FOR THE YEAR 1915.

CHIEF CONSTABLE'S OFFICE,
Toronto, February 22nd, 1916.

The Chairman, Board of Police Commissioners, Toronto:

DEAR SIR,—I have the honor to submit for your consideration, this, my Annual Report upon the Police Department for 1915, also returns containing the usual statistical information covering the same period.

The total number of persons apprehended or summoned was 36,489, namely 33,918 males, and 2,571 females, being a decrease of 3,327, compared with 1914.

In 14,655 cases the charges laid were dismissed or withdrawn.

Property valued at \$291,524.15 including 120 automobiles, was reported lost and stolen.

The Police were instrumental in recovering \$192,120.33, being about 2 per cent. less than for 1914.

DETECTIVE DEPARTMENT.

The influence of war conditions is plainly seen in the decreases noticeable in the usual criminal activities, as shown in the attached summary.

One murder was committed by a woman, who alleged that her victim had attempted indecent liberties with her. The jury acquitted her.

The applications from convicts for parole increased nearly 100. The majority of them had previous records. Some of these men were released in order that they might go to war.

In some cases it was in my opinion very inadvisable that the convicts should have been admitted to parole without reference to the Police Department, who were familiar with their records, which they would gladly have furnished for consideration, had they been asked to do so.

The Detective Staff has been doing very good work in connection with Aliens of enemy nationality, who are now dealt with by the Chief Constable, as Registrar for this District.

I transmit herewith the report from Inspector of Detectives Kenneay, which summarizes briefly the work done under his immediate supervision, and I invite your attention to the recommendations made.

STAFF DEPARTMENT.

Reports from this Bureau indicate that the work done has been more or less of the ordinary character and volume.

Family and domestic troubles numbering 2,303 received careful and discrete handling to bring about satisfactory results, which were obtained in most cases.

\$10,700 were received and disbursed to deserted wives, et al.

Houses of ill-fame and frequenters thereof have received close attention, the law being applied when a conviction was probable. While Toronto is a garrison town, immorality of this kind is not likely to decrease.

The allegations made in some quarters that the Police were inclined to be tolerant with sexual vice, are as fantastic as they are untrue.

Infractions of the Liquor Law have been rigorously dealt with, the heavy fines imposed having a salutary effect.

Peddling liquor by the bottle on the street has been carried on to some extent, and is not easy of suppression.

Betting by handbooks continues, and is difficult of detection, the operators being very watchful and cunning to elude the Police.

Breaches of the Lord's Day Act have declined, there being a decrease of over 200 cases. The Lord's Day Alliance co-operate with the Police in this connection.

The sale of prohibited drugs, such as opium, cocaine and heroin, has shown a marked tendency to increase. Prosecution of those found engaged in this debasing business has been relentless.

As the interest in the suppression of cruelty to animals becomes more general within the Force and out of it, the welfare of those suffering creatures is more closely looked after. With the active co-operation of the Humane Society, complaints of this nature are promptly attended to.

Upon the recommendation of the Police Commissioners, the City made a grant of \$750 to the Society, which was of great assistance to them. I would strongly urge that a similar contribution be made this year.

Truancy has engaged the attention of three members of the Staff, who have their hands full to keep up with the work, a summary of which is appended.

AMBULANCE SERVICE.

Has now three motors, including a combined Ambulance and Patrol Wagon, in operation, and two horse drawn vehicles in reserve, the latter being seldom used.

The celerity of the service at the disposal of the public continues to attract plenty of business. The cash contributions amounted to \$139.

A Motor Ambulance was purchased out of the accumulated funds from this source, at a cost of \$1,900, reducing the balance to \$877.02.

An obsolete horse ambulance was sold to a country town at a nominal price.

Four lectures were delivered by the doctors during the year, and 71 recruits passed through a course of instruction in "First Aid."

The number of certificates now held by the Force is 641.

MOUNTED SERVICE.

Is on a somewhat reduced scale in men and horses, but there are sufficient for present requirements.

PATROL WAGON AND SIGNAL SERVICE.

Calls for no special comment, the system working with smoothness and regularity.

I recommend that another light motor be purchased, and then all horses for draught purposes can be entirely dispensed with.

GENERAL REMARKS.

At the close of the year the strength of the Force, all ranks included, stood at 689 as compared with 690 on the 31st of December, 1914.

Seventy-three men resigned during the year; 43 of them have enlisted. Including the reservists who joined the colors, the number of men from the Toronto Police Force who have volunteered for Active Military Service totalled 83 up to the close of 1915.

As desirable men are forthcoming in very limited numbers, it will probably be necessary to operate the Police Force on a reduced scale until the war is over.

All available members of the Force have been instructed in the use of the rifle, and have passed through a course of target practice at a range placed at their disposal by Mr. R. J. Fleming, who very kindly allowed the Police to use his grounds for that purpose, and also facilitated their doing so, in every way. I take this opportunity of acknowledging his courtesy.

I have much pleasure and satisfaction in calling your attention to the very efficient work done by the Official Censor, Mr. Banks, and his colleagues during the year. He has succeeded in eliminating most of the objectionable features and language, and has done so so tactfully that the proprietors of the theatres, music halls, picture shows, etc., readily give him their assistance and co-operation.

Tag Days were granted in aid of the Queen Alexandra Hospital in June, the Humane Society in July, the National Sanitarium Association in September, and the Citizens' Recruiting League in November. Considerable money was received in this way, and I have no reason to believe that the public raised any objection to this form of contributing money for such worthy objects.

The "Jitneys," so-called, which mean automobiles with a limited seating capacity, were put in service in large numbers, and received a good deal of public patronage so long as the weather was propitious. Certain regulations have been introduced for their operation.

The dazzling headlights on motor driven vehicles have been under consideration, and it may be necessary to restrict their use.

I am pleased to report that the Force has readily responded to the calls made upon them during the year for patriotic and other purposes.

It is no longer permissible for licensed theatres, halls, etc., to be used on Sundays for Election purposes.

All social clubs whose members were of enemy nationality, have been closed.

Although the law relating to Proprietary Clubs operated under a Provincial charter, has been amended, the efforts of the Police to bring them under the control of a City license have not been altogether successful, the Magistrate's decisions having been offset on appeal.

The Chief Constables' Association held their annual meeting in Toronto in June, with a satisfactory attendance, considering the conditions prevailing. The members present were hospitably entertained by the City, the Police Commissioners, and the Police Athletic Association.

There were three thousand, six hundred and twenty-nine houses under the special supervision of the Police, eight of which were entered.

The returns from the License Department show a decrease of \$1,308.07, as compared with 1914.
