CHIEF CONSTABLE'S OFFICE,
Toronto, February 16th, 1920.

The Chairman, Board of Police Commissioners, Toronto:

SIR,—I have the honor to submit for the information of the Police Commissioners, my Report upon the Department for 1919, together with the usual statistical information in tabular form.

The number of persons, male and female, apprehended or summoned is given as 30,170, an increase over 1918 of 1,964.

In 7,116 cases the charges were withdrawn or dropped.

Property valued at \$2,060,581.00, including 1,660 motor cars estimated to be worth \$1,387,997.00, was lost and stolen, as compared with \$1,303,241 the previous year, being an increase of \$757,340.00.

The Police recovered \$1,679,387, or 81.5 per cent. of the loss.

DETECTIVE DEPARTMENT.

The criminal returns show unmistakably that indictable offences have very considerably increased, as may be noted in appended table. This was to be expected, as similar conditions have prevailed nearly everywhere and are likely to continue until the civilized world settles down after the convulsions of a war so prolonged.

Murder was charged in seven cases, resulting in two being reduced to manslaughter; in one the prisoner was pronounced insane, another was found guilty of manslaughter, two have escaped for the time being, and the seventh is awaiting trial.

Manslaughter appears 18 times on the record, the deaths having been caused by motor cars 10, street cars 2, and the rest by drunken quarrels, etc. There were seven convictions and eight acquittals.

Burglary occurred in 11 instances against 20 the previous year, and the loss was \$614.00 in excess of 1918.

House and Shopbreaking increased largely, the reports numbering 1,038 more than 1918, with 50 per cent. greater in value stolen.

Robbery was more frequent, but the thieves did not get so much by \$10,000.00 for their trouble.

Towards the end of the year several instances of what might be termed "robbery under arms" took place by young men operating with fast motor cars. Some have since been arrested, and for a time at least the raids have almost ceased, but are not unlikely to recur at any time.

Pocket Picking doubled, and the financial loss was \$10,000.00 larger.

Bicycle Stealing was very active, over 2,000 having been stolen, with a loss to the owners of some \$15,000.00. The carelessness and indifference shown as to recovery is quite remarkable. The number of unclaimed bicycles in the hands of the Police is increasingly large.

Of the 1,660 motor cars, valued at \$1,387,997.00, all but 51 were recovered. Joy riding is chiefly the object of this form of theft, and it will continue till the owners take ordinary care of their property, and the thieves when caught receive an adequate sentence.

Thieving of a minor and miscellaneous character has been greatly in evidence, the reports totalling 5,229, against 4,087 a year ago, but resulting in a decreased loss to the public of \$183,334.00.

The aggregate value of stolen property—motor cars not included—was \$672,584.00, of which the Detective Department recovered \$241,090.00, being \$92,695.00 more than 1918.

During the year Inspector Kennedy retired on a pension, after a long career of efficient and faithful service. He has been succeeded by Inspector Guthrie, and an Assistant Inspector has been appointed.

Detective Maurer, who was detailed to look after enemy aliens, which he did effectively, also resigned.

This branch of the service must be kept up to full strength in personnel, and with the equipment and facilities for greater freedom of movement.

Detectives are now styled Detective Sergeants, which does not imply any change in rank, pay or seniority.

For several years efforts have been made to get additional accommodation for this Department, which is now so over-crowded that the work is only carried on under extreme difficulty and inconvenience by the officer in charge and his immediate assistants.

I again urge that Committee Room No. 1 or other equally suitable room be allocated to enlarge the Police quarters, so that extra space be made available, and that as soon as possible.

STAFF DEPARTMENT.

The reports indicate little change in the character and volume of business transacted by the Staff Inspector and his officials.

The enforcement of the Ontario Temperance Act has proceeded along the usual lines and very much with the same results, the prosecutions and fines being as follows:—

The total revenue, including fines for drunkenness, being \$215,995 in 1919, as against \$209,102 for 1918.

Liquor to the extent of 478 gallons and 11,311 bottles were seized and handed over to the License Board.

Troubles of a domestic nature were more numerous and were so adjusted that not one per cent. found their way into Court.

Money to the extent of \$22,144 was collected from men who had deserted their families and was widely distributed in Canada, Great Britain and United States.

The Police women are of material assistance in matters of this kind.

Gambling places, houses of ill-fame and other disreputable resorts have engaged the attention of this Department, and the usual migration generally takes place after a conviction.

