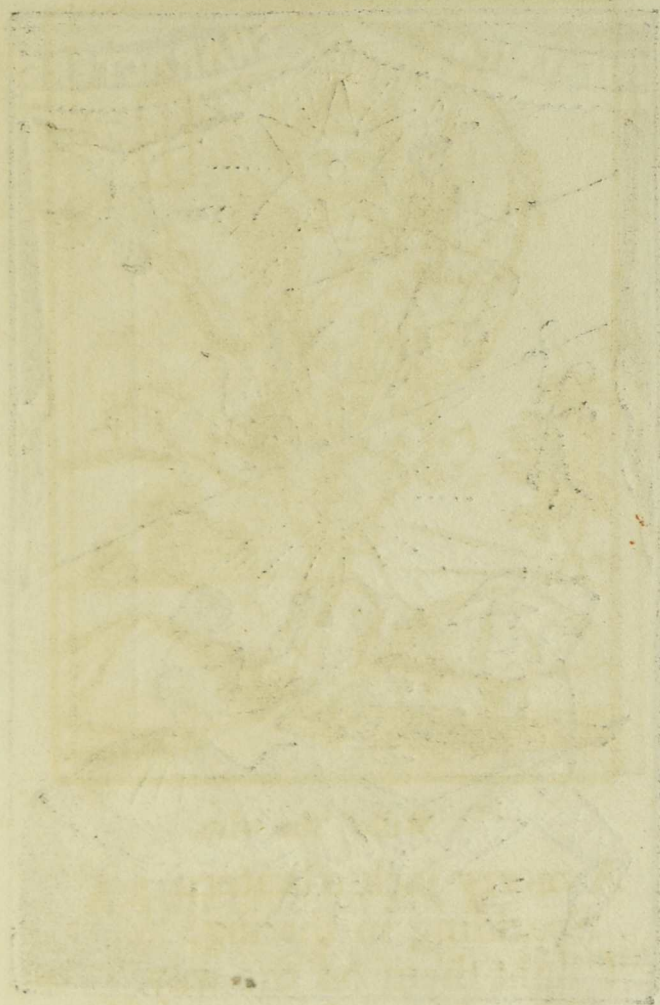


Willo' the wisp.

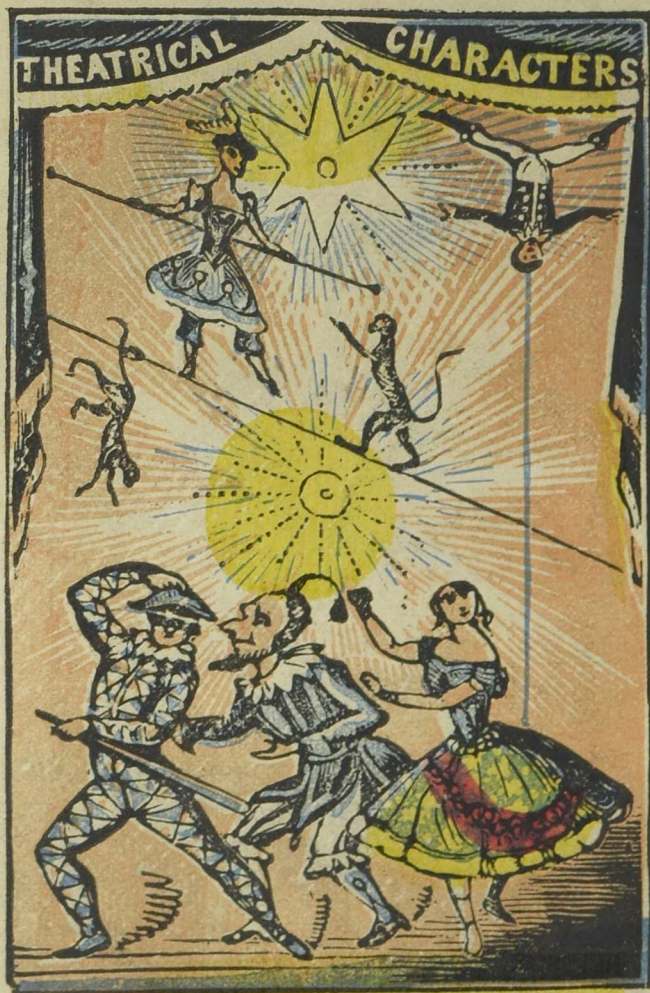
A merry jack o'lantern
