

Toronto, 4th March, 1839.

Sir,

I have the honour to enclose a Resolution, passed on the 2nd instant, by the Committee appointed for the restoration of St. James' Church, to which your attention is particularly requested.

"Resolved, That Twenty-five per Cent, being the first Instalment upon the Subscription towards re-building St. James' Church, be called in on the first of April next, payable at the Bank of Upper Canada; and that the Subscribers be requested to furnish Notes, to be given at Three, Six and Nine Months, for the balance, in order that the Committee be prepared to raise Money at the Bank, upon their Security."

To carry this Resolution into effect, you will be called upon for the Instalment, and Notes required, on the day specified.

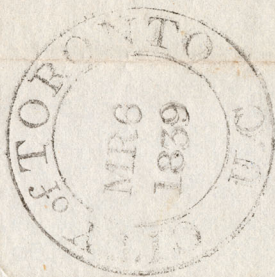
