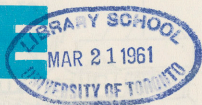

FROM 6001 HOMES IN LEASIDE

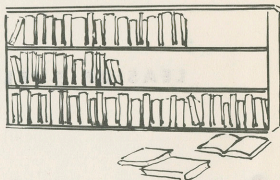


10,061 PEOPLE USE THE PUBLIC LIBRARY—

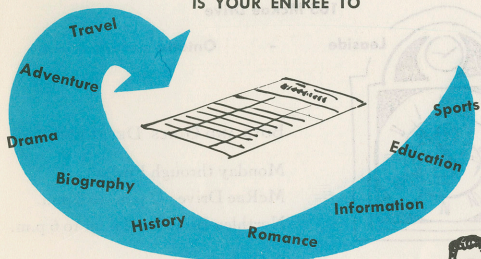

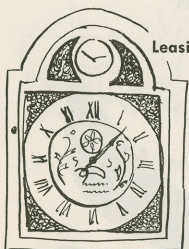
