*The Chairman, Board of Police Commissioners, Toronto:*

SIR,—I have the honor to tender for your consideration this my Annual Report upon the Police Department of the City of Toronto for 1914, containing the usual statistical information, as per forms appended, also the sub-reports of the Inspectors in charge of the Detective and Staff Departments for the same period.

The number of persons summoned or arrested aggregate a total of 39,816, being 37,085 males, and 2,731 females, representing a gross increase of 162 over last year, which is the smallest for many years.

In 16,152 cases the charge was dismissed or withdrawn.

It will be observed that there is a decrease under the following heads:

The value of property reported lost and stolen is given at \$378,024.73, including 44 automobiles.

The Police recovered \$251,967.77, a lower percentage than in 1913.

#### DETECTIVE DEPARTMENT.

According to the figures given in the following statement there has been a distinct increase in the indictable offences recorded, the net excess over 1913 being 454. Many of these were committed by boys who escaped arrest for a time but eventually fell into the hands of the Police. Juveniles charged with indictable offences were 1,066, as against 564 the previous year. This looks as if the system or method of dealing with children under 16 years of age is not having the effect of checking their thieving propensities as might have been expected.

The crime of adult murder was committed twice, and in both instances the men who did the deed either committed suicide or tried to do so.

Two infants were also done to death, the mother of one subsequently taking her own life. No clue in the other case.

It is somewhat remarkable how many bicycles and other articles found by the Police remain unclaimed. After an interval of not less than six months they are sold and proceeds placed to a special account.

Since the war broke out much attention has been given to enemy aliens, who have all been required to register. Thirty-eight are interned and 2 await trial for treason. A Government Registrar has since been appointed and aliens are now dealt with by him.

I would draw your attention to the number of applications for parole received and reported upon during the year, namely, 164.

I am unable to say how many of these met with favorable consideration, but I do know that in several cases a long criminal record did not entitle the applicant to executive clemency, which, in my judgment, should only be extended to those whose previous career has been reputable.

There is an impression abroad that if sufficient influence can be brought to bear a parole is obtainable irrespective of the merits of the case. This feeling I do not share, but among foreigners it is prevalent, and with some reason.

The hands of the Police would be strengthened if the criminal class understood that if convicted they would have to serve the full measure of the punishment awarded to them by the Courts.

#### STAFF DEPARTMENT.

The officials attached to this Bureau, including the Police Women, had a busy year dealing with the multifarious cases that came within the scope of their duty.

Domestic troubles of various kinds have been looked into, and adjusted to the number of 2,674, and no less a sum than \$14,433.65 passed through this Department in support of the wives and families separated from the bread winners.

Wife desertion is on the increase, and should be punishable with more stringent penalties.

The social evil, in so far as the law can be applied, has received the energetic attention of the Police, and the prosecutions show a marked increase.

The presence of a large number of soldiers in training is taken advantage of by street walkers for solicitation.

Betting off the race tracks is largely confined to handbooks, which are operated with great secrecy, making it difficult to locate the offenders, and catch them in flagrante delicto.

The agents and bookmakers in factories have ceased their activities, but, of course, betting to a limited extent will always go on.

Breaches of the Lord's Day Act are largely confined to trade on Sundays by foreigners who take a chance when they can.

The Liquor Law on the whole is well observed, and the infractions are largely confined among a class of people against whom it is difficult to get evidence.

In the matter of cruelty to animals activity has prevailed, and prosecutions for this offence have been more numerous against transportation companies, country shippers of live stock, and local individuals who have been guilty of ill-treating animals in all sorts of ways.

The Toronto Humane Society is rendering important assistance in this direction.

The Police Women continue to justify their appointment, and as they acquire experience their services become increasingly useful. They have been employed in the supervision of dance halls, and their visitations there have a good moral effect.

Since the war began newsboys have been much more in evidence, some 2,381 licenses having been issued. They are required to conform to the law requiring their regular attendance at school.

#### AMBULANCE SERVICE.

The recommendation made in my last report for a second combination motor ambulance and patrol wagon was carried out.

This service is now being operated almost exclusively without horses.

The public evidently appreciate the advantage of an up-to-date system, judging by the increased patronage given to the police ambulances, which removed 4,345 persons, and received \$139 for doing so.

Ninety-two recruits were trained in rendering "First Aid," and received certificates, bringing the total up to 637. Five lectures were delivered.

The money lying to the credit of the Voluntary Contributions amounts to \$2,573.45.

#### MOUNTED SERVICE.

Was for a time somewhat disorganized, owing to eighteen of the best horses having been handed over to the Military authorities. They have since been replaced, and the service is now normal.

I anticipate a rise in the price of horses suitable for mounted P. C.'s, owing to the number bought for Army remounts, also an increase in the cost of forage.

#### PATROL WAGON AND SIGNAL SERVICE.

The full complement of signal boxes is now in operation, and no further extensions are contemplated at present.

The horse wagons are being displaced by motors with economical results in men, time and money.

The vans used for the conveyance of persons to and from the jail have been discontinued since the second combined motor wagon has taken up the work.

#### GENERAL REMARKS.

The strength of the Force on January 1st, 1915, was 690, as against 626 the same time the year before, the difference being 64. As forty men have

gone on Active Military Service, either as Reservists called to the Colours or otherwise, the actual available gain during the year is only 24, being 50 under the number I mentioned in my last report as necessary to provide adequate Police protection.

Two patrol-sergeants, one detective, and thirty-seven men are seconded while absent on Active Military Service, and it is with satisfaction that I hear several of those have been selected for important positions by reason of their general efficiency.

Owing to the exigencies of the war situation I am not disposed to ask for additions till matters resume their normal state.

Traffic regulation is making progress, and absorbs a lot of men at fixed points.

Motorists keep more within the speed limit than they did.

The outstanding event of the year was the inspection of the Force by H. R. H. the Duke of Connaught, Governor-General of Canada, on May 22nd, when he was graciously pleased to compliment the men on their appearance, training, etc., and expressed his satisfaction at what he had seen and heard.

To train the Force in the use of the rifle a number have been purchased, and during the winter all ranks will have an opportunity of learning the exercises.

At the request of the Medical Health Officer permission to use a room at Nos. 8 and 11 Stations by the nurses has been temporarily granted.

An attempt to get a station at the Island has failed for the time being, owing to Aldermanic opposition.

Street preaching in foreign languages is the cause of unrest in certain down town districts, and an outbreak is only averted by the presence of the Police. It may become necessary to confine street orations to the English language, as the Police do not understand what is said in a foreign tongue.

Some of the chartered clubs havē become little better than places where liquor is sold, and where gambling is indulged in. I have recommended that these places be brought under the City License Law, and there is some reason to believe that this will be done.

Two thousand five hundred and seventy-two houses, temporarily vacant, were under Police supervision, five of which were entered.

The health of the Force on the whole has been good during the past year. The number on the sick list has been less than for several years notwithstanding the increase in the membership of the Force, due, no doubt, in a great measure, to the sanitary conditions of the new stations.

There were no cases of contagious or infectious diseases.

The number of assaults on members of the Force have sensibly diminished of late years, due, no doubt, to the punishment meted out to such offenders, and to the physical appearance of the men.
