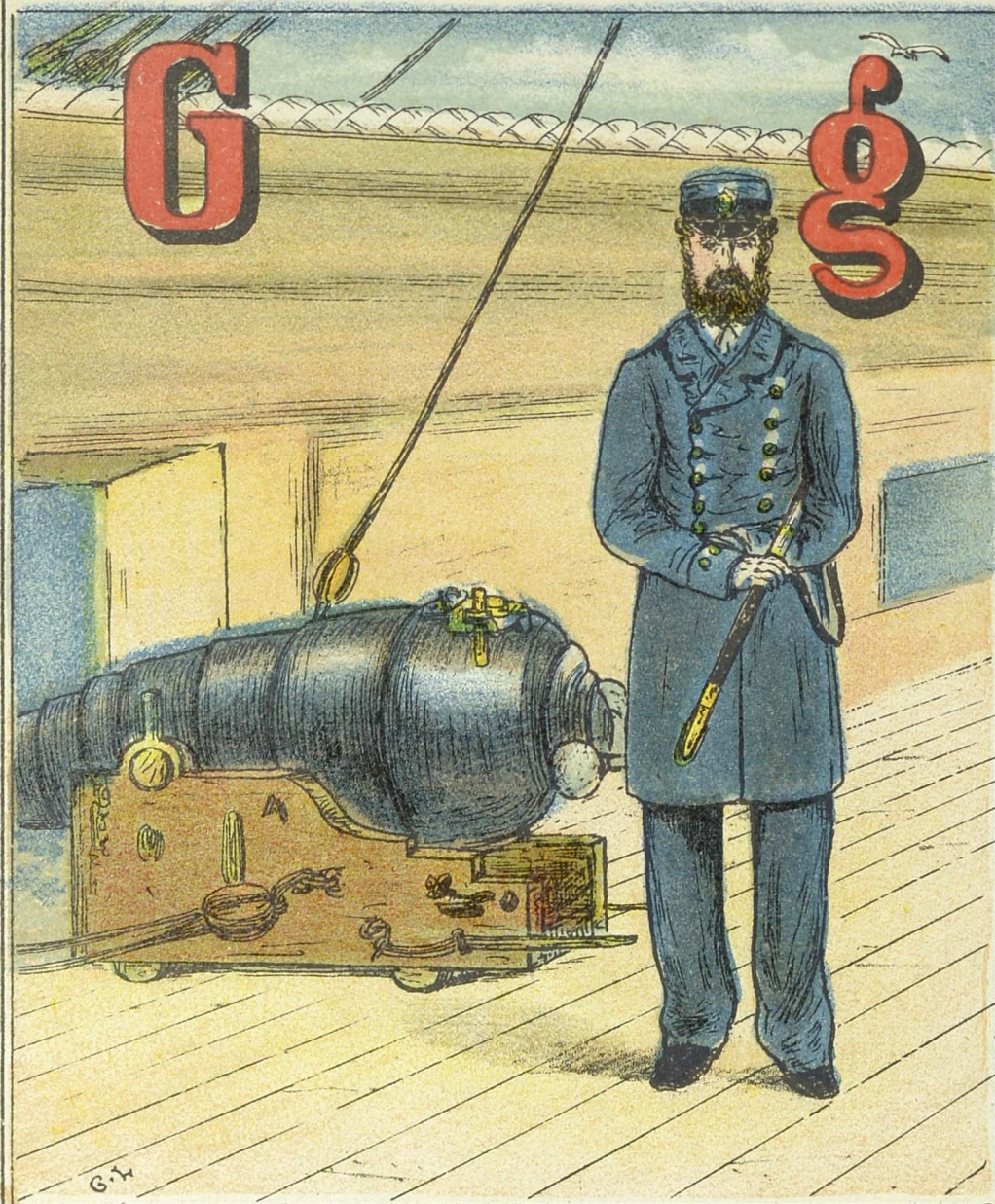
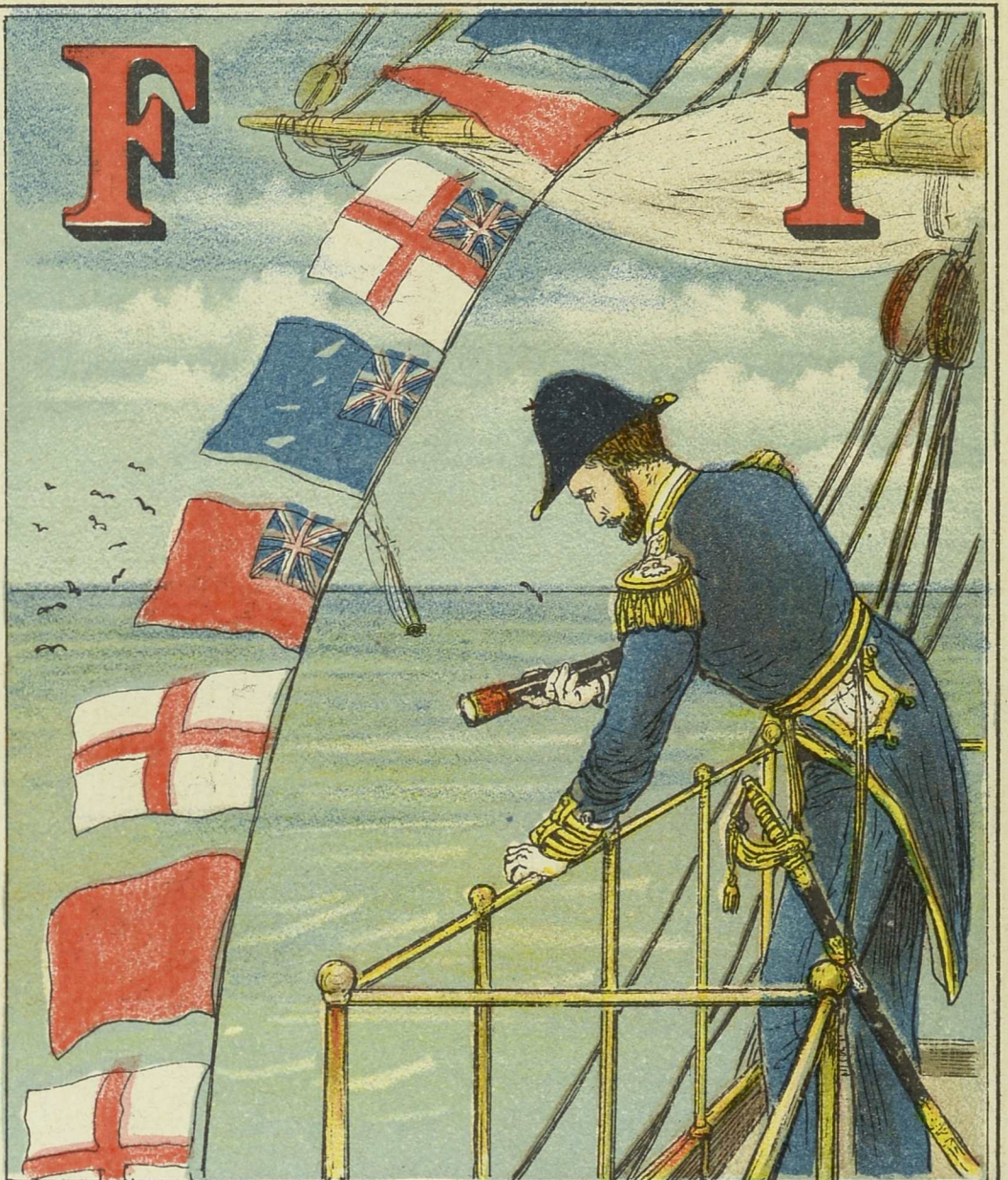
**A** for an ADMIRAL, famous in

wheel.

