Too great a temptation.

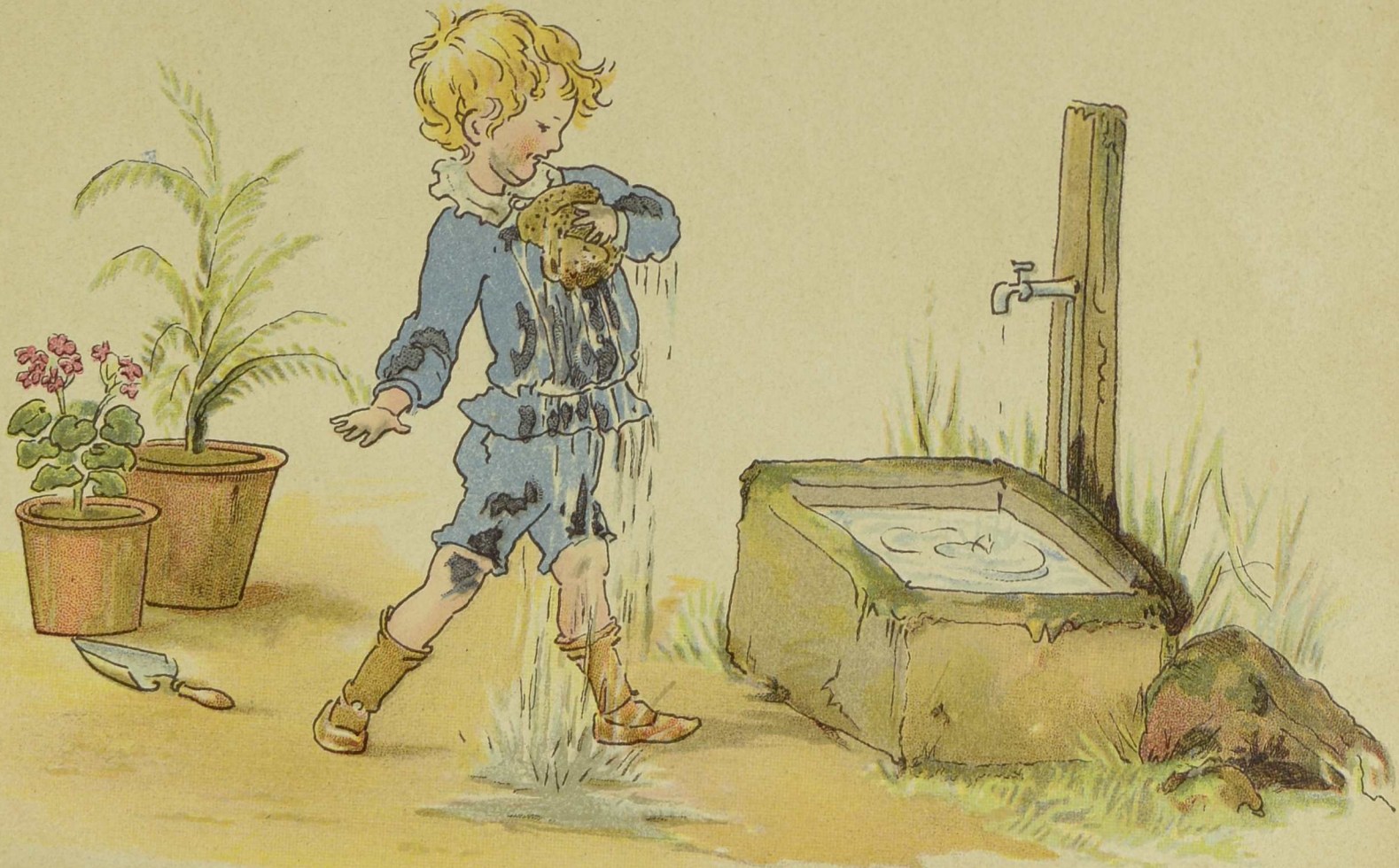
The unexpected happens!

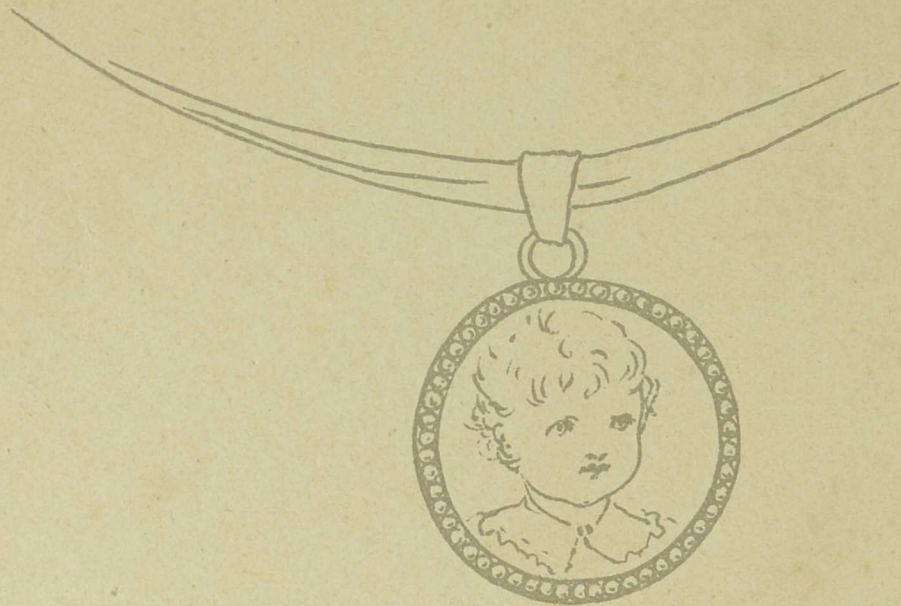
