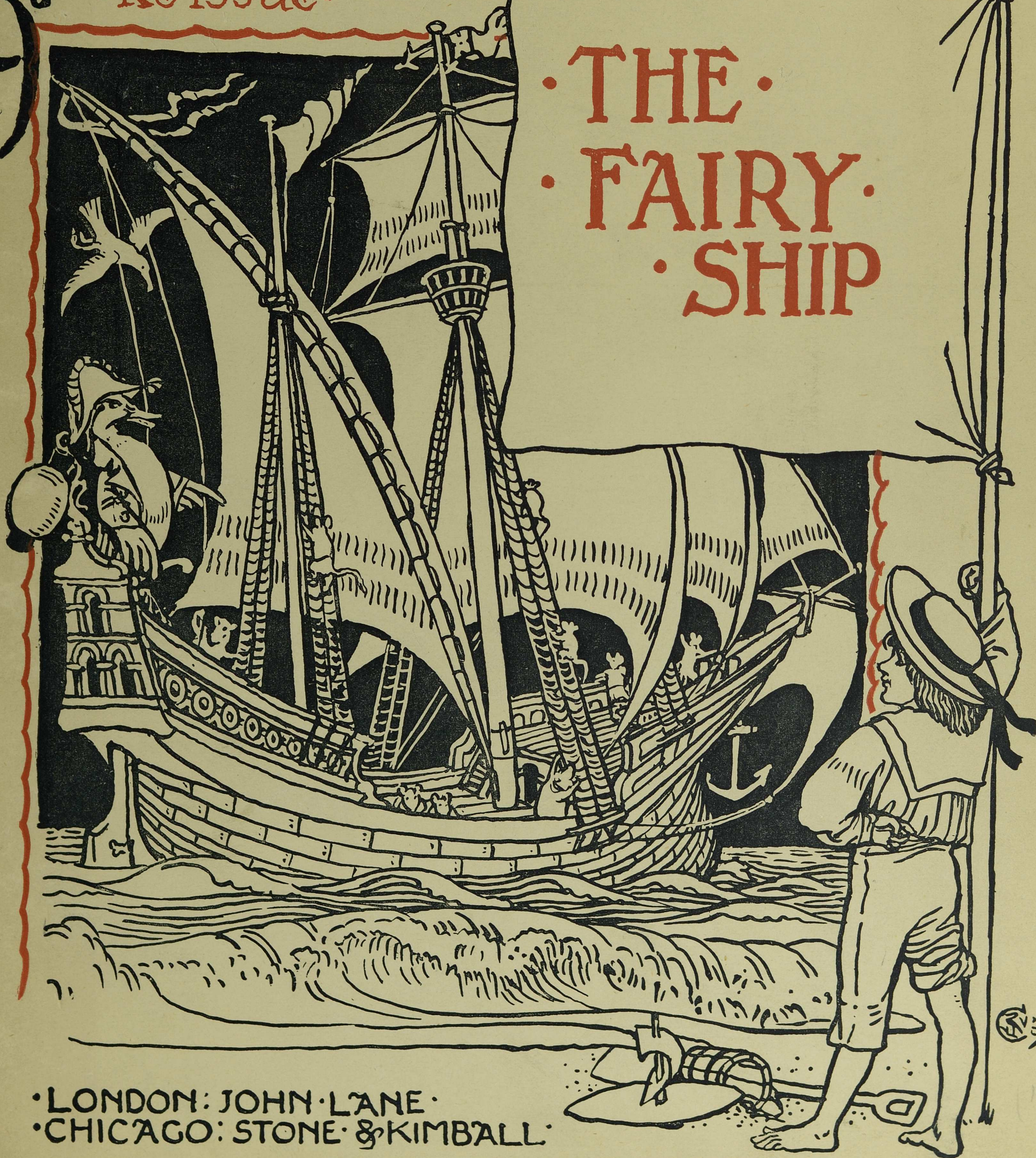

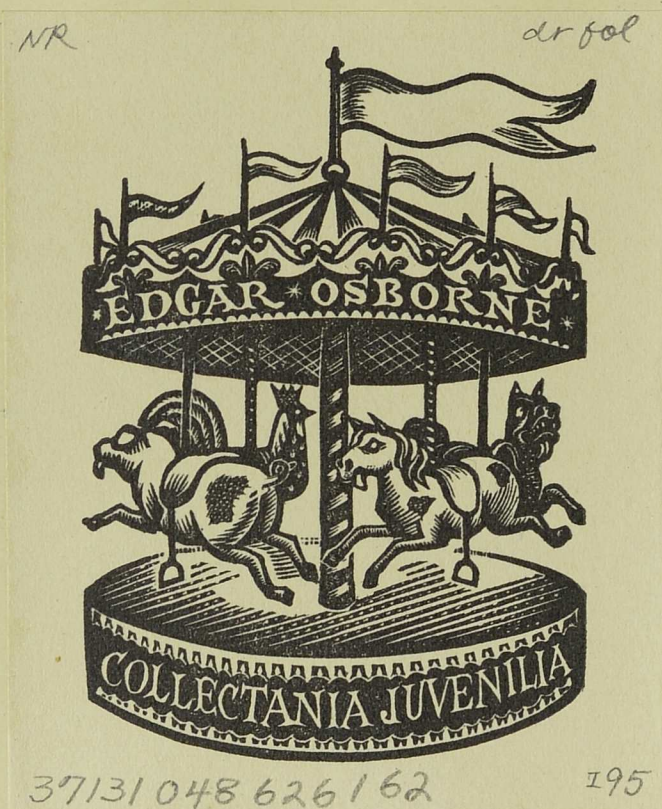