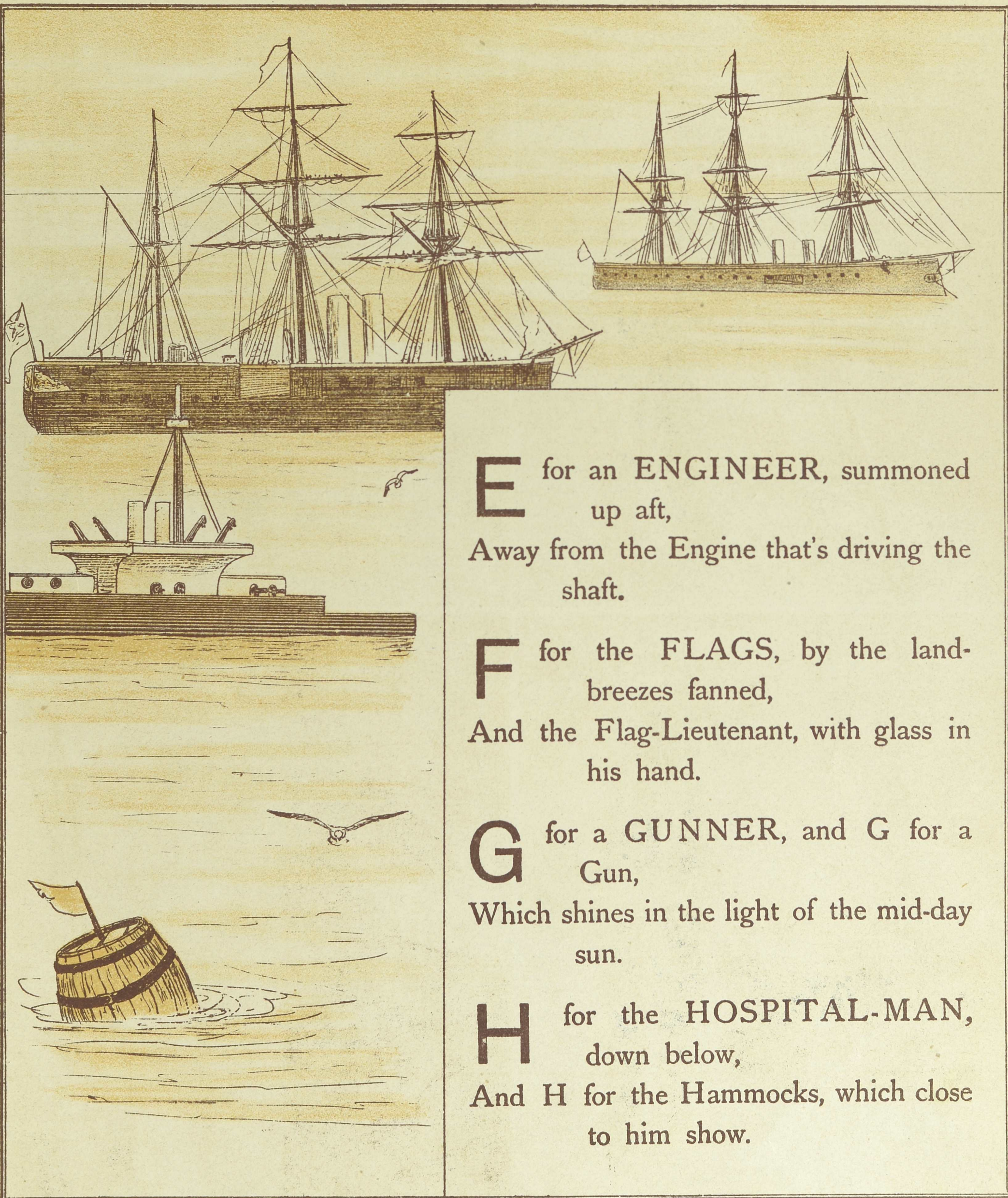
**C** for a CAPTAIN, returned from

boat.









