And so the poor dog had none.



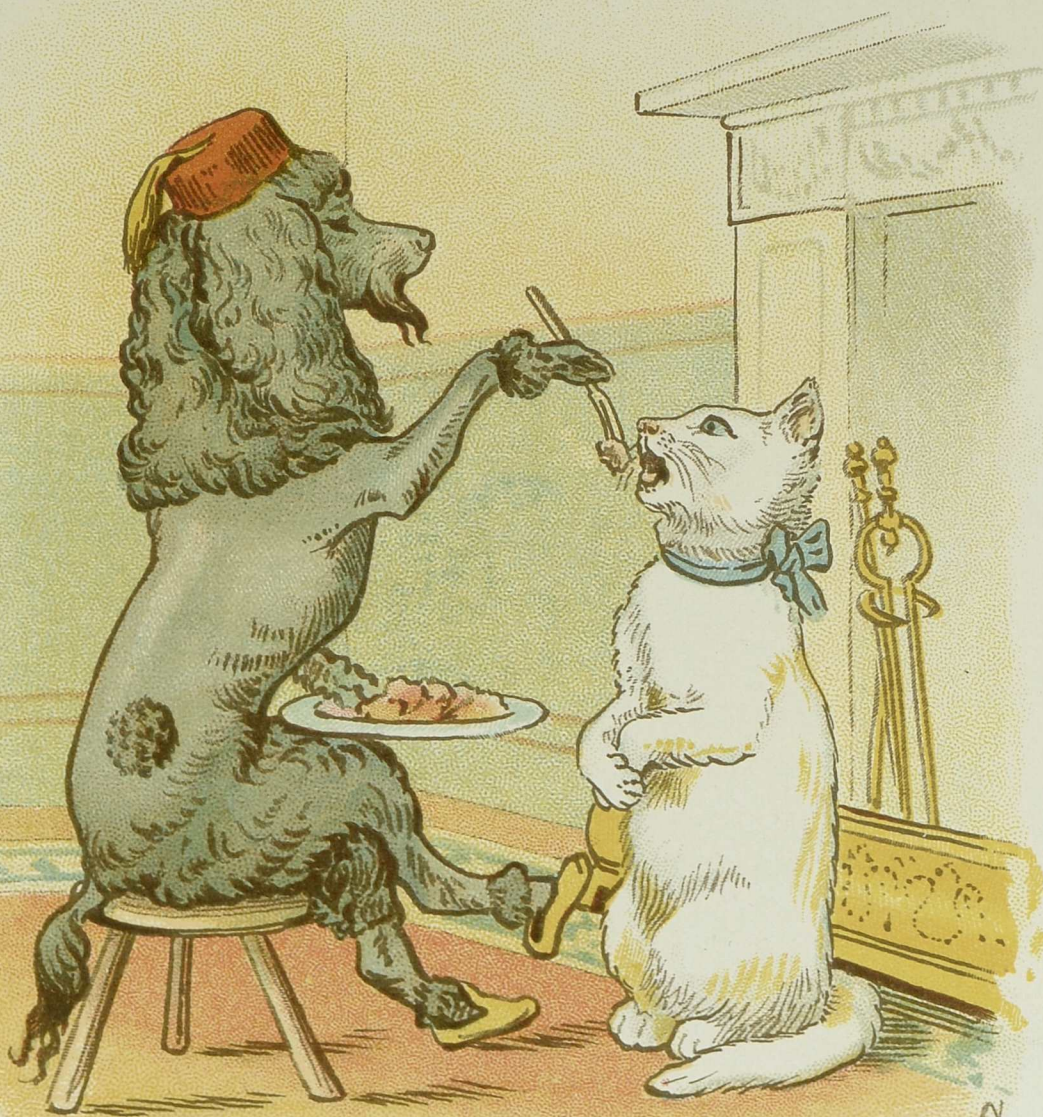
She went to the Cobbler's

He was riding the goat.

