My Cousin.



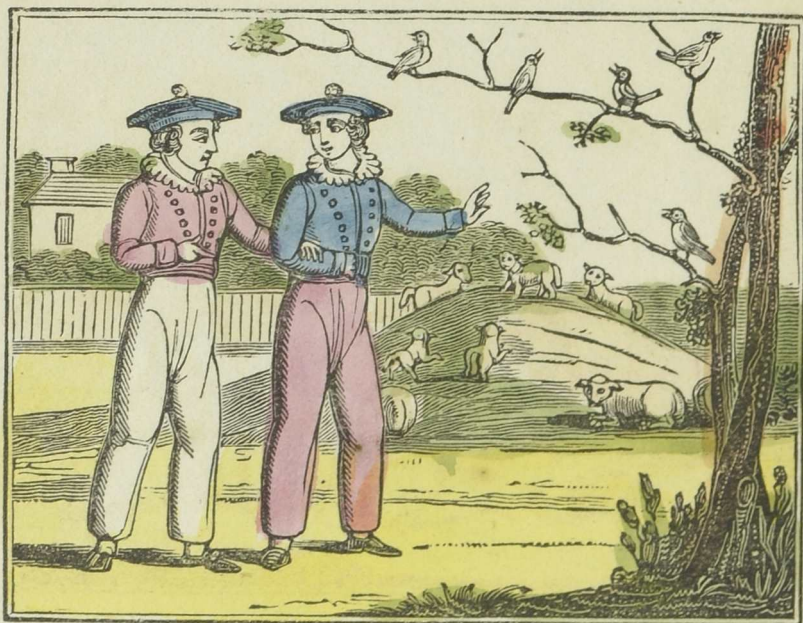
Who helped me o'er the rippling brooks,

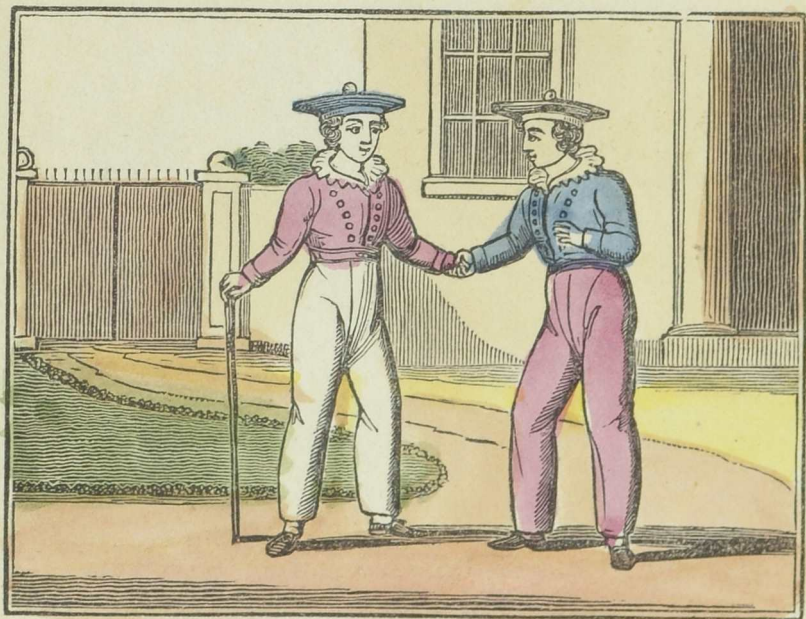
Who took me to the fields so gay,

Of ladies fair and barons bold ?


