

Especially adapted for working among carnations, roses, etc. Equally as valuable to the market gardener and nurseryman; and the best all-round weeder for the private garden.


Does not cut or de-

No More Broken Backs-This device gets at the root of the evil and removes it bodily. The curved edge of the blade enters and loosens the soil; pressure on the lever then causes the toothed



jaw to grasp the plant ,and a slight pull suffices to dislodge the same without disturbing surrounding sod. Price 75c each here.