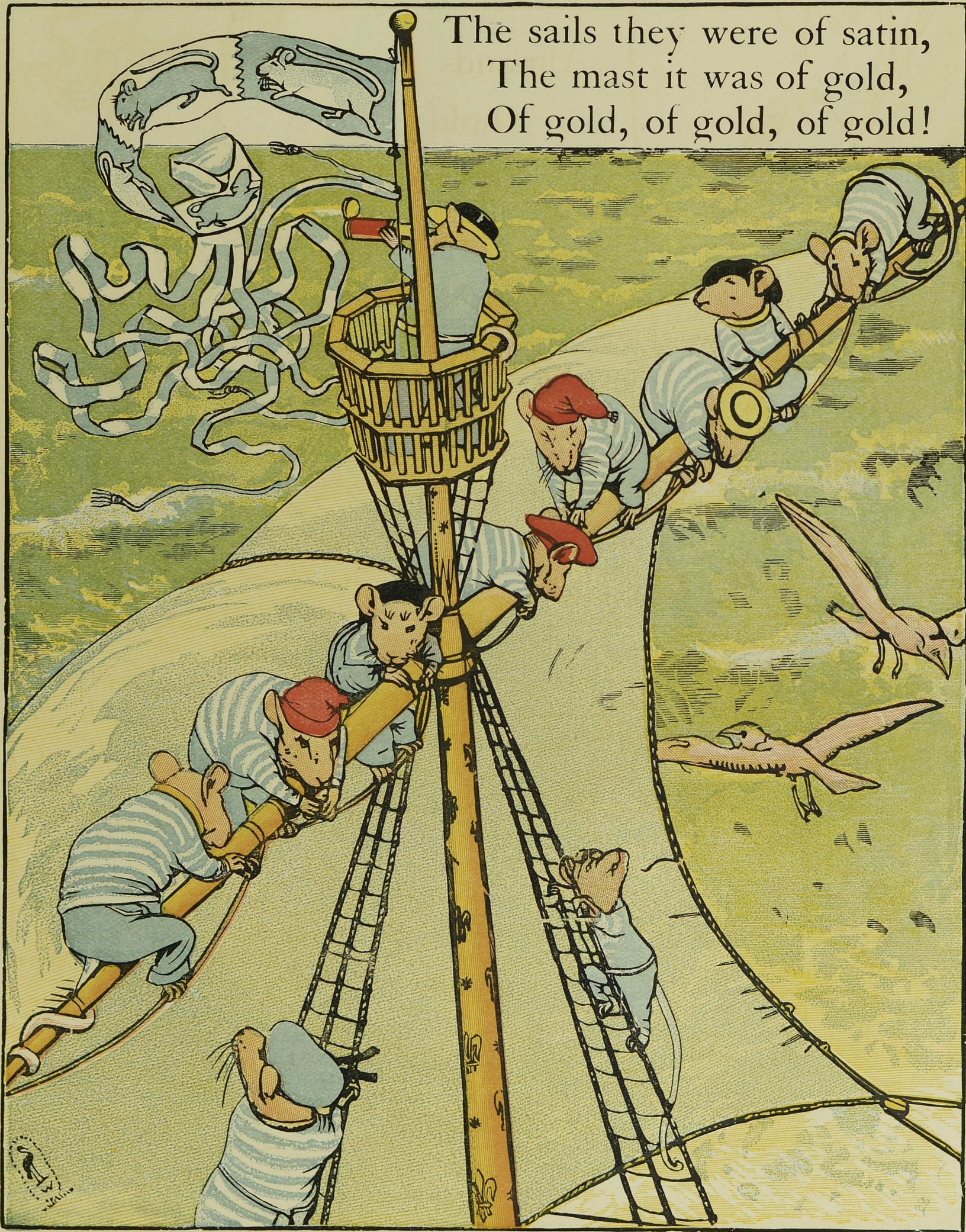