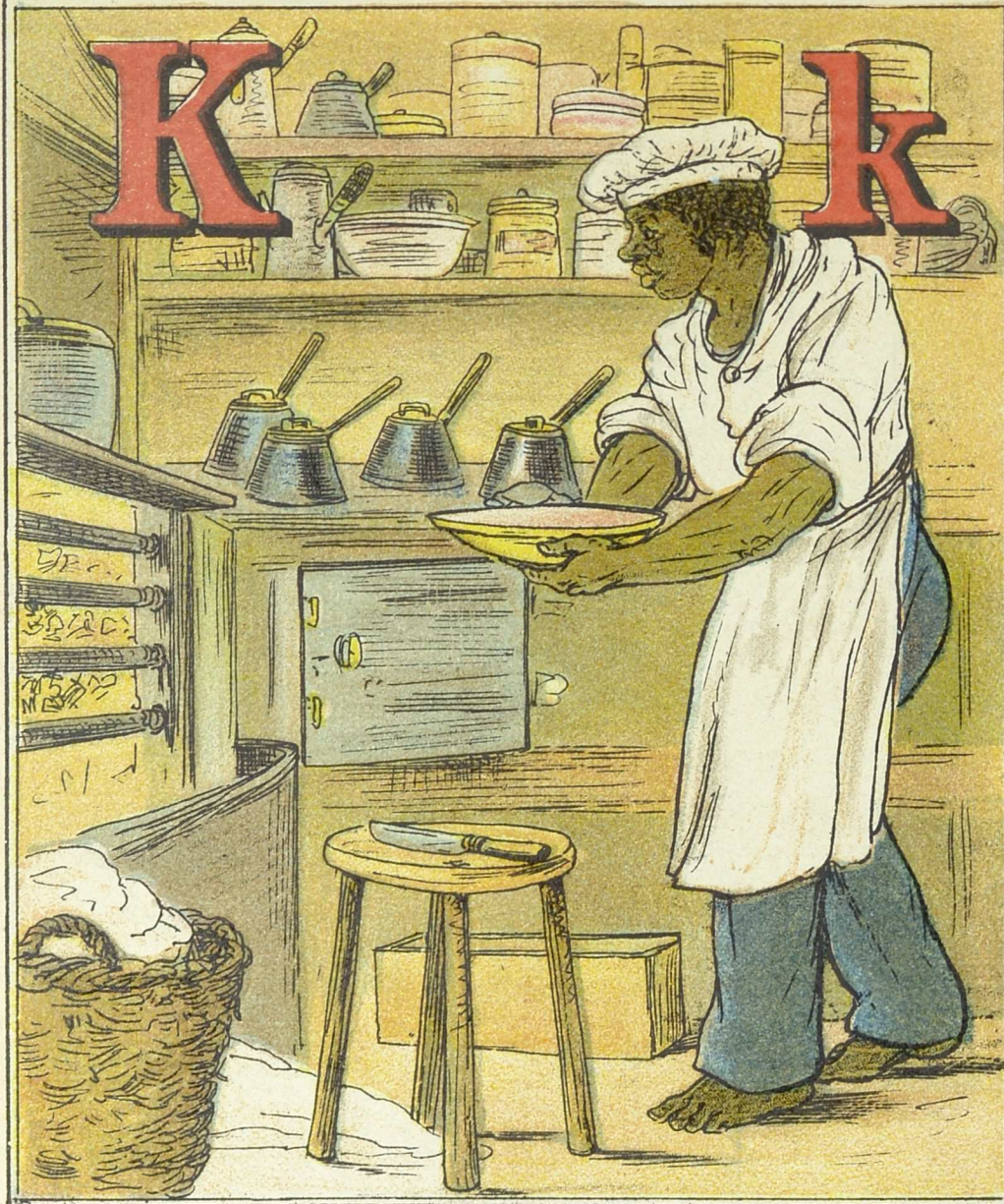
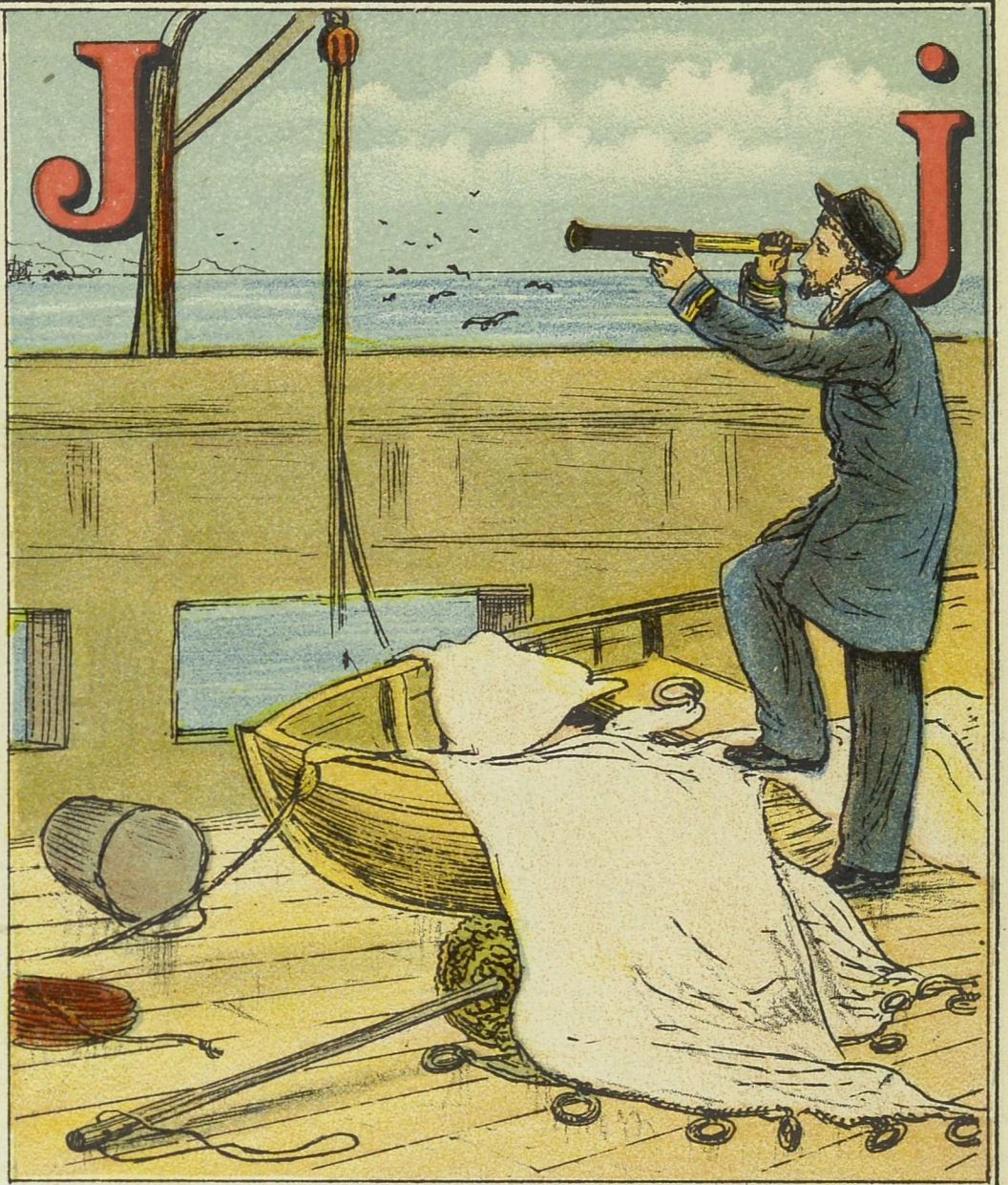
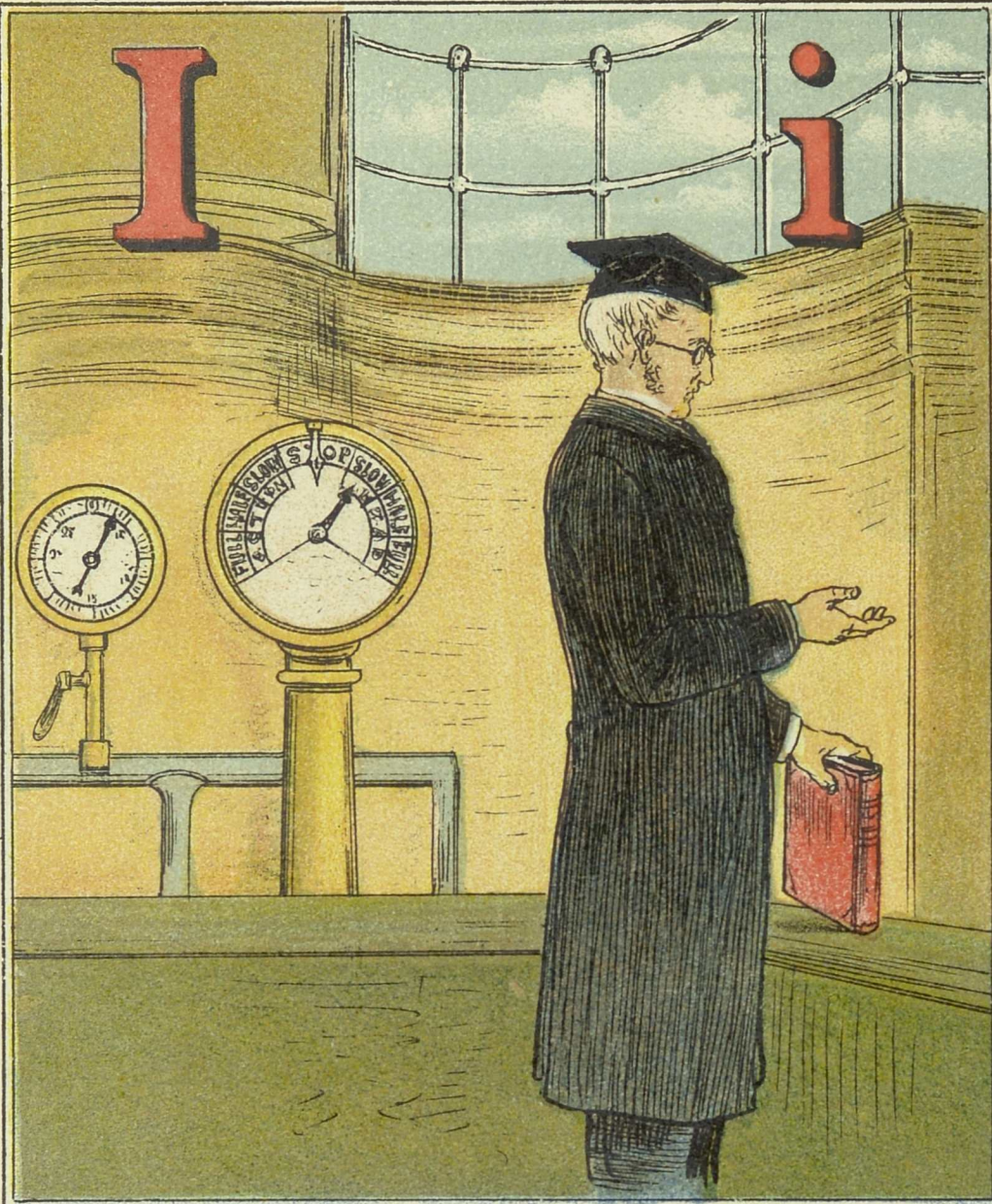
**E** for an ENGINEER, summoned

his hand.

