


Twenty Pence are One and Eight pence;— Twenty-four make Shillings Two.

Just the sum that dittle: William as a faid fourspade, and hoe, and roke.




Thirty-Six Pence make Three Shillings;—

That was kind: so uncle said.




Eighty Pence are Six and Eight-pence;—
