The ripe fruits in the garden,


He made them every one;

That we gather every day;


He gave us eyes to see them,

Ev'rywhere that Mary went,


The lamb was sure to go.


It followed her to school one day;

The teacher did reply.



I shall see him and hear him above;


In that beautiful place he is gone to prepare

For of such is the kingdom of heaven.