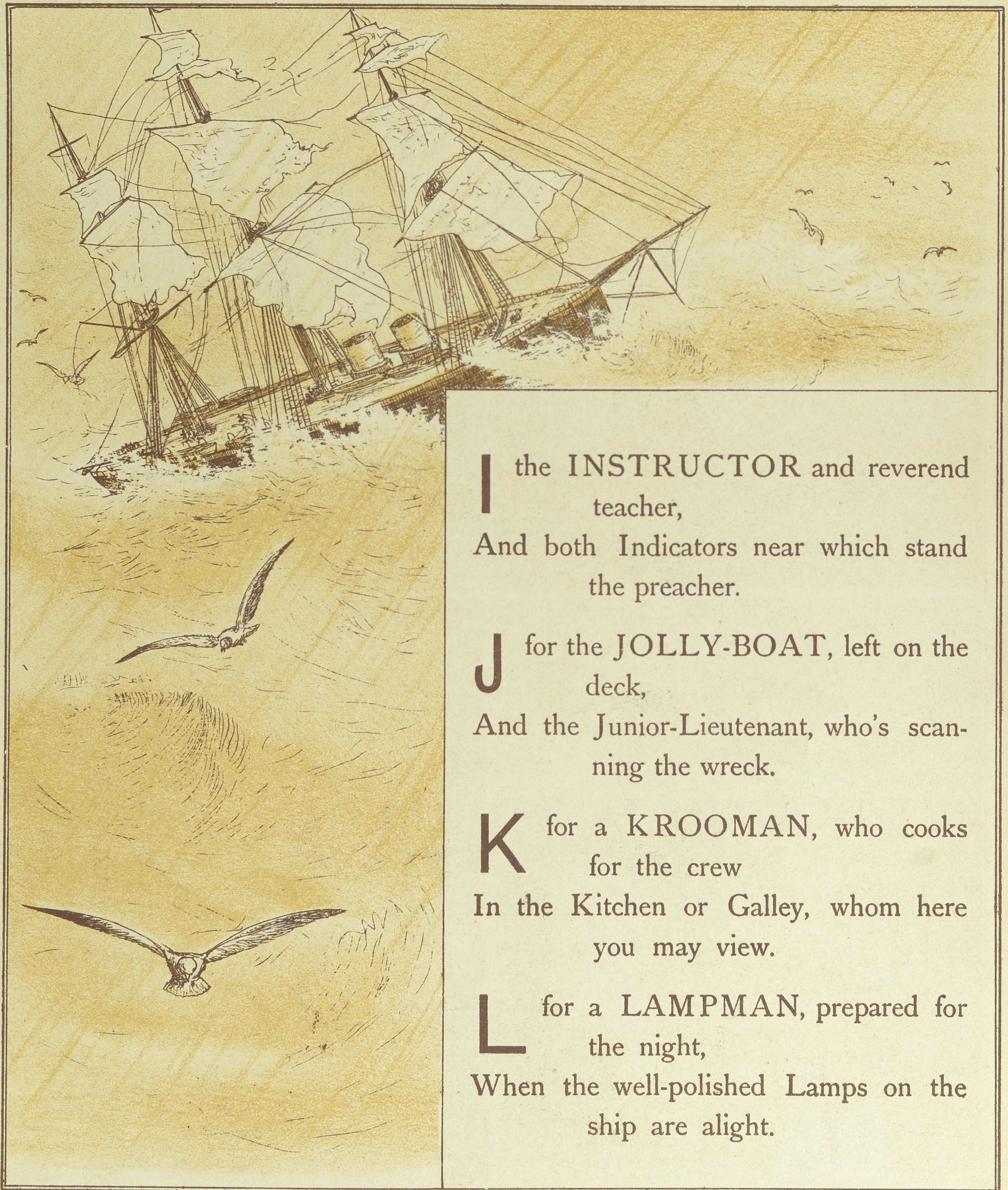
**G** for a GUNNER, and G for a

to him show.









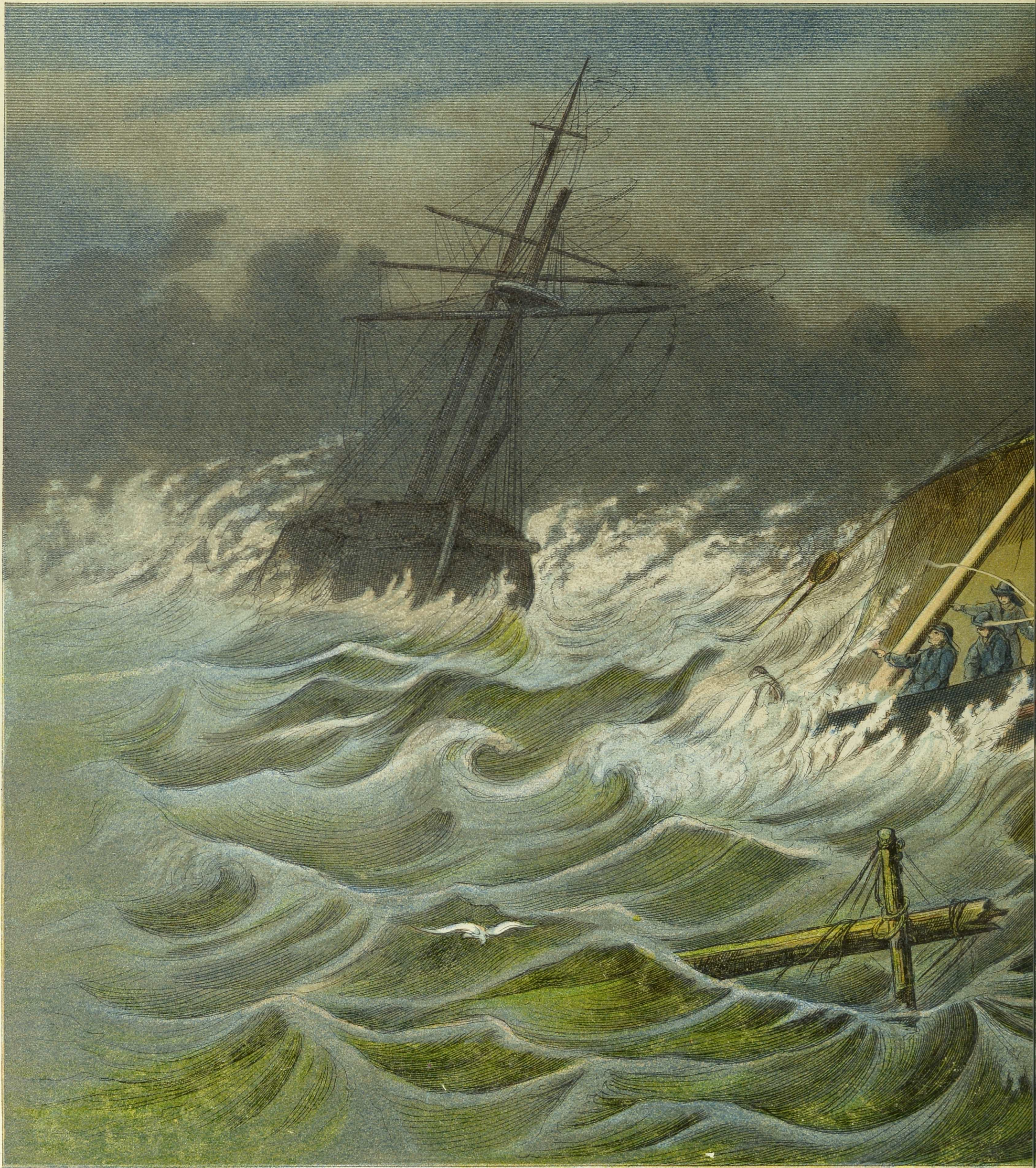
**I** the INSTRUCTOR and reverend

ship are alight.











