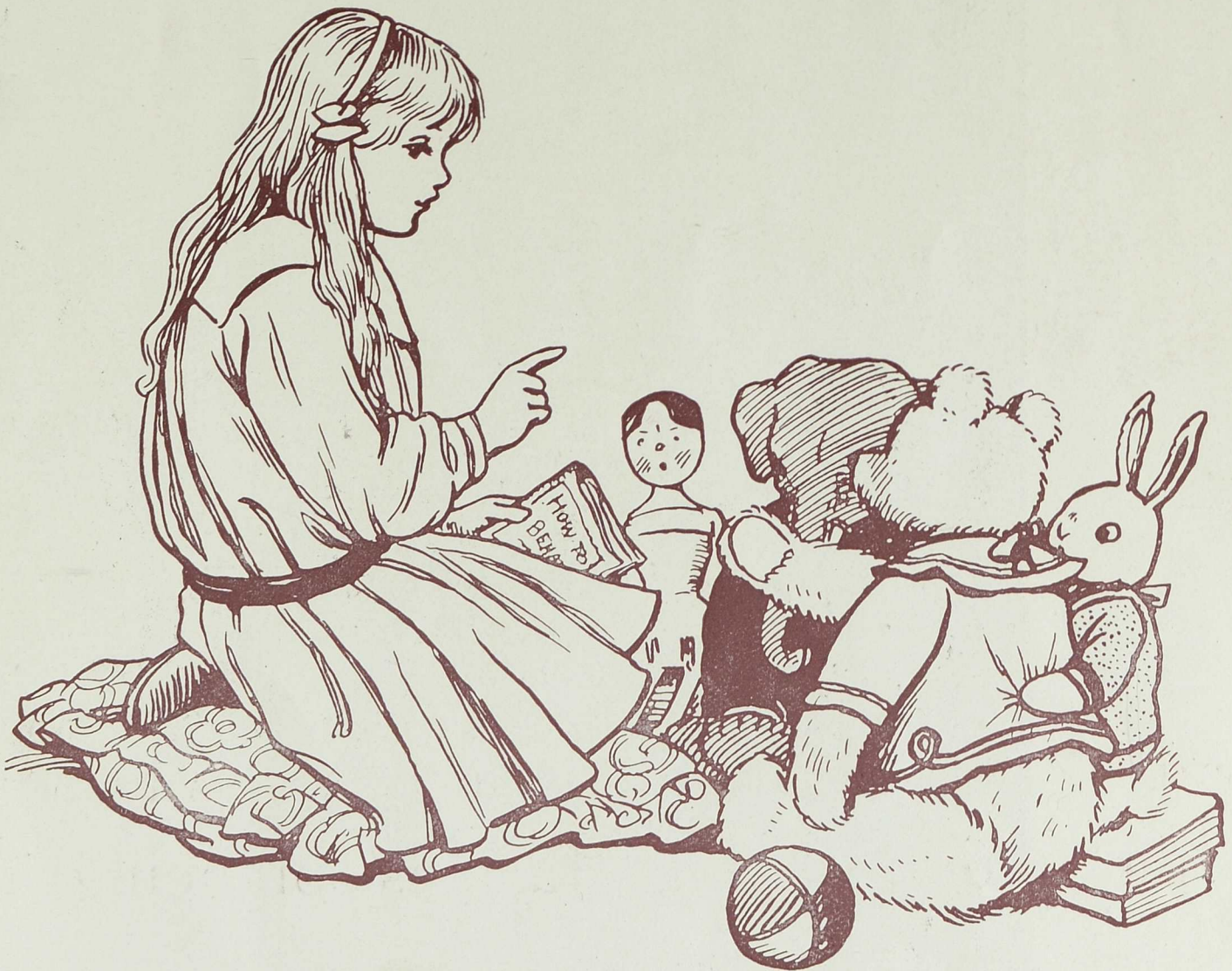
BABY is clapping his hands