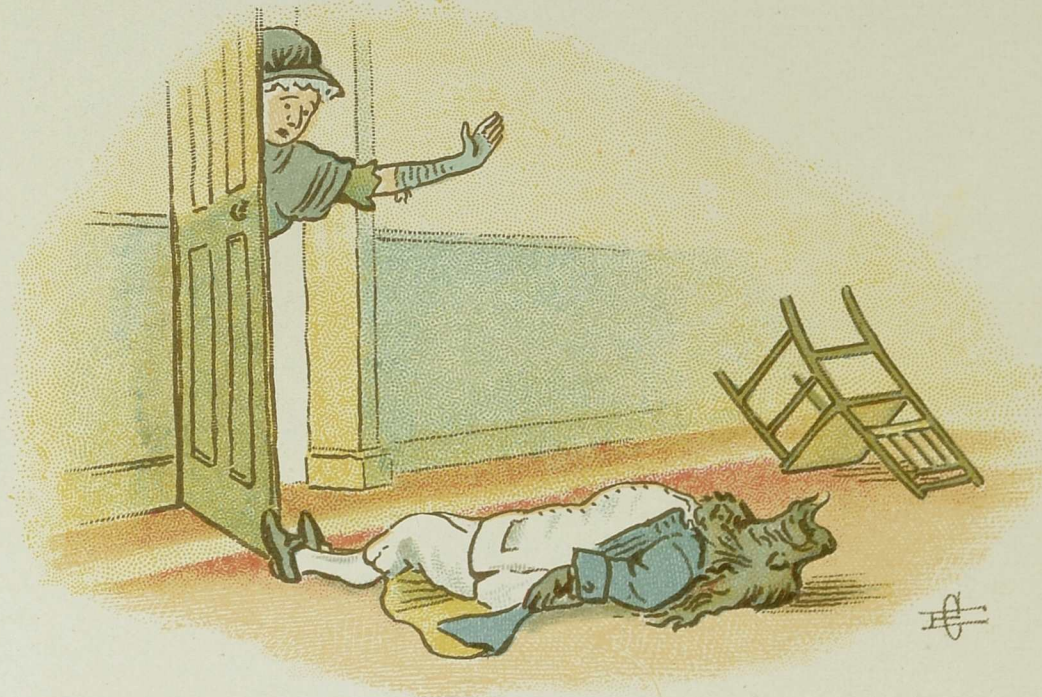




She went to the Hosier's

He was dressed in his clothes.

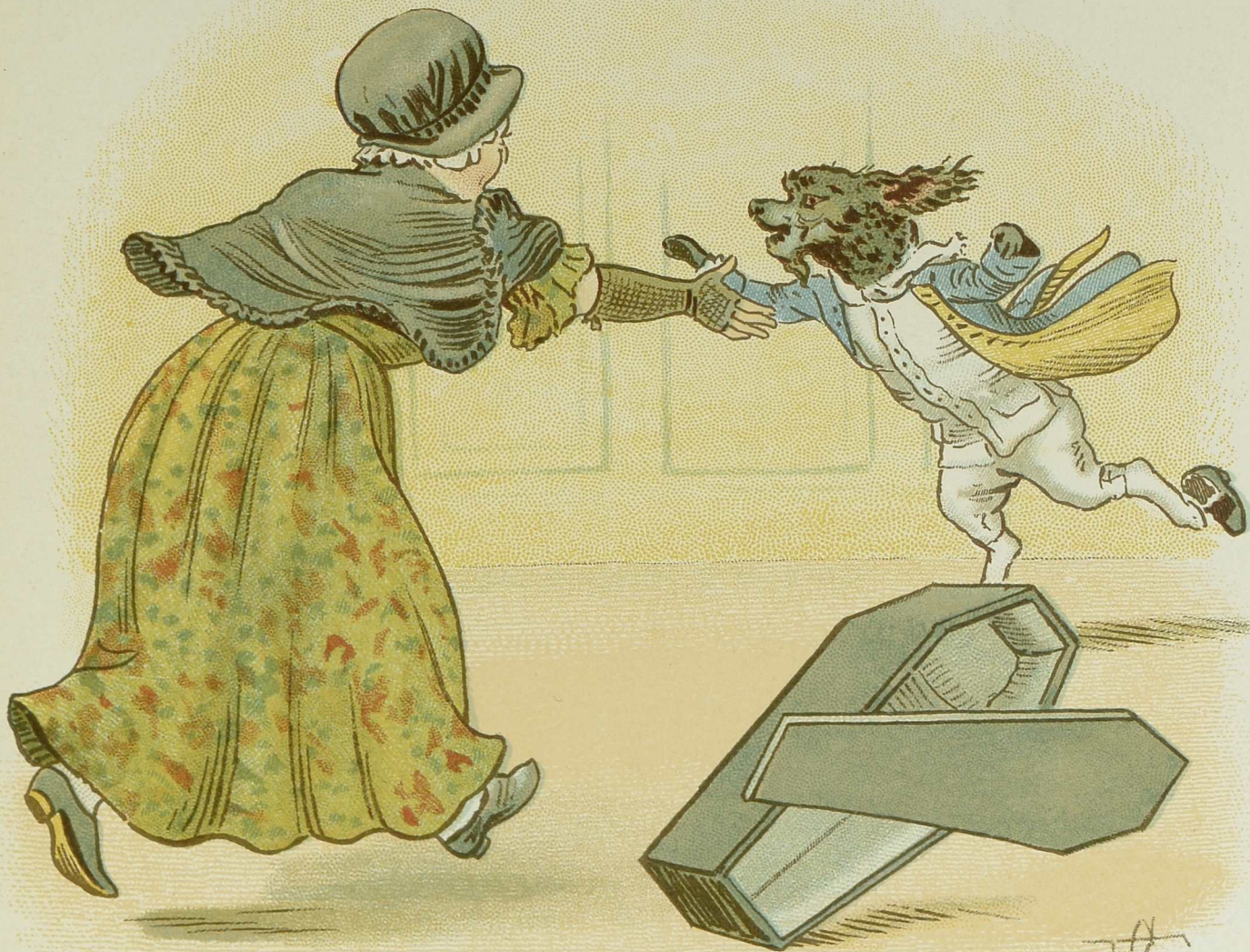