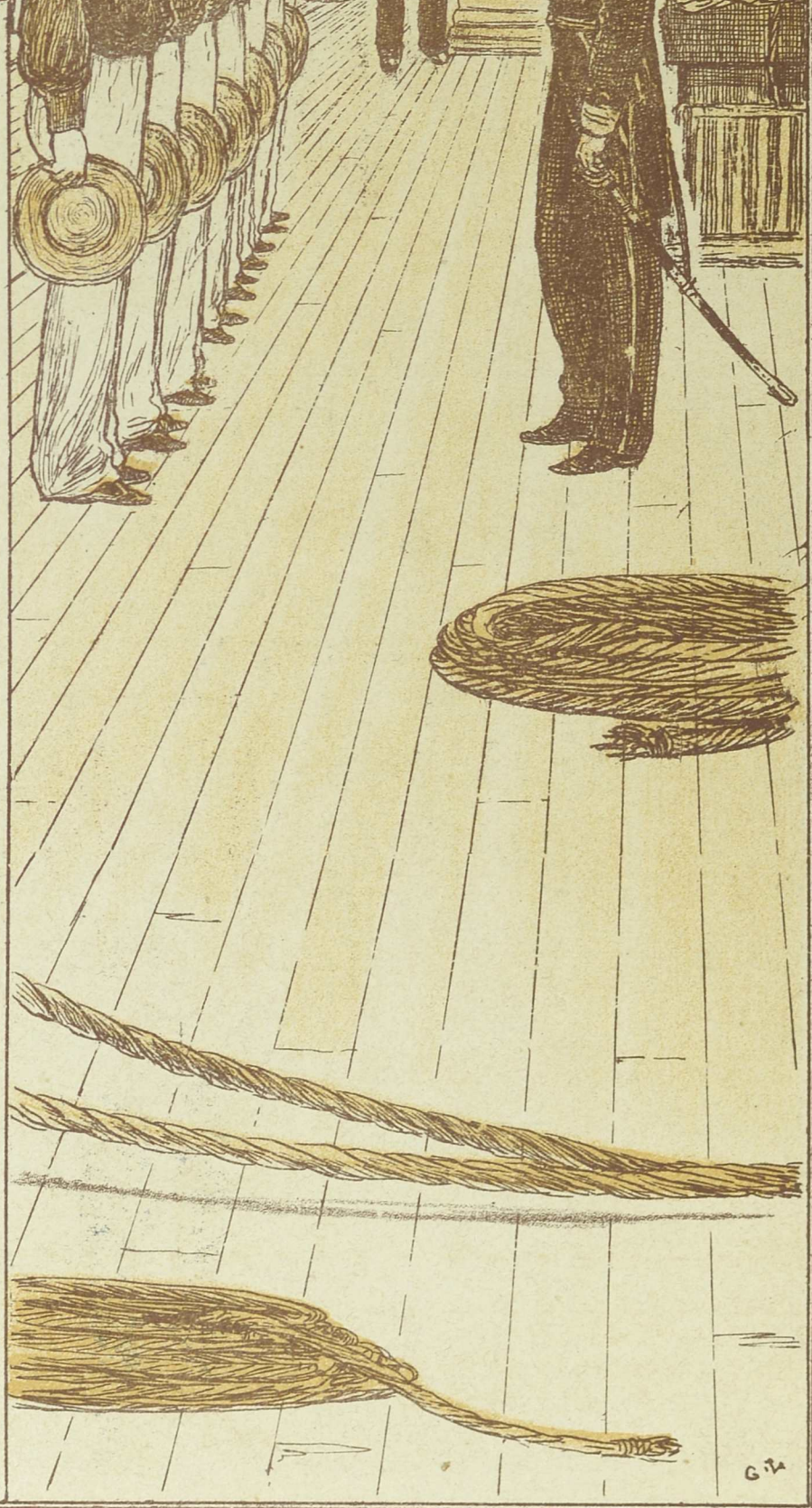


**M** for a MIDSHIPMAN, near to

passed.

