

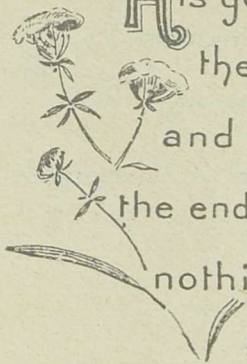

enlightening the eyes.

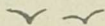
The fear of the Lord is clean,