with joy,

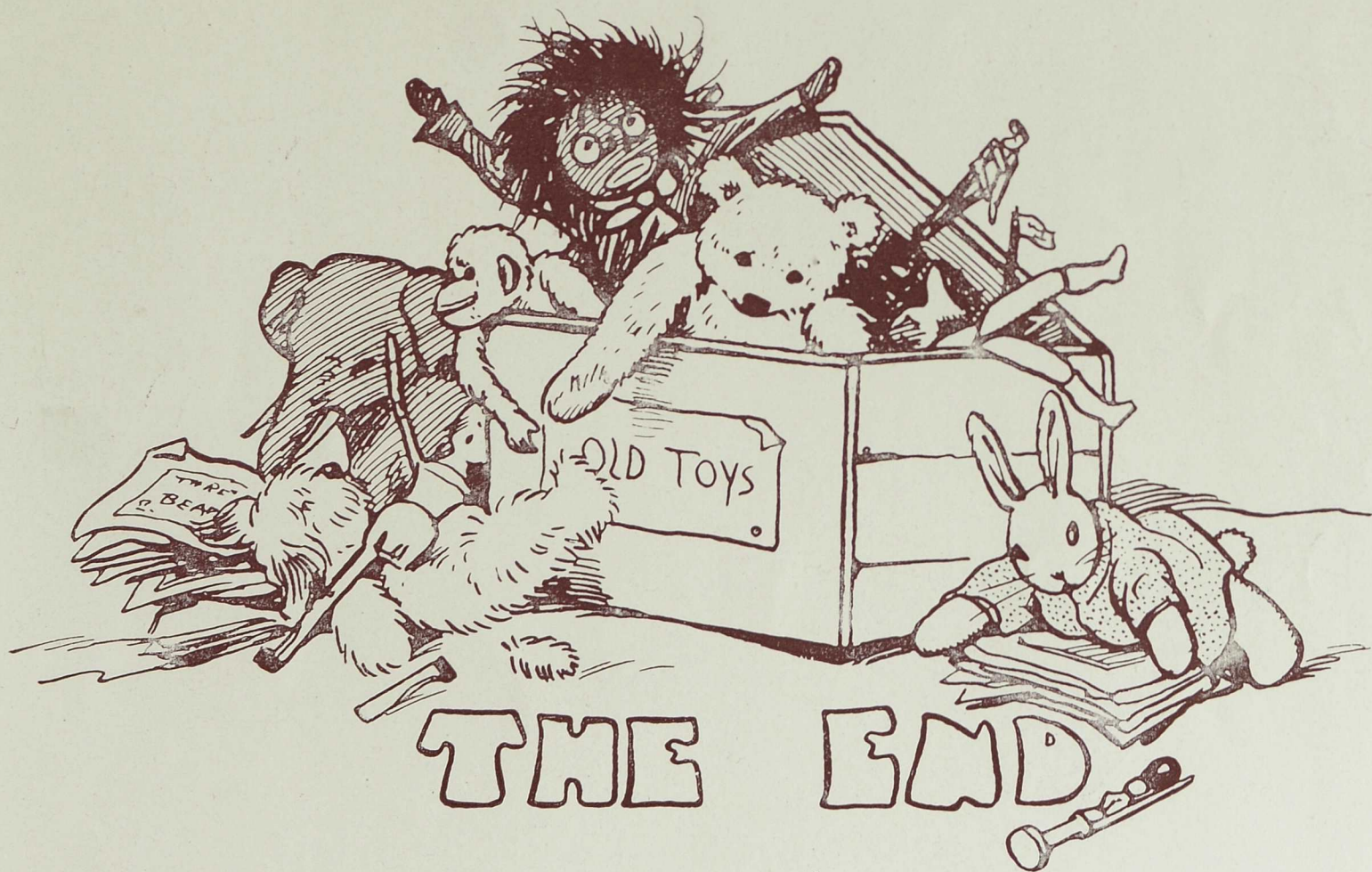


Sulky One.