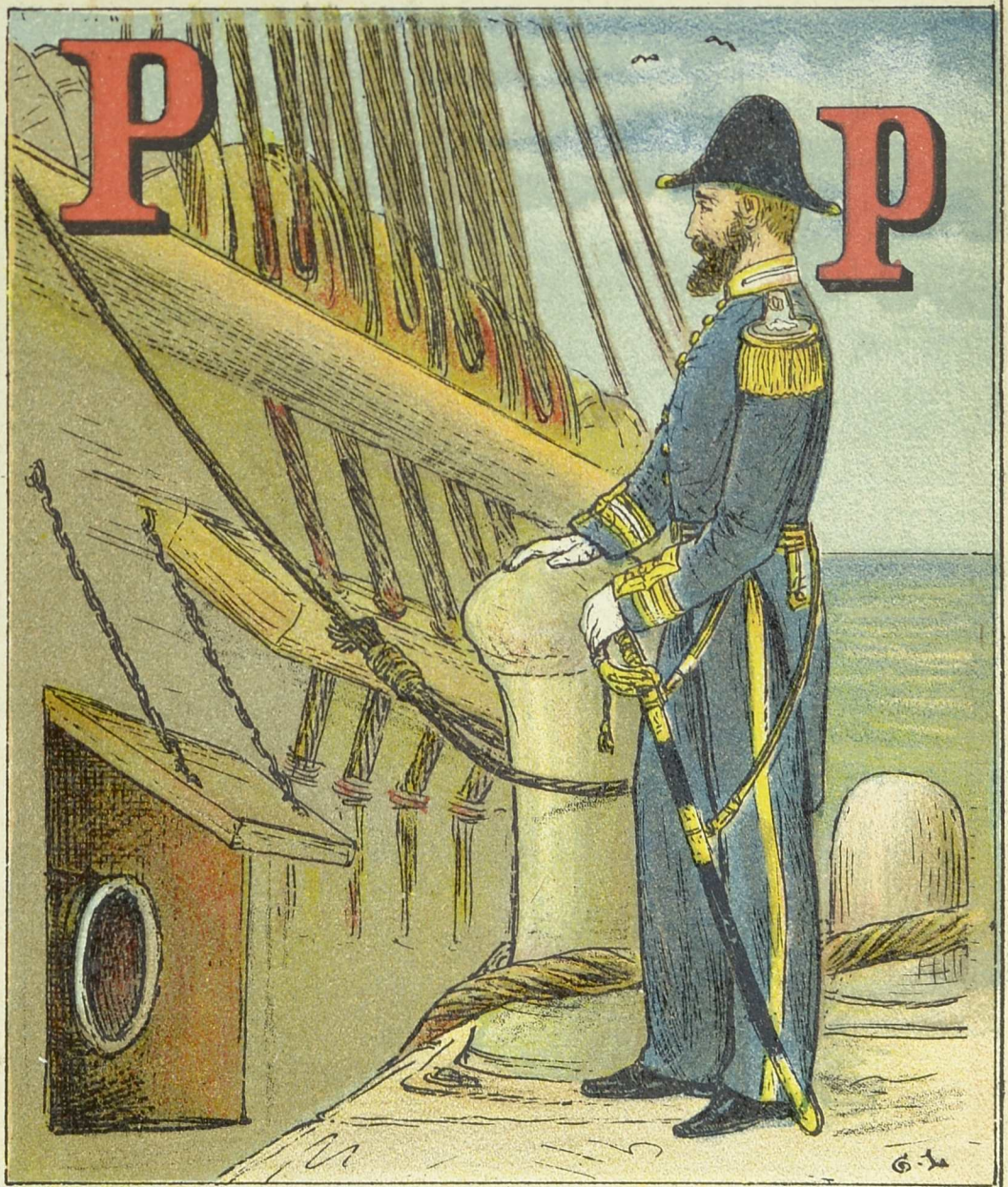
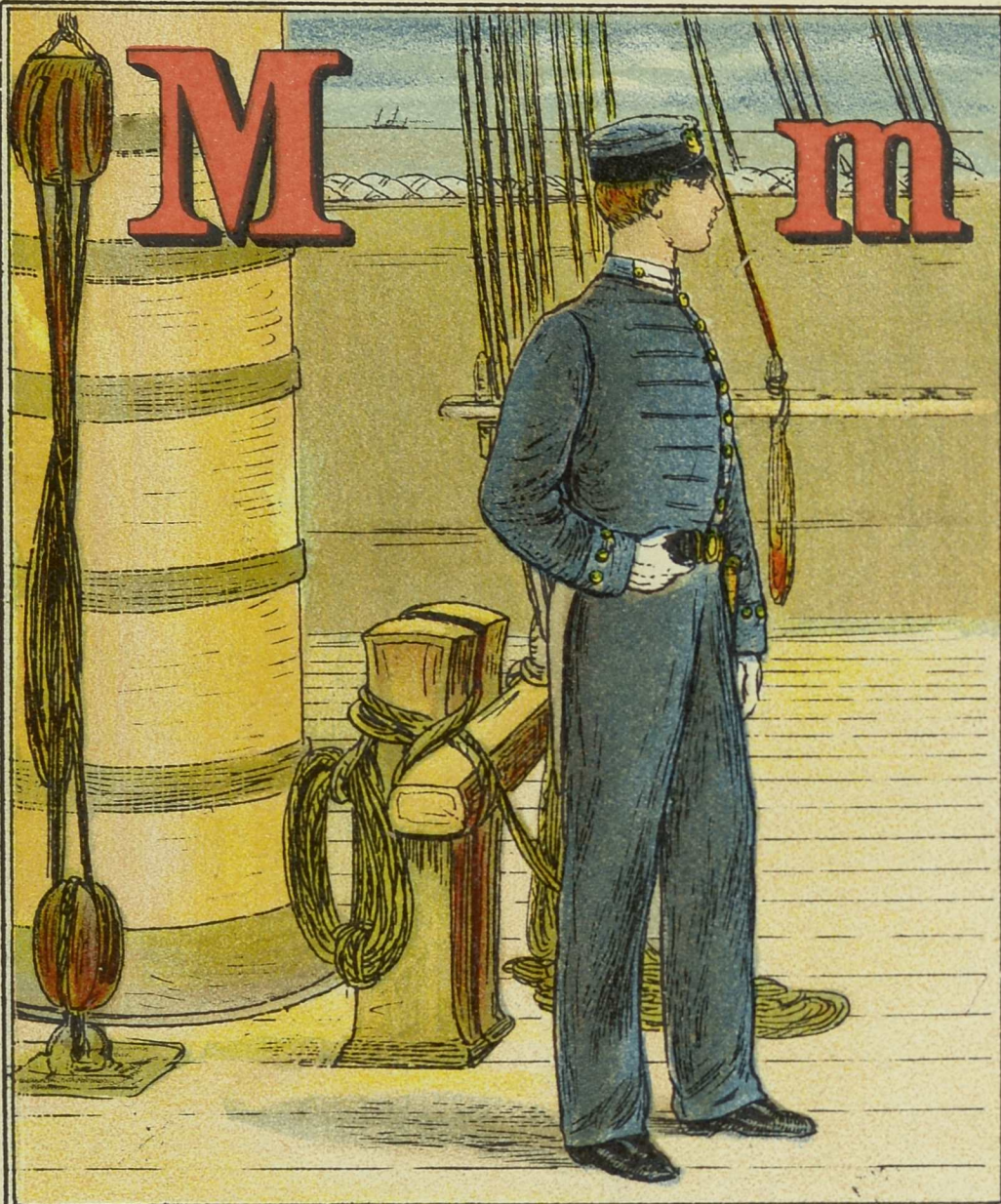
**N** a NAVAL CADET, who has

so wide.







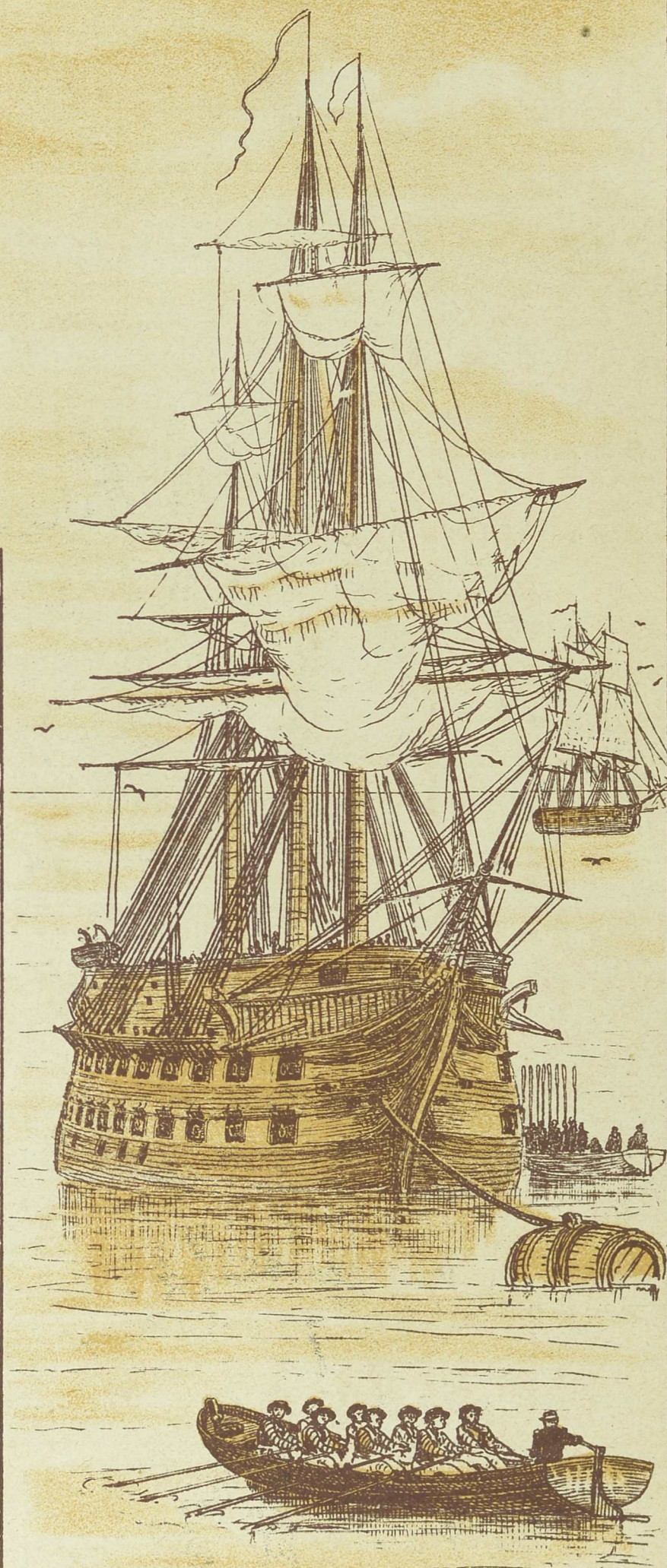


**Q** for the QUARTERDECK, spot-

seen.

