THE REV. VINCENT PHILIP MAYERHOFFER,
A. M., Rector of MARKHAM AND VAUGHAN.
—In the Colony of St. May last, was in-
serted a communication, signed "A Scot," illu-
strative of the conduct of the reverend person
whose name heads this article. We have
had lying by us for some time past the follow-
ing document, which was intended as a reply to
that letter, but how far it is so, we leave our
readers to judge.

We view the reverend gentleman's allusion
to us as quite harmless, and we have no doubt
our correspondent will regard the allusions to
him equally so.

The document is a curiosity in its way, and
we present it to our readers *literatim*; al-
though its publication at all is certainly against
our own judgment; as we took occasion to
state to its Reverend author; but as he
strongly persisted in its publication by us, and
exact our promise to that effect, we feel bound
to do so, as early as we possibly could afford
the space.

We might introduce the subject, if so dis-
posed, with some curious facts, but the docu-
ment itself is sufficient for one week.

We may, however, allude to one point ex-
hibited by the document, viz. the extraordi-
nary manner of acquiring property for "The
Church of Upper Canada." We pre-
sented Mr. Mayerhoffer will have found out by
this time, that there is something more neces-
sary in law, to transfer property from one re-
ligious body to another, than the mere cir-
cumstance of Dr. Strachan going to the place
and administering the sacrament according to
the rites of that church, for which it is sought
to secure the property.

Here follows the document.

Markham, May 26, 1838.
If the natural and moral precept of Christian
Charity would only be known and exercised
by men in general, to do unto others as they
wish to be done by, it would be a sufficient
and well regulated guide to preserve the
rights of others, and to incur the reproach of
all decent members of the community, who
by transgressing this law of nature, such per-
sons justly ought to be punished with shame
and abhorrence, and detestation, who blindly
led by false assertions against the character
of others, can enter into the company
of wicked and unchristian men, and the
Editor of the British Colonist and the
wretch who gave in the declaration against my
character, April 21 1838, as upon one
level is a sufficient proof, for neither the one
who wrote the statement, nor he that printed
it, ever can prove the assertion, though the
writer pledges himself for the truth of his
contents. All that I permit my declaration is,
God forgive them, for they don't know
what they do.

I feel it my duty to give a general repre-
sentation on the whole subject, viz.
Nearly ten years before my appointment as
Missionary for the congregations of Markham
and Vaughan, the members who formerly
called themselves Lutherans, entered freely
into joint subscription with the members of
the Church of England throughout these
two parishes, and received the services of
Dr. Strachan, Dr. Mountain, and Dr. Stuart, and
the Government, to be provided with a clergyman
of the Church of England; but as the condi-
tion was such to get a person qualified to dis-
cuss the word of God in German and Eng-
lish, they could not receive such a man until
