#### YOUR FREE LIBRARY CARD

If you live, work or study in Metro Toronto your library card can be used at all public libraries.

#### LIBRARIES ARE FOR YOU -

Use them to the fullest. You can borrow:

- BOOKS
- FILMS
- MAGAZINES
- PROJECTORS
- RECORDINGS
- SCREENS
- CASSETTES
- FRAMED PICTURES.

You can have most material for three weeks.

Any reasonable amount of material may be borrowed for this period.

Material can be reserved free of charge.

#### TELETYPE NETWORK

A teletype service speeds up interlibrary loans and information exchange across Metro. A daily interlibrary delivery allows all branches to draw on the resources of the entire network to fill specific requests.

#### MULTILINGUAL RESOURCES

Books in 26 different languages are available. Films, recordings, cassettes, directories, magazines, and newspapers in many languages can also be borrowed. Members of the library staff are fluent in eleven different languages. The largest multilingual collections are at the Cedarbrae and Albert Campbell District Libraries.

#### SHUT-IN SERVICES

Designed for those unable to come to the library. Books (including large print and "talking" books), recordings, cassettes and framed pictures are brought to your residence once a month free of charge. Telephone the Bookmobile Department (291–1991, Ext. 42 or 47) anytime between 9 a.m. and 4:45 p.m.

#### BOOKMOBILE SERVICES

Two bookmobiles bring library service to new areas and to neighbourhoods some distance from a library. BOOKMOBILE SCHEDULES are available at your nearest branch or telephone the Bookmobile Department (291–1991).

#### FILMS AND PROJECTORS

Films of interest to adults and children can be borrowed free of charge from an extensive collection at the Albert Campbell District Library.

A catalogue of 16 mm films can be consulted at all branches.

Equipment service charge:

16 mm sound projector and screen - \$3.00 per booking period Screen only - \$1.00 per booking period

#### PROJECTIONIST TRAINING

or


\$2.00 for multiple children's items \$5.00 for multiple adult items
