

To the Chairman and Members of the Committee on Fire and Light :

GENTLEMEN,—In compliance with the rules governing the Fire Department, I have the honor to herewith submit the Annual Report of the Department for the year ending December 31st, 1905.

During the year the Department responded to 779 alarms ; this is eight more than last year ; a few of those were false, given by boys breaking the glass covering the locks on our street boxes, and, notwithstanding the fact that a number of convictions have taken place for this offence, the practice is still continued, causing a great deal of unnecessary trouble for the Department, and creating the danger of delay in answering alarms where their services might be required.

The total loss by fire during the year amounted to \$448,214.04 ; this is \$158,128.57 less than last year, exclusive of the conflagration of April 19th of that year. I believe that in no year of the Department's history have the efforts of the Brigade been more successful in keeping down the fire loss, taking into consideration the number of fires and the dangerous nature of the places in which they occurred ;

this is borne out by the many letters of thanks and donations to the Firemen's Benefit Fund received from citizens whose property had been protected, and by the general comment of the public press.

ACCIDENTS.

The members of the Department met with a large number of accidents during the year, and some of them of a very serious nature, but only one proved fatal, that of Captain Worrell, who was instantly killed on the night of September 19th, while performing his duty at the fire in the Brown Milling Co.'s building on the Esplanade, at the foot of Princess Street, by the sudden and unexpected collapse of the building. Captain Sargent was seriously injured at the same fire and is not yet able to resume duty.

HOUSES OR STATIONS.

A considerable amount of improvement has been carried out at the different stations of the Department during the year, notably new basement and hot water heating in No. 9 Dundas Street, complete hot water heating in No. 2 Portland Street; enlarged stable accommodation in No. 1 Bay Street and No. 5 Lombard Street, to contain the horses necessary for the heavy apparatus in those houses. The new Berkeley Street station was completed and occupied; this, for its size, is one of the most up-to-date, and I believe the finest fire station on the continent, and is undoubtedly a credit to the City. The new stations on Cowan Avenue and Queen Street east of Woodbine Avenue are nearing completion and will be ready for occupation in a few weeks. Ground has been secured or options obtained for the land necessary to erect a new central fire station to take the place of Bay Street, and also a new station in the north-west part of the city. When those houses are completed the Department in this respect will be brought up pretty well to the City's requirements.

APPARATUS.

The two 1,200-gallon engines equipped with rubber tires, built by the Waterous Engine Works Company, of Brantford, were received and placed in commission during the year, one at Bay Street to take the place of the "W. P. Hubbard," which is now in Portland Street, taking the place of the old "J. B. Boustead," which was becoming unreliable and is now kept in reserve; the other in Lombard Street taking the place of the "Ronald," formerly in Richmond Street, and which is now transferred to the new Berkeley Street Station. These two large engines are equipped with three horse hitches and are each drawn by three horses; the large aerial truck at Lombard Street has also been equipped in the same manner and is now drawn by

three horses; this is a most decided and marked improvement on the old two-horse system for heavy apparatus. The two large rubber tired hose wagons with divided boxes for carrying 2½ and 3-inch hose, built by J. A. Darch & Co., were received and placed in commission, one at Bay Street, the other at Richmond Street, to accompany the large engines and carry an increased supply of hose for the centre of the City.

The one-horse hose wagon at Ossington Avenue Station was replaced during the year by a two-horse wagon, thereby assuring a quicker response to alarms and greater supply of hose, which was decidedly needed in this rapidly growing part of the City.

HORSES.

The horses in the Department are from year to year being kept up to a proper standard of efficiency; during the year nineteen new horses were purchased, eleven considered unfit for service sold, and two died, leaving 76 in service; this is an increase of six as compared with the final report of 1904.

BUILDING INSPECTION.

The inspection of buildings during the year was carried out more extensively and with a better system than ever before, a record of all inspections being kept in the Chief's office, which can be referred to at any time. All the colleges, convents, convent schools, boarding schools and charitable institutions were carefully examined with a view to better fire protection and proper emergency exits and fire escapes, and I am pleased to report that a very great improvement has been carried out in this direction at the different institutions as a result of the inspection.

The different theatres were also carefully inspected, and, as a result, considerable changes and improvements

have been made, both as to fire protection, emergency exits and fire escapes. I may just state that in carrying out this work I had the hearty co-operation and assistance of Mr. McCallum, the City Architect, whose experience and knowledge of construction made his services in attending to this work most valuable.

It affords me great pleasure to be able to testify from year to year to the loyal support and able assistance which I receive from every officer in the Department, and to the satisfactory manner in which both officers and men perform their duties.

I have again to thank the officers and men of the Police Force for their hearty co-operation and assistance on all occasions possible.

I also wish to thank the members of the Press and the public generally for the many kind things said about the work of the Department during the year.

In conclusion, I return my sincere thanks to the Chairman and members of the Committee on Fire and Light for the courteous treatment I have received at their hands, and for the interest they have taken in the welfare of the Department during the year.

Hereto attached will be found all necessary information as to the running of the Department.

OFFICE OF SUPERINTENDENT FIRE ALARM TELEGRAPH,
Toronto, December 31st, 1905.

Mr. John Thompson, Chief of Fire Department:

DEAR SIR,—As is the custom I respectfully submit herewith a statement of the working of the Fire Alarm Telegraph for the year 1905, during which four hundred and forty-five (445) alarms passed through the automatic repeater and were properly transmitted to the various fire stations.

Early in the year we had two of our wires break on Queen Street, near Victoria street. As the wires in that locality were not safe, I found it necessary to have them replaced by new ones, which has been done between our headquarters and opposite the City Hall on Queen St.

During the year six (6) new alarm boxes were added to the system, one, No. 313, being private and placed on the Gutta Percha and Rubber Company's building, O'Hara Av'. We also paid strict attention to all alarm boxes and gongs, a number of each receiving thorough repairs and materially benefiting the system.

There are thirty-two (32) alarm boxes that would be improved by the adoption of an improved circuit-break specially adapted to this style of box. As the cost would only be about \$2.50 per box, I trust you will have a sufficient amount placed in the Estimates to enable us to make this improvement.

On May 24th the Island system was connected up and kept working until the 1st of November, and that at the Exhibition Park from the 25th August until 12th Sept.

It is necessary that a light wagon be kept on the Department, so we may have the use of it and any spare horse when required to take material to different parts of the City.

It would also be to the interest of the Department were each of the assistants furnished with a bicycle. Time could be saved in inspecting lines and boxes, and in cases of trouble on the circuits it could be quickly located and removed.

The following is a correct inventory of the property in my charge :

- 1 10-circuit repeater.
- 1 10-circuit switchboard.
- 11 galvanometers.
- 5 large bell strikers.
- 435 cells of battery.
- 110 miles of wire, poles, etc.
- 212 fire alarm boxes.
- 31 gongs.
