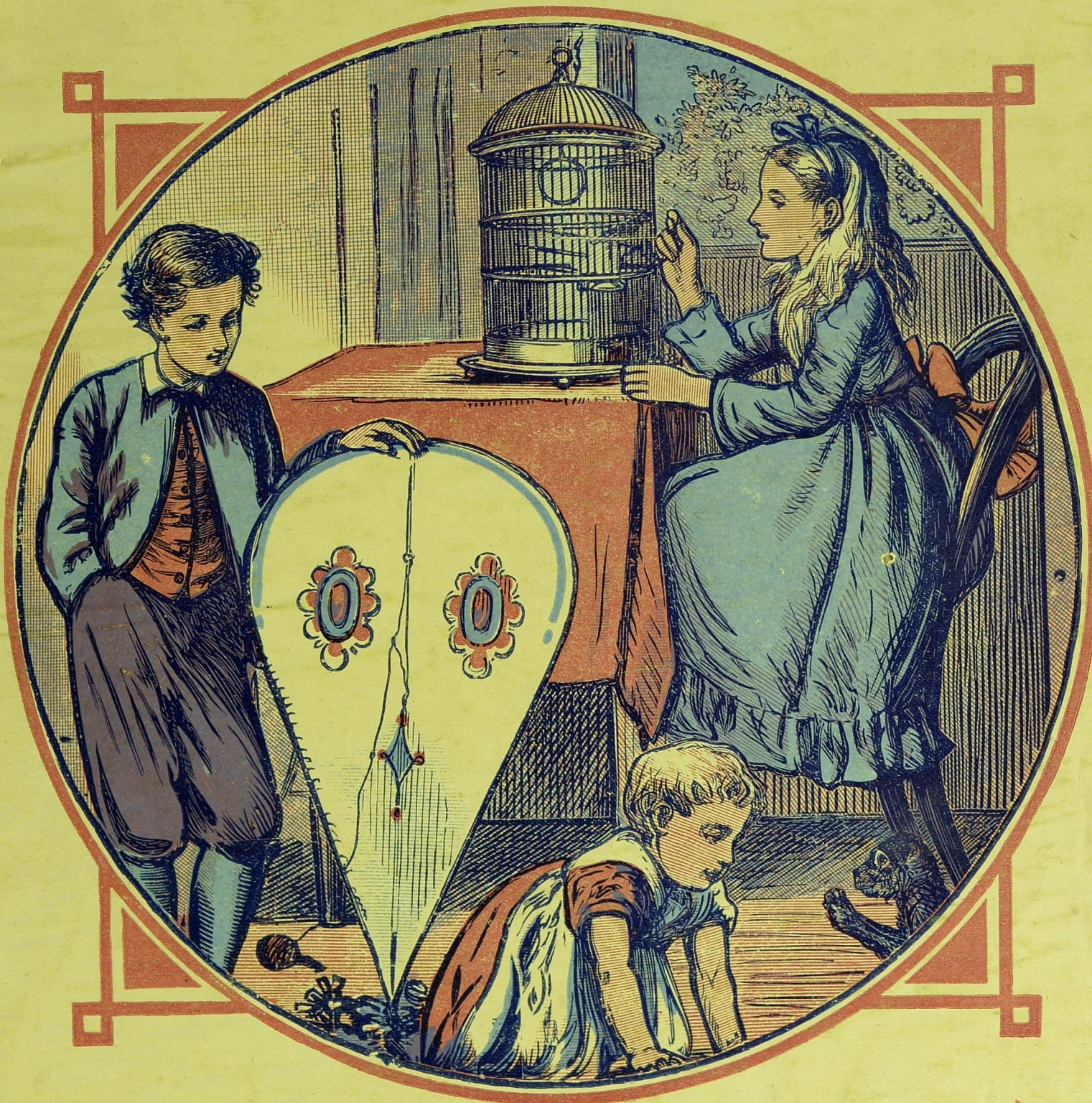


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THE HOME ALPHABET.

K is a Kite George has painted and framed ;

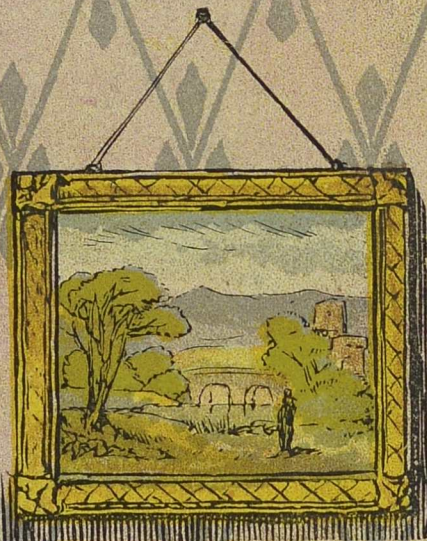
L is a Linnet which Mary has tamed ;
