## FIRE ALARM TELEGRAPH

### DIRECTIONS TO GIVE AN ALARM.

Upon what may appear as correct information of a fire near your signal box, break the glass, unlock the signal box door and pull the brass hook, on the inside door all the way down (once only) and let it go. If you are within hearing distance of the fire alarm bells or gongs, and do not hear the alarm sound in less than fifteen seconds, go to the next nearest box to the fire and do as before directed. The hook should not be pulled while the alarm is being sounded from some other box, nor before the expiration of at least thirty seconds after the alarm has ceased. No alarm should be given for a chinmey only on fire, and no box should be pulled more than once for the same fire, except by an officer of the Fire Department

Never open the box or touch the hook except

in case of fire.

To give an alarm from a box with a Keyless door, turn the handle to the right, open the door and pull the hook down (once only) and let it go.

Never give an alarm except from the box nearest the fire, unless you have first ascertained that the box nearest the fire will not

work

Do not try to take the Key out of the door as it is "locked in" and cannot be taken out without a relief key.

## ORDERS.

#### CALL FOR ENGINES.

If a Steam Engine is required, as a warning to the person in charge of the Engine, four distinct blows will be struck on the Bells and Gongs, and after a pause of ten seconds the number of the Engine required will be struck once

#### FOR GENERAL ALARM.

First, three distinct blows on the bells and gongs, and, after a pause of fifteen seconds, the

signal box pulled.

When the General Alarm is sounded, all the men and working apparatus of the Department ordered to attend a General Alarm shall attend as speedily as possible.

#### FALSE OR UNNECESSARY ALARMS.

Whenever the alarm of fire is sounded, as soon as possible after it is ascertained that there is no cause of alarm. or that the fire has been extinguished, or nearly extinguished, two distinct blows will be struck on the Alarm Bells and Gongs.
