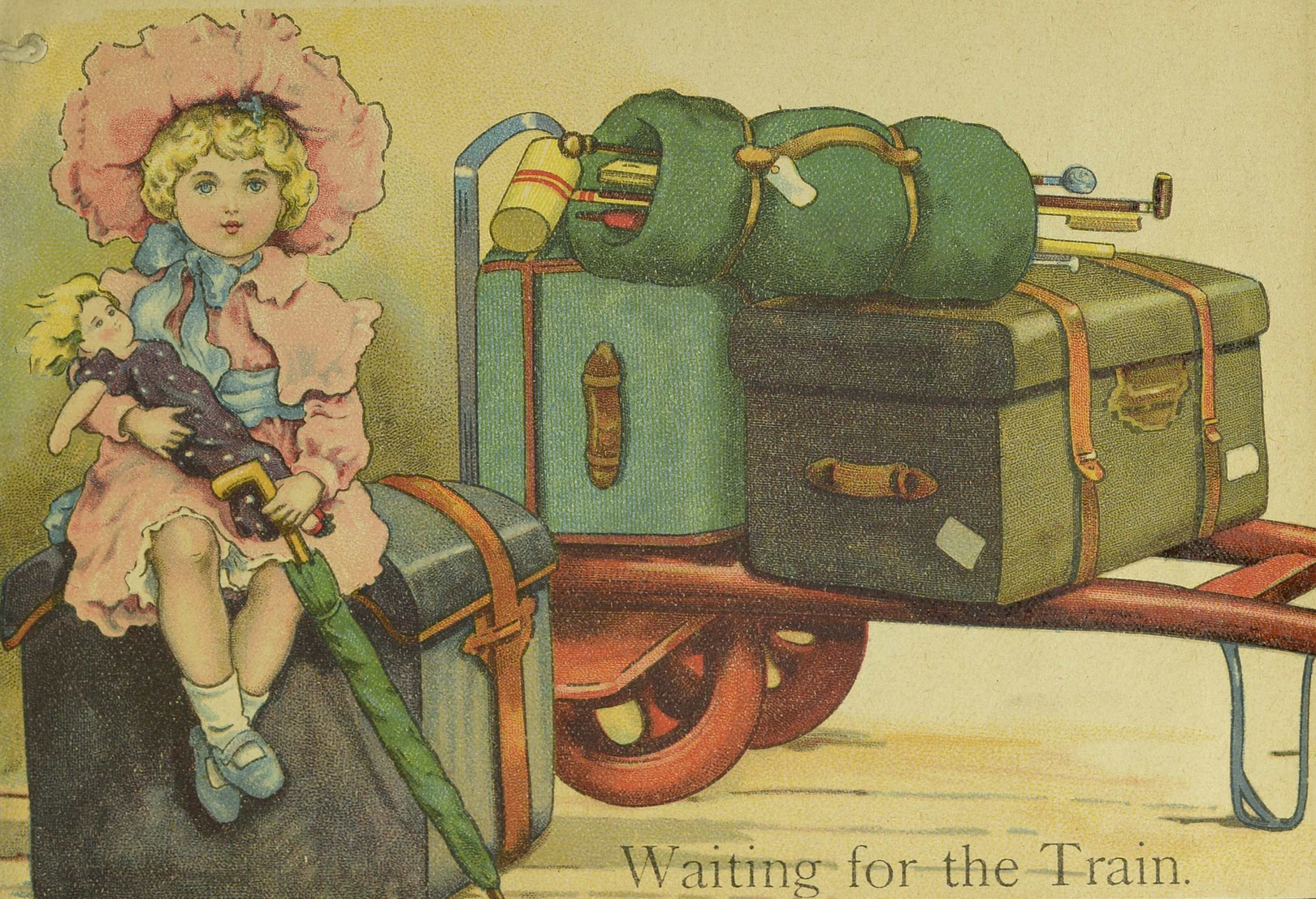

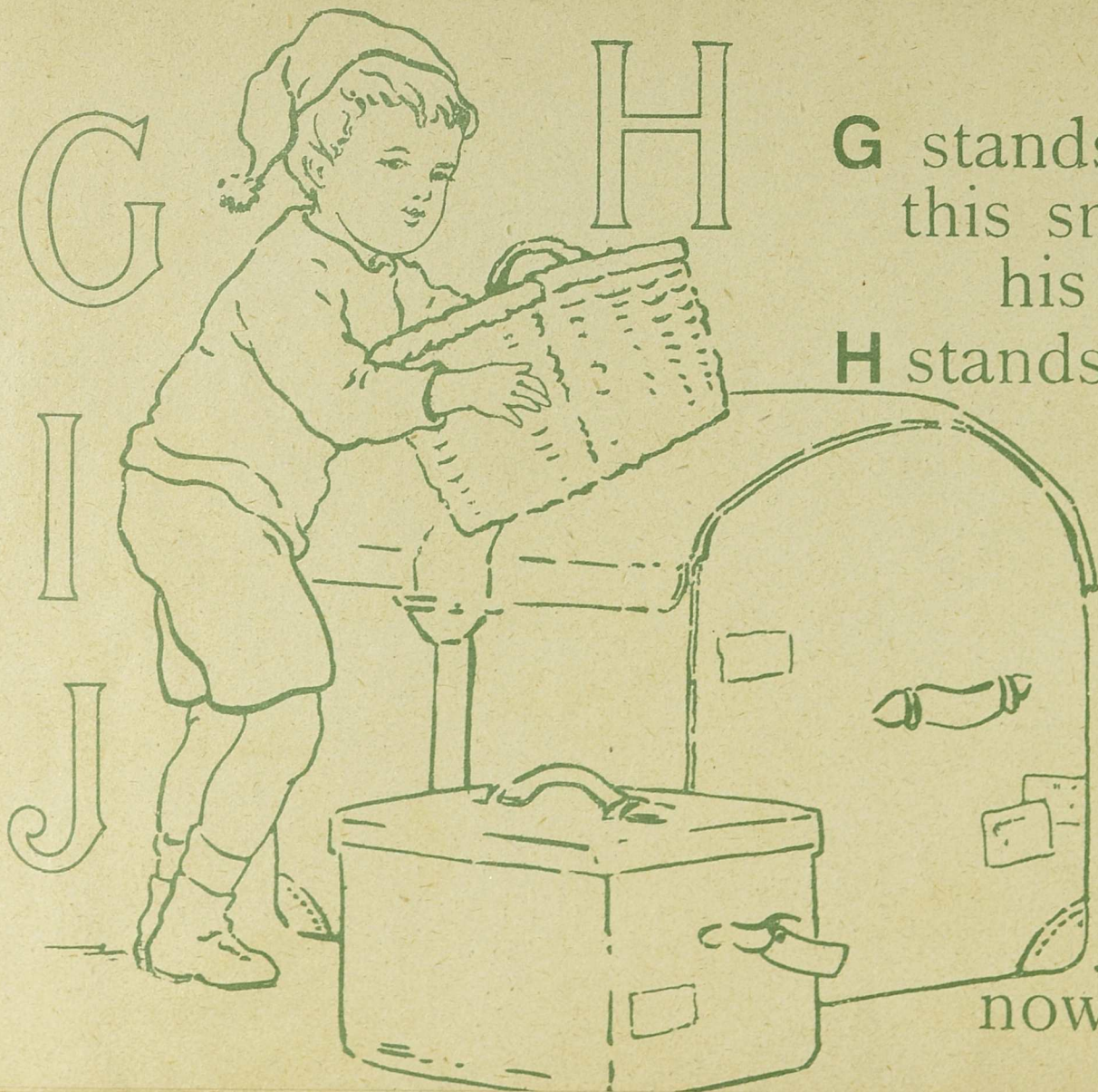

