




FINGAL'S CAVE, at STAFFA, in SCOTLAND

This wonder great of Staffa's Isle To view is worth the travellers toil It still retains brave Fingal's name An ancient outlaw of great fame.










The Bell rock is on Scotlands coast

From rocks and sands the ships to save.




Natures great works oft give surprise

As any in the european land.











This heathen God of Appenine

A guide to seamen in the night.








In Iceland rises boiling springs
