Sir,

I beg to intimate, that I have recently augmented my Stock, by a very large importation of Cases and General Services, which will be found well worthy the attention of Families, as they have been selected with great care, and particularly with the view of obtaining a more extensive Family Trade.

Since I completed my purchases in New York, an extraordinary rise has taken place in the price of Tea; and the same descriptions cannot now be bought, except at an advance of from 40 to 45 cents per lb. This upward movement in Tea is mainly attributable to the unfavourable returns lately received from China, which show the exportation to America alone, from July 1st to September 30th of the present year, to have been 7,000,000 lbs. less than in the corresponding period of 1852. This fact, viewed in conjunction with the continued progress of the immigration in that country, will have the effect of still further stimulating the Tea Affection; but considering the favourable terms on which my present extensive Stock was purchased, I shall be enabled to offer Teas during the Winter at lower prices than they can be bought Wholesale in New York.

My Stock of Cutlery, likewise, comprises the finest qualities in the market, and particular attention is bestowed upon its preparation for sale—the being being treated on an improved scientific principle, in order to preserve the weapons as perfect as the highest quality of the article.

I would also direct attention to the Dry Goods Department, which is on a very extensive scale,—embracing every style and variety of the season.

I respectfully solicit a perusal of the List of Prices annexed, believing that they will be found as low, if not lower than those of any similar Establishment; while the quality of every article is unexceptionable.
