

SOMETHING DOING INSIDE

THE history of the Boy's Department of the West End Young Men's Christian Association is a story of rapid and sure growth from its inception to the present day, a growth which is the result of the life and activity which permeates every corner of the Department. For the past three years the boys desiring accommodation have been knocking at the door and pushing on the walls till, at last, bricks and mortar have given way before flesh and blood, with the result that accommodation has been provided for six hundred boys in the new quarters set aside for their exclusive use.

The work will be carried on along the same lines as heretofore, but on a larger scale (the former auditorium having been transformed into a Department for the boys) with better equipment and a few special features added.


BOYS' MEETINGS

S U M M E R W O R K


Includes Summer Camps, Picnics, Outings of all kinds; also Baseball, Football, Lacrosse, Athletics, etc.