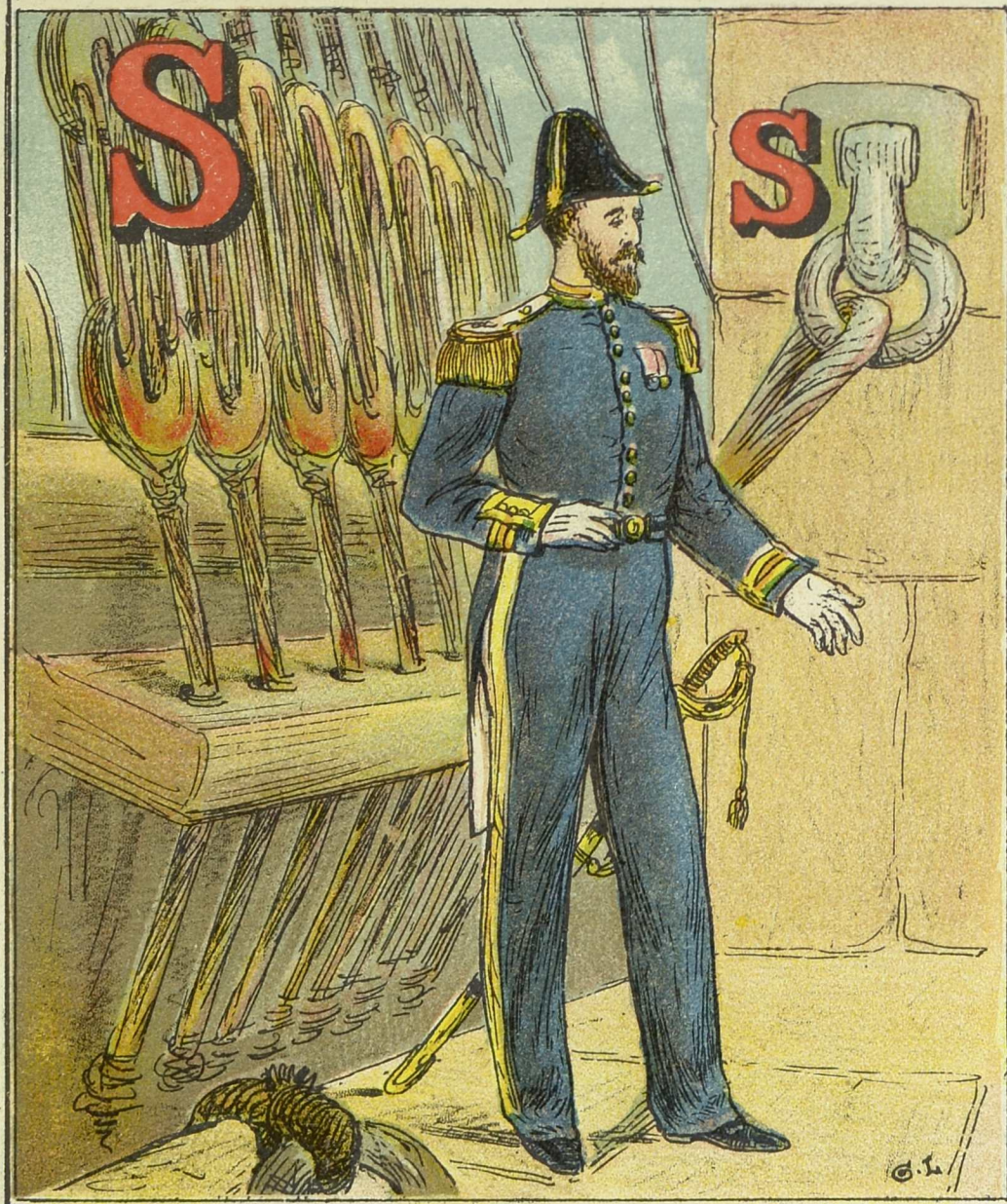
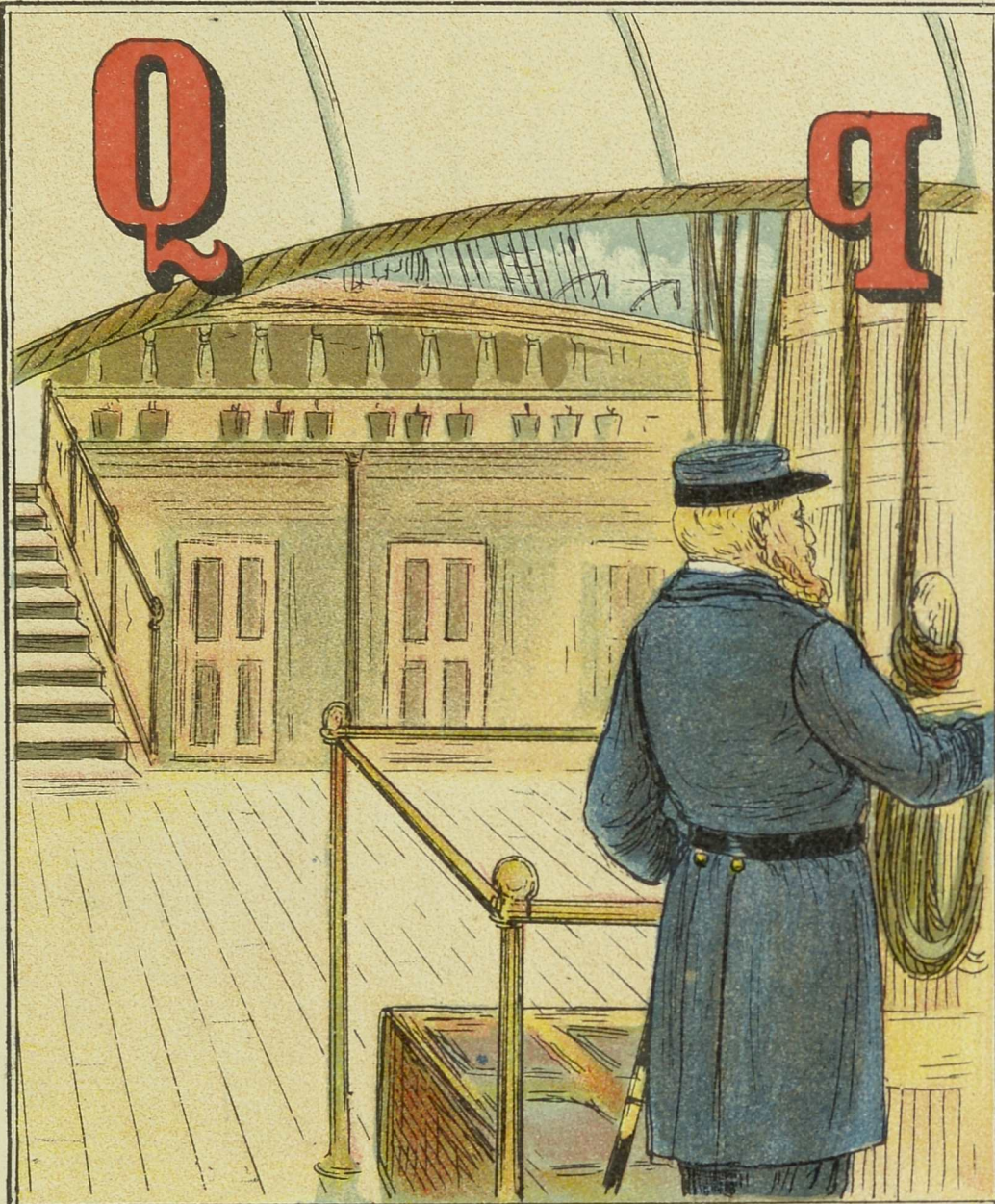
**R** for the RATLINES, which lead

of blue.

