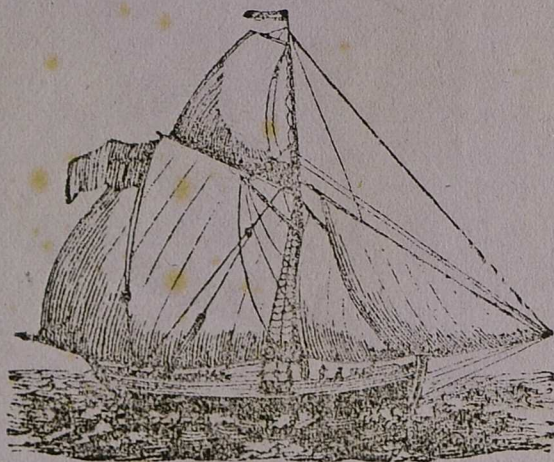

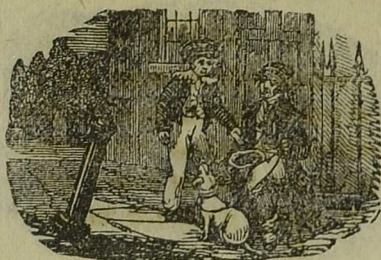

PRAYER BEFORE LEAVING CHURCH OR CHAPEL


Almighty God, I thank thee for this