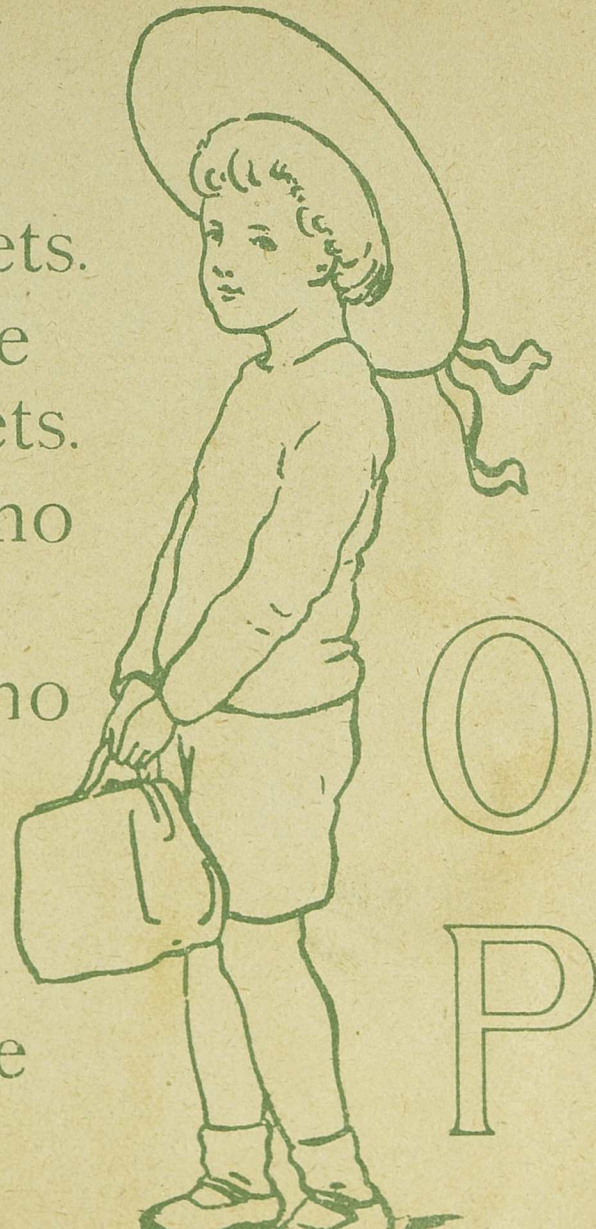

gets such a lot.

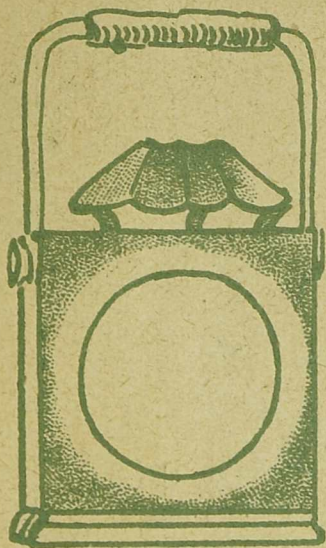
