and there \_\_\_\_\_



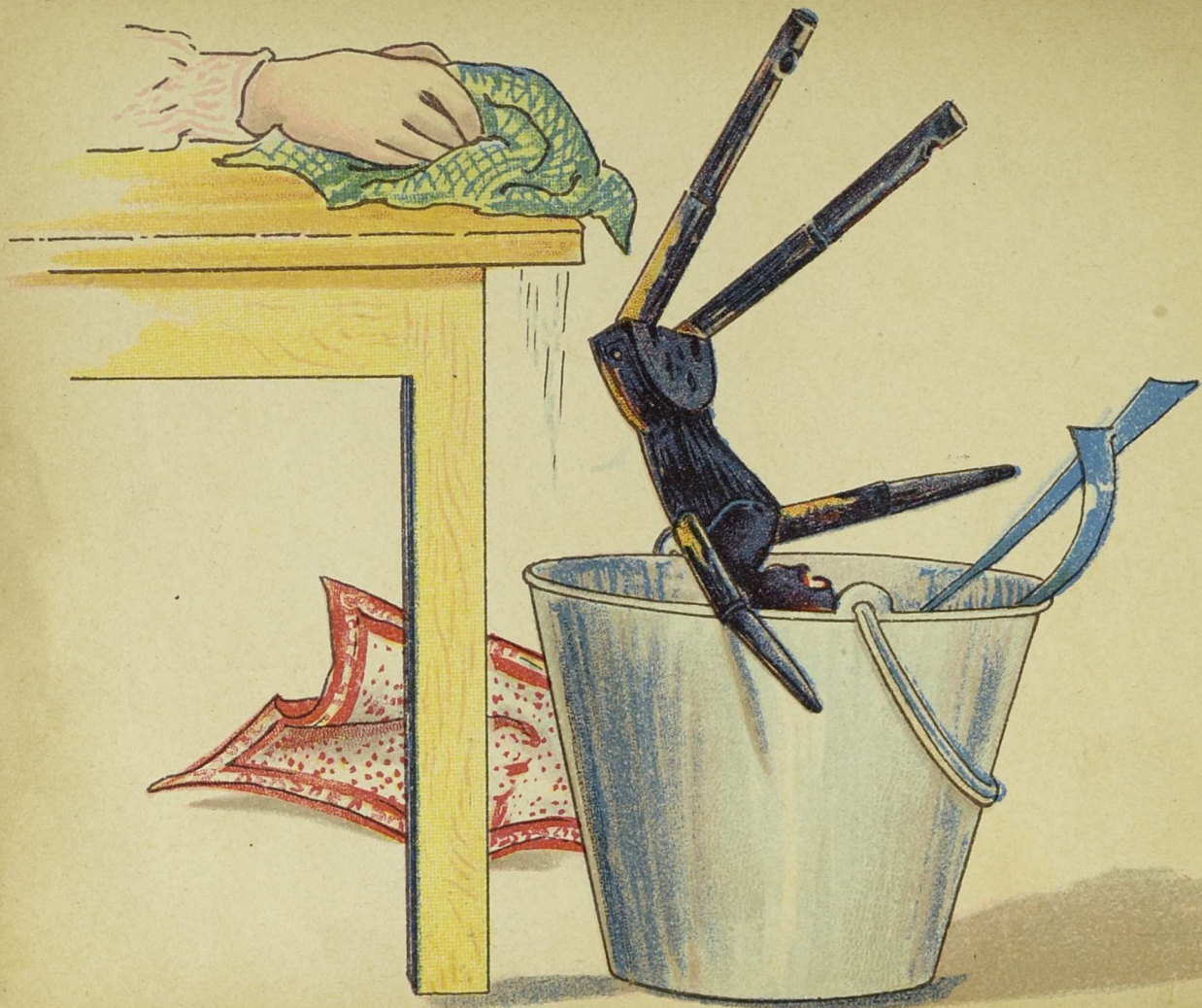


With a ribbon for my hair;

"O, what a mess!!!

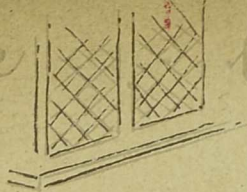
you horrid little thing,

Oh! my poor face!

