After many trials and temptations, the pilgrims reach the River of Death and gaze at the glories of the Celestial city on the other side.

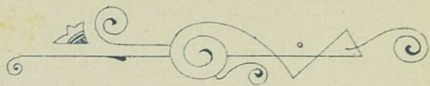
When they enter the river, Christian begins to sink, but Hopeful encourages and helps him till they reach the other side in safety. Two angels then conduct them to the gate of the city.

The glories of the sky.

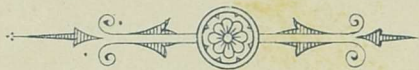
IN HEAVEN
