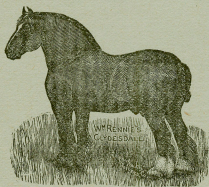

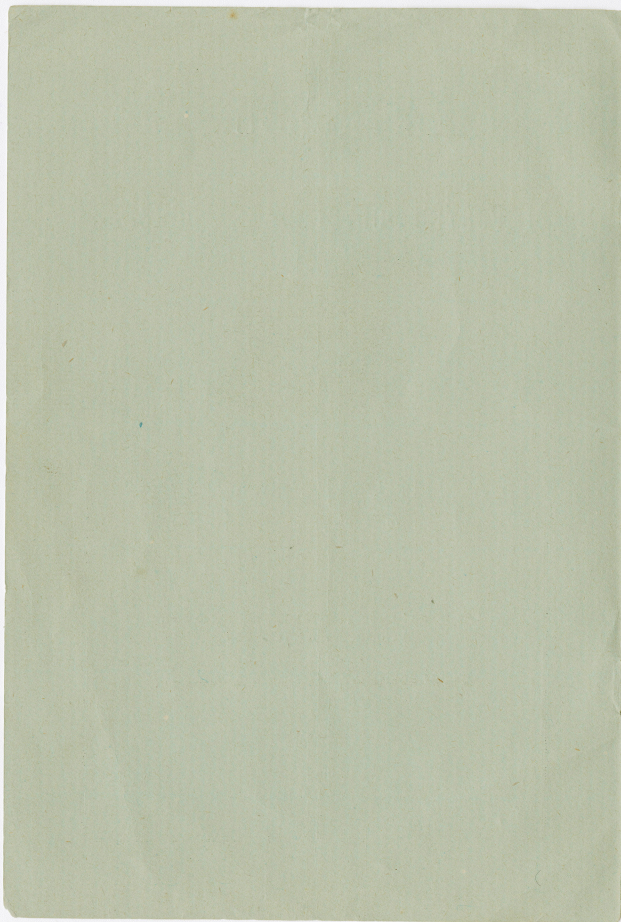

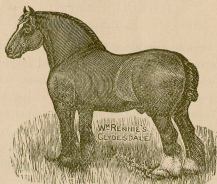

ANNOUNCEMENT.

WM. RENNIE begs to announce that having sold his farm, he will sell the whole of his imported Clydesdale Horses and Implements by auction.

The Clydesdales are a superior lot, having been selected in Scotland by the Proprietor personally. The two fillies rising four years old won 1st Prize at the Toronto Exhibition last September as a team, also first at other local shows. Two of the fillies rising two years old won both 1st and 2nd Prizes in Toronto, and the stallion "Richmond" won 2nd prize at Toronto in a ring of 24 imported two-year olds, although he had only landed a short time from Scotland. I also offer for sale "Minnie," one of the smallest and handsomest Shetland ponies in Canada. The Implements are all nearly new.

For some years past there has been a large demand for brood mares of the Clydesdale type from breeders in the United States, and as a result, there is a scarcity in this country at present. This will be a favorable opportunity for securing mares of high merit for breeding purposes.

Luncheon will be provided at 11 o'clock. Sale to commence at 12. The farm is situated 15 miles north from Toronto, three miles from the Villages of Thornhill and Richmond Hill on the Northern Railway, and five miles from Unionville on the Midland Railway. Persons intending to come by those railways will please communicate several days before the sale, and arrangements will be made to drive them to the farm and back in time for evening trains.

Terms:—For all sums of \$10 and under, cash; over that amount, seven months credit will be given on furnishing approved joint notes. A discount of 6 per cent. per annum allowed for cash.

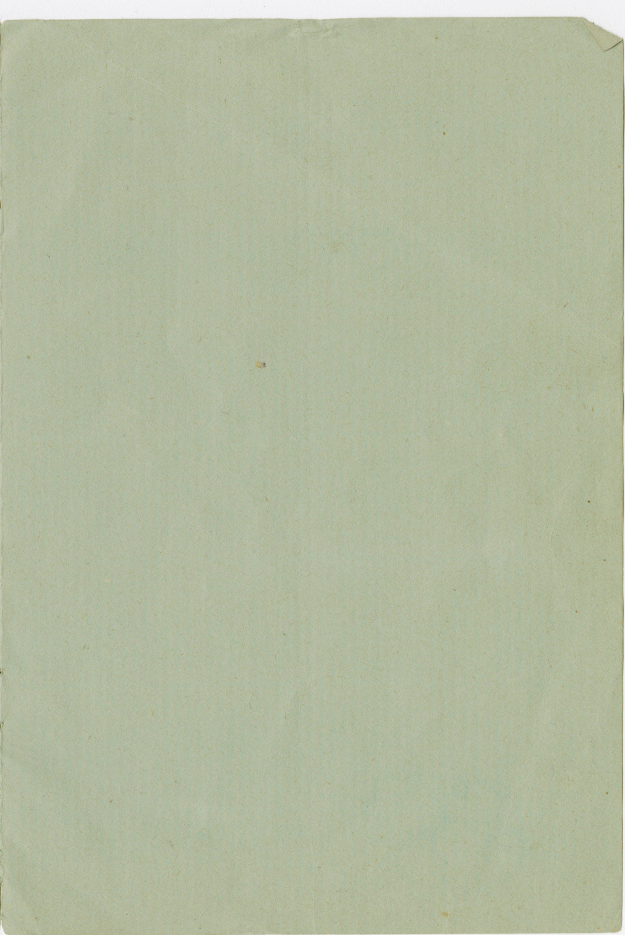
