

An interval of half a year is supposed to have elapsed between the last Midsummer Holidays and the rising of the Curtain.





Master Jacky's Holidays




Here you have him celebrating his arrival (to the disturbance of M^r. Pinocchio)

Here you have him, on a wet day, bored to death.




*He has read all the books

Here Mr. Wormwood Scrubbs arrives in a peculiar temper and is congratulated by Mr. Phoenix on his blooming appearance.




Grand evening rehearsal of the Miller and his Men,

teaching him to smoke.




Here you have 'old Bradshaw under,

Here he bolsters 'old' Bradshaw,




over the head of Mr. Wornwood Scrubbs.

of Ruggles with a burnt stick.




M^r. Ruggles relates in the kitchen what that 'air boy has bin and done.
