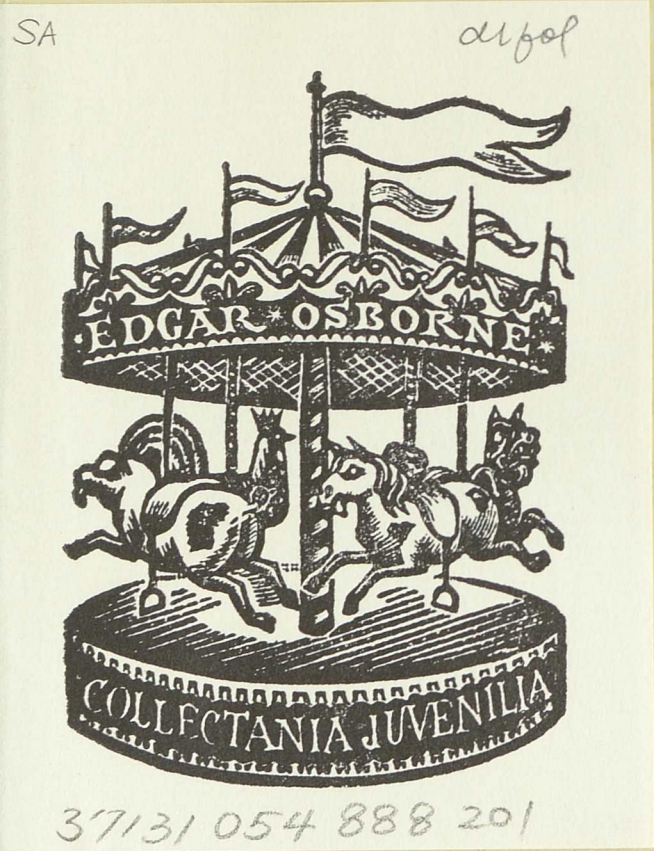
Mrs. Judy shows the Baby to

Punch plays with the Baby ; but it grows troublesome ; he throws it out of the window and it is killed.





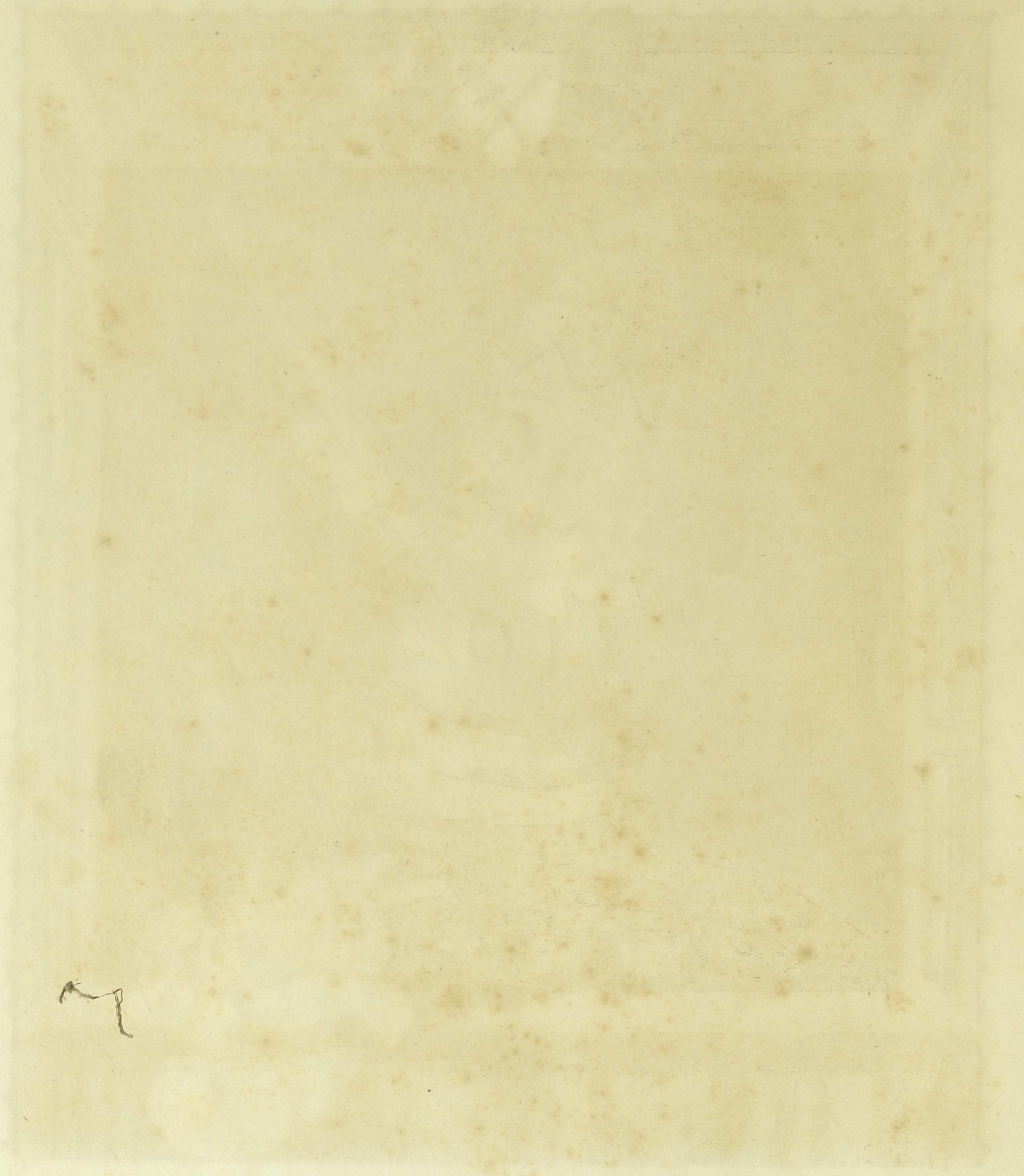
PUNCH AND JUDY.
