JOHN ALEXANDER COOPER

John Alexander Cooper was born in Clinton, Ontario, on the 5th of February, 1868. He received his elementary education in Clinton and taught in the township of Goderich for 3 years. He then attended University College, University of Toronto, where he studied political science, graduating with a B.A. in 1892, and an LL.B. in 1893. In 1896 he became editor of the Canadian Magazine, and in 1906, left that publication to become the first editor of the Canadian Courier.

While attending University, Cooper enrolled in the University Company of the Militia, and after graduation, joined the Queen's Own Rifles. By 1906 he achieved the rank of Captain. Though he retired from the militia in 1912, he was called to active service in 1915, and in 1917, having recruited the 198th Battalion (the Buffs), Cooper went to England with them as their Colonel. When the Buffs were broken up in January 1918, Cooper reverted to the rank of Major and went to France to join the 2nd Division, 4th Infantry Brigade.

In 1919, after Cooper had returned to Canada, he was sent to New York by the Canadian Government to establish a Bureau of Information. When the office was transformed into a trade office in 1921, he returned to Toronto to associate himself with the advertising agency, Smith, Denne and Moore, and to become Secretary of the Motion Picture Distributors' Association. In 1925 he was appointed full time manager of the Motion Picture Distributors' Association and for the next 25 years was concerned with the commercial problems of the Association and legislation concerning the industry. During the Second World War, Cooper was a key figure in the organization which supplied motion pictures to the Canadian Armed Services.

In the course of his working life, Cooper was an influential member of the Canadian Press Association, the Association of Canadian Clubs, the Canadian League, the Dominion Fire Prevention Society, the Musical Protective Society, the Canadian National Exhibition, the Canadian Society of Authors, and the Canadian Red Cross, as well as other organizations and causes concerned with Canadian arts, government and society. Throughout his life he wrote and lectured on the topics which deeply concerned him, particularly, education, journalism, Canadian nationalism and British patriotism. He maintained relationships with many of the most influential Canadians of the time including Prime Ministers Laurier, Borden and Mackenzie King, and other members of the federal and provincial government, as well as Canadian, American and British military men, newspaper editors, businessmen, historians and writers.

Col. Cooper died in Toronto on the 18th of January 1956.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE JOHN ALEXANDER COOPER PAPERS

The John Cooper Papers consist, primarily, of letters to and from Col. Cooper, written between c.1890 and 1945 on a wide variety of his interests, especially journalism, politics, military history, Canadian nationalism and Canada's relationship with Britain. In addition there are numerous manuscripts and typescripts of articles and addresses by Col. Cooper, reports, memos, minutes, constitutions, military papers, invitations, programmes, menus, visiting and Christmas cards, periodicals, newspaper clippings and some pamphlets on Cooper's many interests.

The John Cooper Papers were donated to the North York Public Library Canadiana Department in 1981. Access to the Papers is unrestricted.

The organization of the John Cooper Papers has been primarily dictated by the order used by Col. Cooper. Most of the series titles were established by Col. Cooper, many of the items found in individual series were placed there by him, and the arrangement of the correspondence reflects Col. Cooper's practice of grouping letters from individuals and copies of his responses to them together, chronologically, under the name of the person involved. Cooper also frequently gathered together correspondence from several individuals, on a specific topic, in one file. Occasionally these items were glued together. These files have been maintained under the sub-series, Attached Correspondence.

The Papers have been divided into two main sections:

- I: Series which reflect Col. Cooper's primary activities and interests according to his unpublished autobiography and his own files.
- II: Series which reflect his personal, family and miscellaneous business concerns, and in addition, manuscripts, typescripts, periodicals, newspaper clippings and photographs of a miscellaneous nature.

Page 1 of the Finding Aid lists the title of each series and the order in which each appears in the Finding Aid.

NOTES ON THE FINDING AID

- 1. A list of the series titles appears on page i.
- 2. Most series begin with an introductory paragraph which outlines Col. Cooper's involvement with the topic of the series.
- 3. The first sub-series within each series, Correspondence, opens with a list of topics covered in the letters. Letters are organized alphabetically by correspondent with incoming letters and copies of Col. Cooper's responses to the correspondent filed together. Entries for Col. Cooper's outgoing letters are indicated by "to" before the correspondent's name. Items under each name are organized chronologically.
- 4. The second sub-series within each series, Attached Correspondence, contains letters on a specific topic within the series which were fastened together and filed separately by Col. Cooper. Entry includes the range of dates, correspondents involved listed alphabetically (except for Col. Cooper), and the main subject of the correspondence.
- 5. Subsequent sub-series within each series are appropriate to each specific series.
- 6. In two series, <u>Canadian Magazine</u> and <u>Business and Personal</u> Correspondence, a brief description of each letter is given.

JOHN ALEXANDER COOPER PAPERS PART I

PRIMARY ACTIVITIES AND INTERESTS

SERIES: BUREAU OF INFORMATION, N.Y., AND U.S. TRADE RELATIONS

In July of 1919 Col. Cooper was asked, by Sir Robert Borden, to go to New York to re-organize the distribution of Canadian news in the United States. Canada needed publicity in that country prior to floating a large loan in the U.S. market. The Bureau of Information was opened in August 1919 and served not only to publicize Canada and to answer trade inquiries, but to assist Canadian citizens in New York. Cooper was convinced that Canada needed a trade office and trade agents in the United States and for many months wrote letters and gave addresses in support of his conviction in spite of Canada's Federal Government opposition to the idea. Eventually the need for a trade office was accepted, and when Col. Cooper resigned his post in 1921 his successor, Frederic Hudd, Cooper's former assistant, was named the first Trade Commissioner.

Cooper and William H. Moore, the <u>Courier</u>'s founders, set out to establish an illustrated national, non-political weekly which provided news, fiction, and informative articles. Over the years of its publication the <u>Courier</u> provided stimulus for the works of Canadian writers and illustrators.

At the outset of war, in 1914, the publisher decided to bring out the Daily Courier, but due to poor sales and distribution problems the venture was abandoned after two months. Col. Cooper resigned from the Courier in 1916 to serve in the Canadian Armed Forces overseas, and when he returned to Canada, in 1919, decided to accept a posting as Canadian Government representative in New York rather then to resume editorship of the Courier.

When war broke out in 1914, John Cooper decided to join the Canadian Army but withdrew due to other commitments. In December, 1915, he was called up for service, and by February, 1916, as a Colonel, began recruiting a new battalion - 198th O.S. Battalion which was given the sub-title, the Canadian Buffs. The Buffs went to England but were broken up in January, 1918, before they had an opportunity to go into action. Col. Cooper reverted to the rank of Major and went to France in 1918 where he served on the Brigade staff until Armistice in November.

He travelled with a Canadian delegation to a Press Conference at the World's Fair in St. Louis, as president, and in 1905 accompanied the Canadian Manufacturer's Association to Great Britain as honorary journalist. Subsequently Cooper, with two other members of the party, published a souvenir of the trip Official Souvenir: Visit of the Canadian Manufacturers... (see Bibliography p.113). Cooper was elected honorary member of the Canadian Press Association, Inc., in 1919.