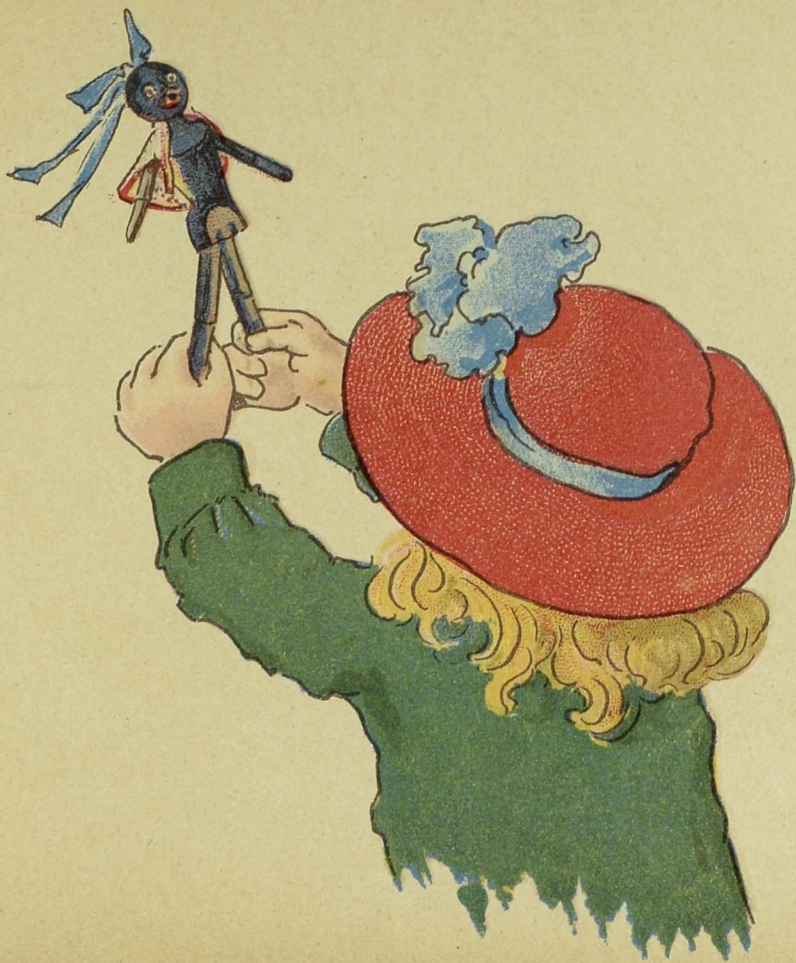




and there Baby picked

then."

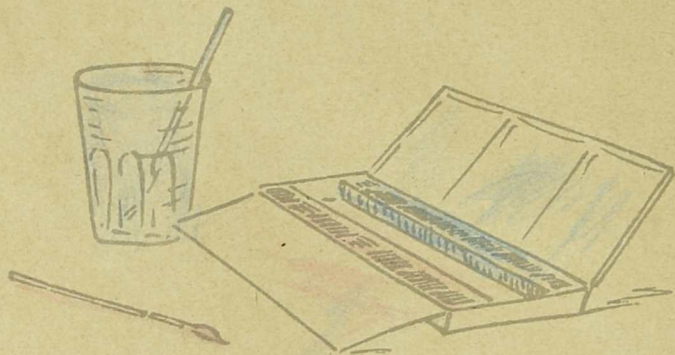

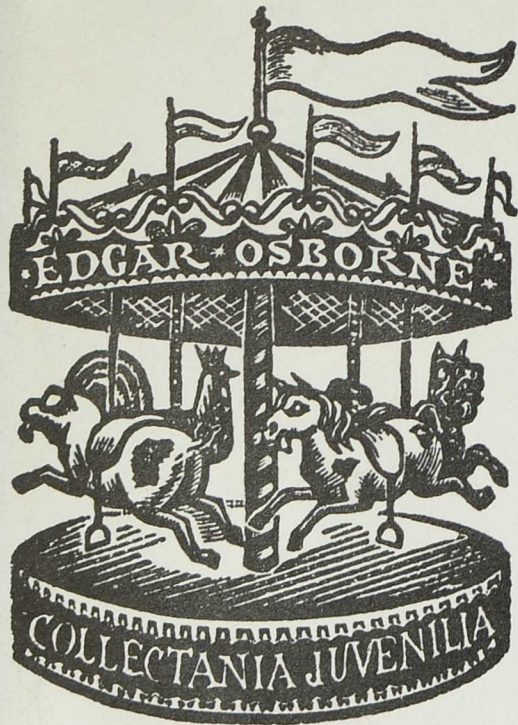
