fight outside — — —

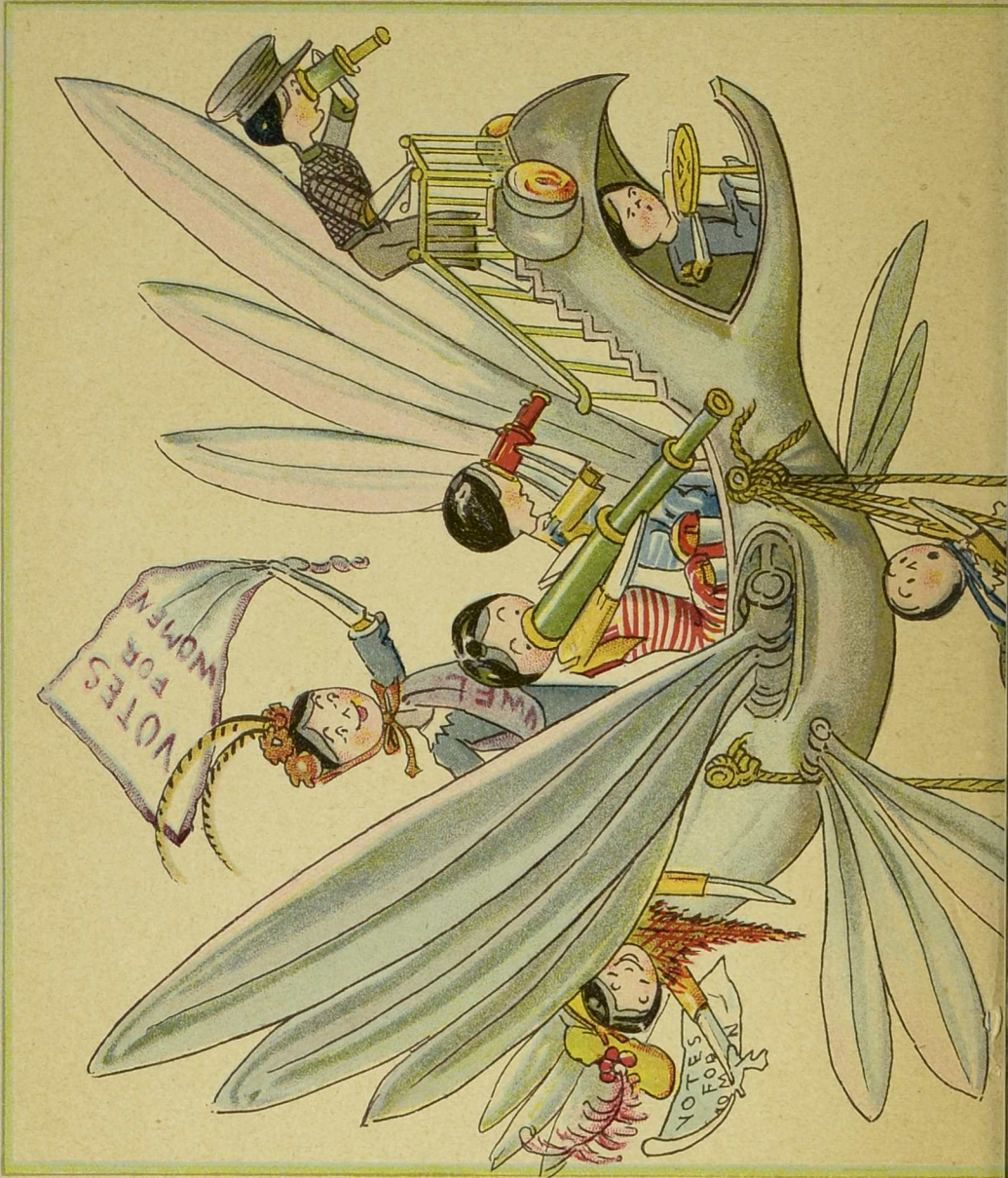


Then we had an awfully

Yah!!!!!!