Opium, cocaine and other harmful drugs continue to be sold, resulting in 68 prosecutions, slightly less than the previous year.

Cruelty to animals is on the decline, partly because there are fewer of them and partly through the activities of the Humane Society.

The truant officers have been discontinued, as the work has been taken over by the School Board.

The Staff Inspector and his assistant deserve credit for the success that has been attained through their instrumentality, hard work and good judgment.

AMBULANCE, PATROL AND SIGNAL SERVICES.

These are operated under the direction of an Inspector who gives his exclusive time and attention to the details of a wide range, the result being entirely satisfactory.

There are three ambulances, all motor driven, the last horse vehicle having been sold, and a steady service has been maintained under all conditions of weather, etc.

The receipts collected from the public amounted to \$1,845.00. One new ambulance was purchased out of the accumulated funds.

The patrol wagons are in fair order and handled the business without interruption. One new one should be provided this year.

The signal system worked without a hitch, and the operators are to be commended for the intelligent way in which they circulated information to P.C.'s on beat and elsewhere in emergency calls.

MOUNTED SERVICE.

There is little to be said in this connection of special interest. Horses and equipment have been maintained on a workable standard. The number of men on this duty should be increased at least 25 per cent.

The prices of horses, forage, shoeing, etc., have ruled high, and there is no reason to think that they will change for the better.

Three horses were cast and replaced by five others.

There should be a stable at No. 9 Station for three or four horses, to patrol that outlying district.

GENERAL REMARKS.

On January 1st, 1920, the strength of the Force stood at 662, all ranks, an increase in 12 months of 52, which makes the number about 30 less than it was before the war. This, in my opinion, is quite inadequate to give citizens the protection and service they undoubtedly should have. Among the reasons for a very substantial addition are:—

- (a) The 8-hour day, which in itself calls for nearly one-third more men on patrol duty.
- (b) The regulation of traffic at all congested crossings which necessitates the presence of P.C.'s there during the busy hours.
- (c) The supervision of all places of public resort, such as the Island, parks, railway stations, wharves, ball grounds, theatres, rinks, etc.
- (d) The growth of the City, in area, population and commercial development.
- (e) Provision for emergencies liable to arise unexpectedly and without warning.
- (f) Industrial unrest everywhere which is causing all large cities to strengthen the Police.

I therefore have no hesitation in recommending that the maximum amount the City can afford be invested in this form of insurance to make life and property safe in Toronto.

The Royal Commission, appointed by the Ontario Government to report upon the Police Union, its affiliations, grievances and other matters of Police import, held a prolonged investigation and came to the conclusion that a Police Union should have no outside affiliations, but recommended some changes for the betterment of the Force, which have since been adopted by the Police Commissioners.

A strike of the Toronto Railway employees for an increase of pay took place in June and lasted 13 days. No untoward incident occurred.

His Royal Highness, the Prince of Wales, visited Toronto in August, staying three days. The resources of the Department were taxed to the limit, as the Canadian National Exhibition was in progress at the time. The Prince returned in October for 24 hours.

Traffic regulation on the busy streets is becoming increasingly difficult. I would therefore suggest that a mechanical device known as a semaphore be tried out at several points where their utility could be determined.

The Toronto Railway Co. has withdrawn the privileges the Police out of uniform enjoyed of riding free on the cars. This will entail an extra expense to the City of about \$9,000 per annum for two years.

A new official Police badge for all ranks has been issued for identification purposes only.

Revolvers of a modern pattern for P.C.'s in plainclothes have been supplied, but the question of re-arming the Force has yet to be decided, the expense involved being very considerable.

Electric flashlights now form part of the equipment, also waterproof greatcoats of the latest pattern. A new type of forage cap will be introduced during the year.

Two additional Police women for outside patrol service have been taken on. Their work is in the experimental stage.

Payment to the Police volunteering for extra duty at races, football and other matches by those engaging them has been restored.

His Honor, Judge Winchester, a Commissioner for 16 years, died in May to the great regret of those who knew his value as a public official. His Honor, Judge Morson, has been appointed in his place as a Commissioner.

Dr. Eadie was appointed Medical Officer in charge of the Force, vice Dr. Spragge, resigned, and who has since died. New regulations for both the medical and surgical treatment of the Force have been promulgated.

Vacant houses to the number of 2,476 were placed under special Police supervision. Nine were entered.

The receipts from licenses as per statement attached have increased by \$10,280.17.
