DO NOT DETACH TIRE FROM RIM



Elevate the wheel, so as to work from the under side.

Insert the point of tool in puncture.

Turn handle of tool to the right—this forces the solution through the point of tool.

USE PLENTY of the SOLUTION

Withdraw the point slowly, giving it a twisting motion so as to bring the solution

into one mass directly over the puncture.

WHEN THE PUNCTURE IS LARGE

Use the solution in proportion, and after with-



drawing the tool, pinch the tire slightly at the top so that the solution will not spread but remain in a lump directly over the puncture.

Keep the wheel suspended and the repair on the under side.

Allow from five to t-n minutes for drying, according to size of repair.

TO RE-FILL THE TOOL WITH SOLUTION

Turn handle to left—this withdraws the plunger to the end of the barrel.

Unscrew the nozzle end and fill the tool with solution.

CAUTION

Before starting to repair, turn the handle and thus make sure that the solution is ready to flow and that the tool contains enough to make the repair.

See that the solution has not become too dry —if so, add a few drops of benzine—it should be at about the consistency of molasses.