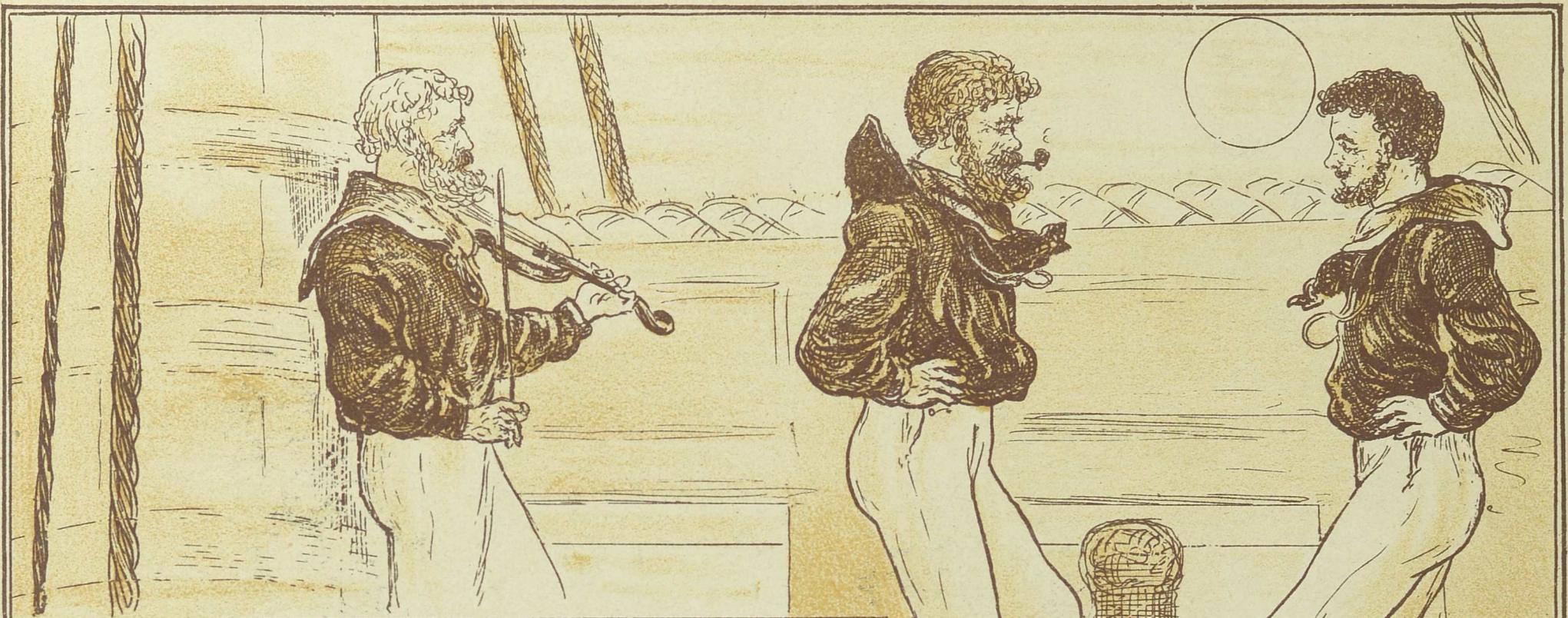
**T** a TOP-GALLANT MAST,

deck.

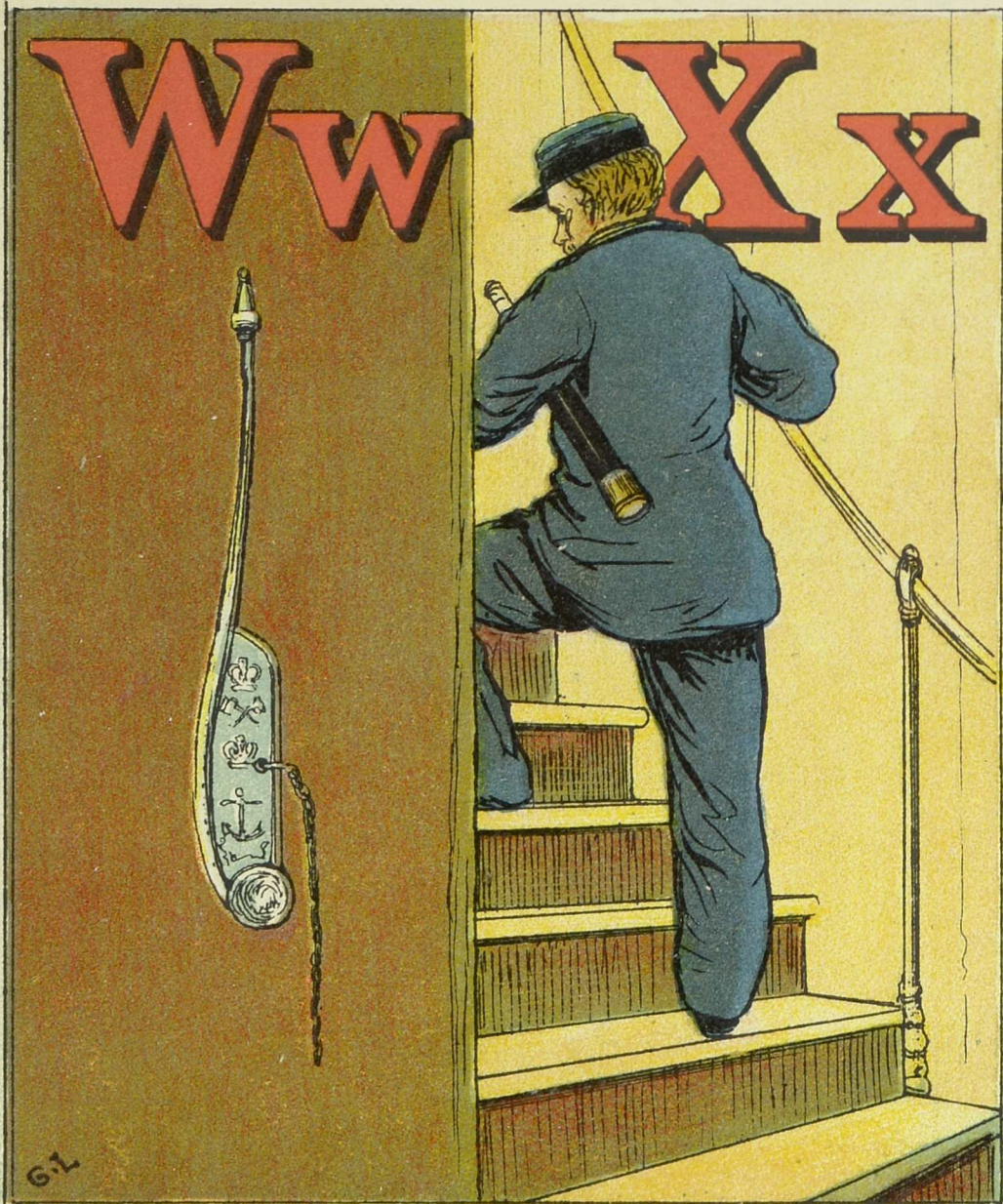
**Y** for the YARD, which is crossing