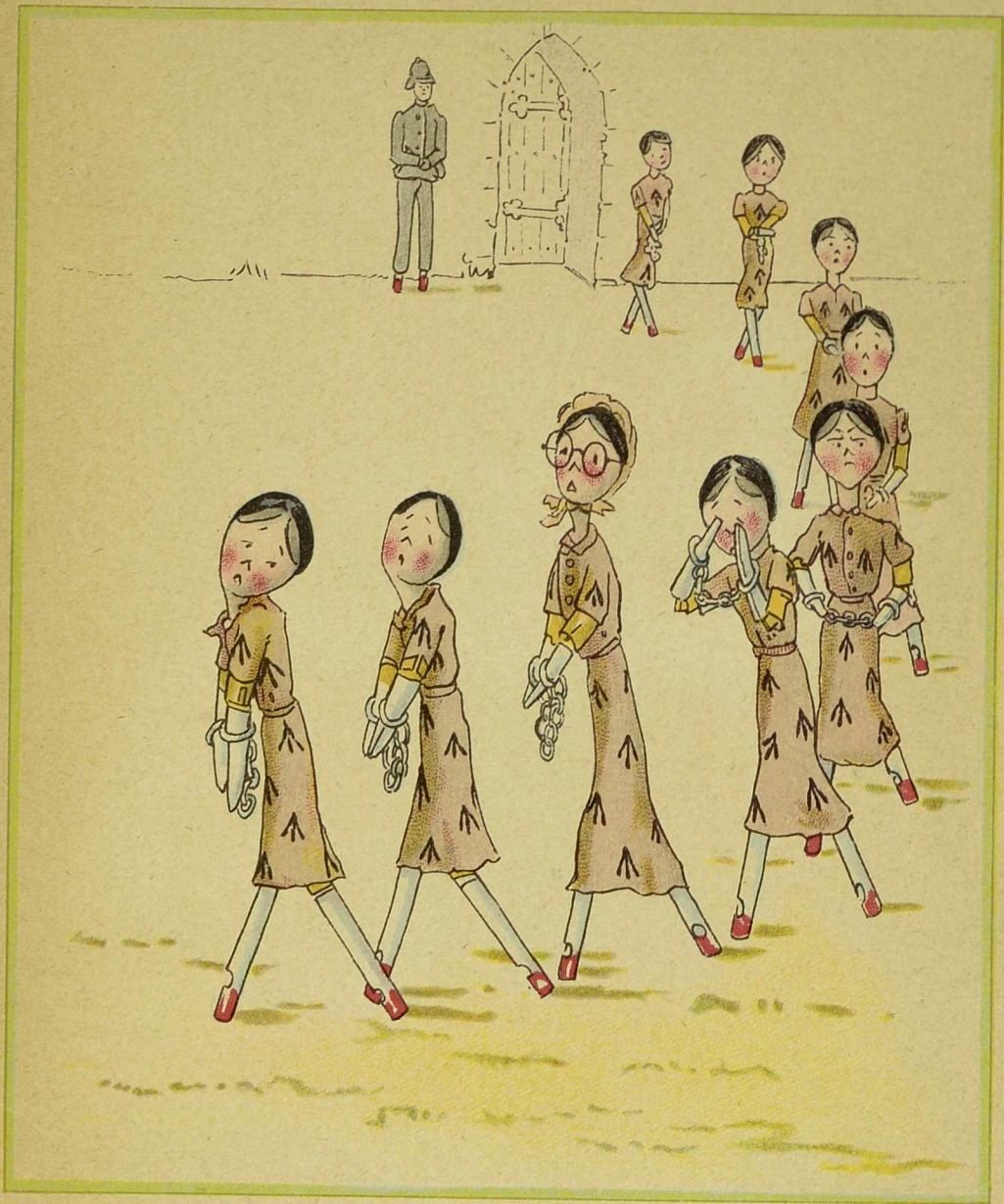


Take it away! — — —
