Moved by Mr. Combe, seconded by Mr. Whittingham, and resolved

That the Institutes abould be recognized as essential parts of the educational system of the Province, and as entitled to public support equally with the Public Schools and the High Schools.

Moved by Mr. Forrester, (Mayor of Clinton) seconded by Mr. McGarva, and resolved,

That the functions of the Public Institute should be to furnish to the municipality to which it belongs the benefits of a public library, a reading room, evening classes, and a scientific museum, open to all persons on reasonable terms.

Moved by Mr. Hine, seconded by Mr. Stevenson, (Town Councillor) and resolved,

That the local municipality should be required to farmish, in return for the benefits accruing to it, suitable accommodation for the Institute, and also to contribute yearly to its finds an amount equal to one half of the amount which the Institute receives from the Provincial Treasury.