Raisins in the Cabin;



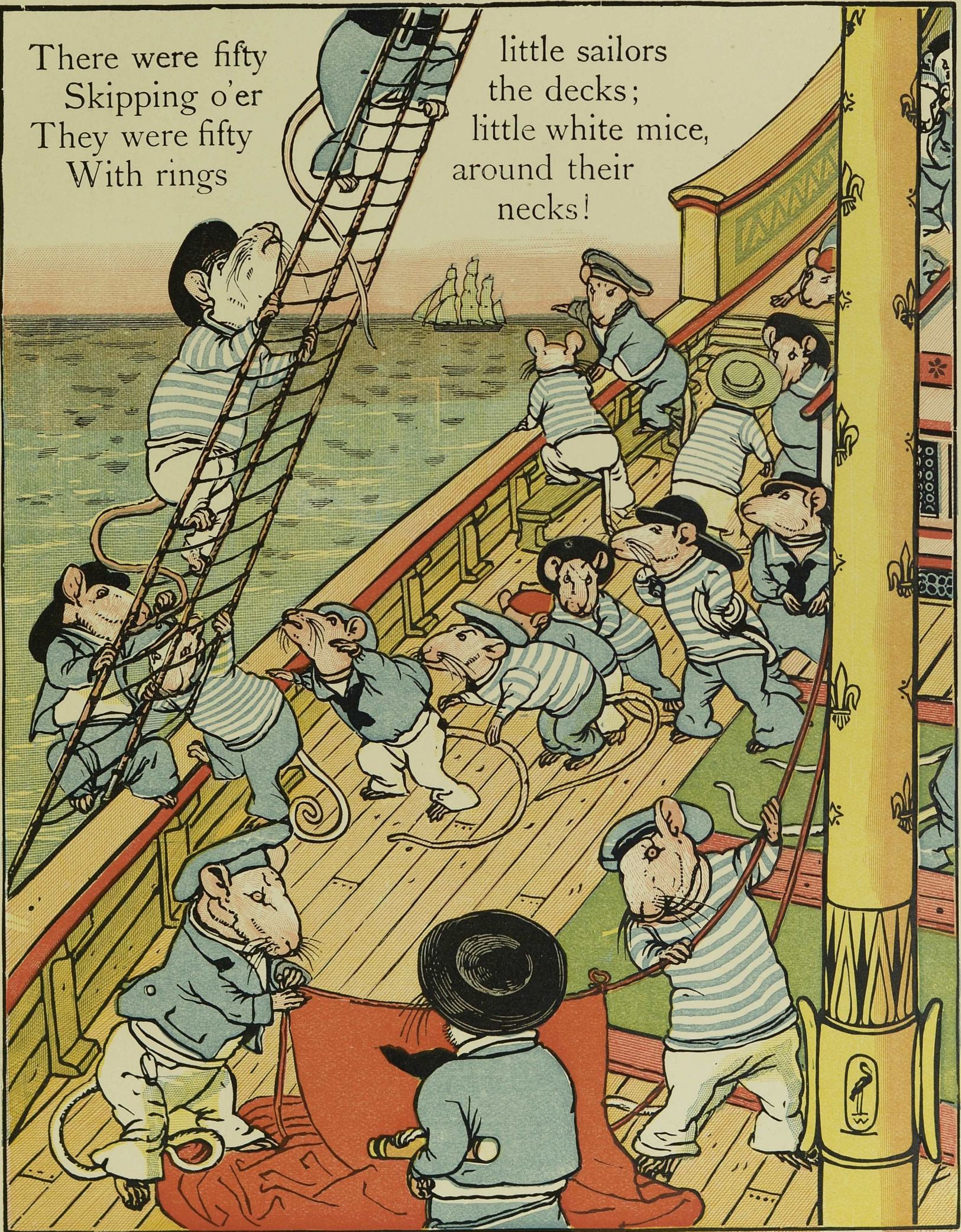


