**BILL.**

An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Mechanics' Institute of the City of Toronto.

WHEREAS for the convenience of the members of ~~results~~  
the Toronto Mechanics' Institute, it is found  
necessary and expedient to alter the time of the annual  
meeting for the election of the Officers and general  
Committee of the said Institute:—Be it therefore en-  
acted, &c.

That the fourth, fifth and seventh clauses of an Act passed  
in the tenth and eleventh years of His Majesty's Reign, <sup>Quebec Act.  
An Act to incorporate the Mechanics' In-  
stitute of the City of Toronto.</sup>  
and intituled, "An Act to incorporate the Mechanics' In-  
stitute of the City of Toronto," shall be, and the same  
are hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That the annual meeting for the  
election of Officers and Members to compose the said  
general Committee of the said Corporation, shall be held  
at the place at which the usual meetings of the said Cor-  
poration are held, on the first Monday in May in each  
and every year, and not on the first Monday in November  
<sup>or December</sup> heretofore: Provided always, that whenever the <sup>first</sup> ~~fourth~~  
said first Monday in May shall happen on a Saturday  
holiday, the said annual meeting shall take place in the  
nearest business day provided, and the said Officers and  
Members theron elected shall serve in the said office  
during the year then next ensuing, and until others being  
elected in their stead shall enter upon the discharge of  
the duties of their office as hereinbefore provided; and if  
by reason of any unforeseen matter or thing cause, the  
election so to be had and made on the first Monday in  
May as aforesaid shall be prevented or shall not be had  
or made, then and in every such case it shall be compre-  
hended to the members of the said Corporation, and their  
successors, or to the major part of such as may be pres-  
ent at a meeting to be called by the President or Vice-  
President for the time being, and held as soon after as  
shall be convenient, given days' notice being first given,  
to proceed to and make the election of a President, Vice-  
President, Secretary, a Treasurer, a Librarian and  
Cabinet Keeper; and twelve of the Members with the  
Officers aforesaid, shall constitute and form the general  
Committee as aforesaid, and the election so made shall  
be as valid and effectual as if it had been made on such  
first Monday in May: Provided always, that the Presi-  
dent, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Librarian

and Cabinet Keeper, with the other twelve Members aforesaid to be elected at any general election of Officers under and by virtue of the provisions of this Act, shall not enter upon nor act in the discharge of their respective offices until the Monday next ensuing after such general election; And provided also, that the present Officers and Committee elected on the first Monday in November last, shall hold their office until the Monday next after the first Monday in May, one thousand eight hundred and fifty one, or until the Monday next after such general election as hereinbefore provided, any thing in the said recited Act contained to the contrary thereof notwithstanding.

III. And it is enacted, That the said Corporation shall consist of an indefinite number of ordinary, life, corresponding, and honorary Members, all of whom shall be chosen according to the form, and under the restrictions and conditions hereinafter prescribed, that is to say,—the ordinary Members being those who shall pay and contribute to the funds of the said Corporation such annual go subscription as may from time to time be required by the By-laws, rules and regulations of the said Corporation; the life Members being those who shall pay or contribute to the funds of the said Corporation, the sum of ten pounds in one sum, or who shall make a donation in the purchase of Books, Apparatus, or other useful articles equal at least to that sum;—the corresponding Members being those who reside at a distance from the City of Tercio, but who shall have no vote at any of the Meetings of the said Corporation, and shall not be eligible to any of the Offices thereof, and Honorary Members being those only who being distinguished for services rendered shall be admitted without payment, to all the privileges enjoyed by ordinary Members except the right of voting at the election of the said general Committee; Provided always, that all such persons as shall be new Members of the said Corporation shall continue to be such and shall be ordinary, life, corresponding or Honorary Members of the said Corporation according as they shall respectively be within the provisions of this section as respects their admission as Members of the said Corporation.

And be it further enacted, That the said Corporation shall have an official seal, which shall consist of a shield containing a plough, a sheaf of wheat, and two bunches of grapes, supported by two griffins, and above the shield a crest, and a motto, and that the said seal shall be engraved in gold, and the same shall be used by the said Corporation in all its acts, and shall be a sufficient evidence of the authority of the Corporation to bind the same.