The sails they were of satin,

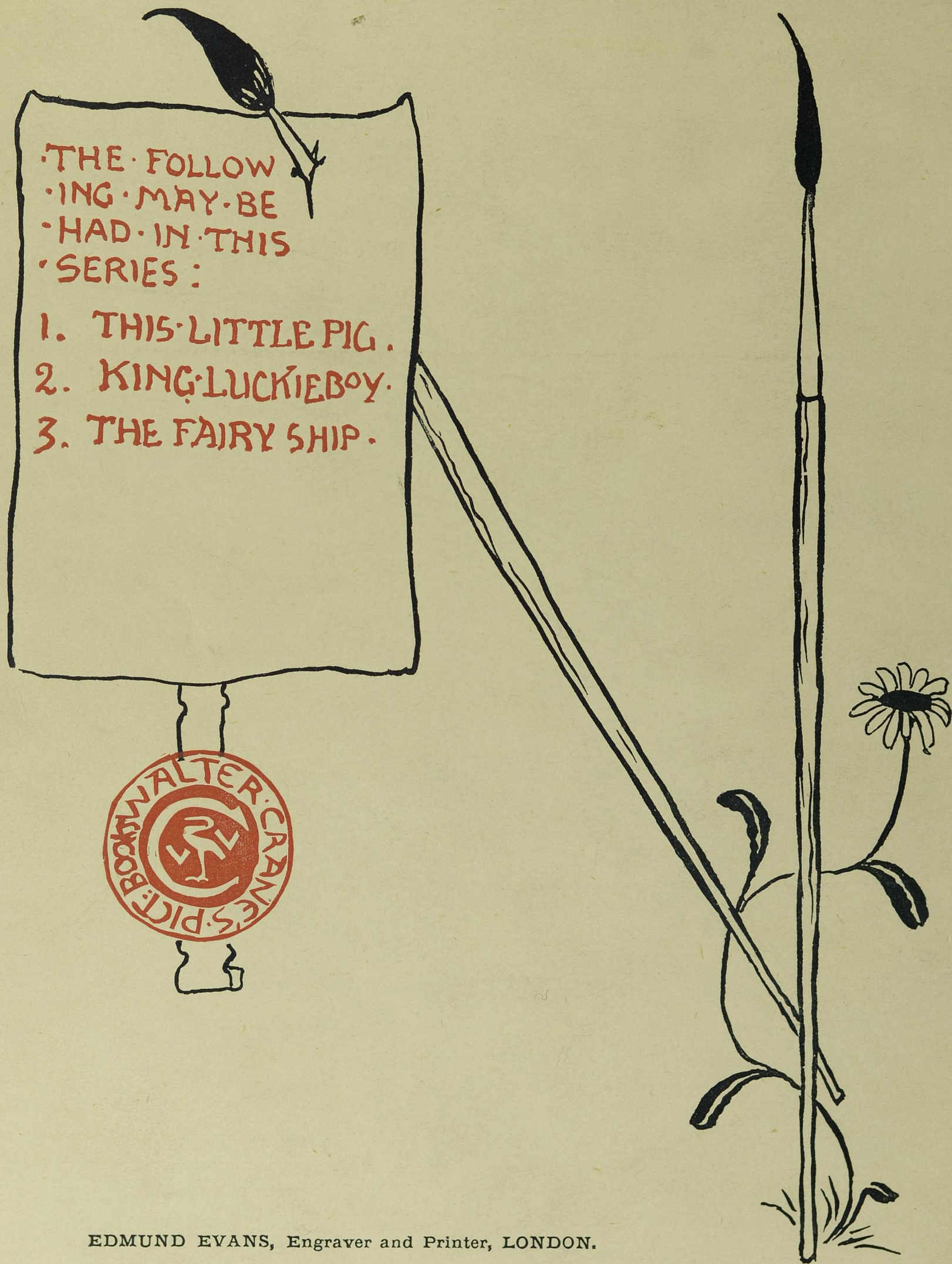
