"WHY FISH BITE"

One of the most interesting topics that every follower of Isaac Waltonhas no doubt spent much time thinking about is—"WHY FISH BITE."

If we know WHY, then we are in a position to get them to bite.

This narrative involves what might be termed the first thrill to the angler. The second is when the fish actually bite, and third, when the prize is captured.

I think we will all agree that the first thought is to feed the fish. This is logically true, but not always, as it has been proven that one angler might have all the tempting foods that fish feed on and yet get no results, while his neighbor fishing right along side of him is catching the fish.

Now comes the secret: All game fish are pugnacious, consequently they will attack and give battle to any foreign looking object in the water. This accounts for the success of what appear to be "silly-looking" Baits, but it is well to remember that fish can be tempted to bite or strike at artificial Baits when they will not even take notice of any kind of food. So it is that the persistent angler who continues to try different Baits from his kit will eventually be rewarded with a catch. These facts apply to Bass, Pickerel and Lunge.

The Trout is more of a feeder. It looks for the little titbits of flies and insects and will feed on these at certain hours every day, not by the clock but by climatic conditions, which bring about a hatch of fresh flies. These flies are sometimes driven down on the surface of the water by a gust of wind, causing a ripple on the water. All Trout anglers fish the ripple, and will often say it is because the lure is not as distinguishable to the Trout when a ripple is on the water that they make a catch. This may be partially so, but not so much as the fact that Trout will lie and watch the ripple because they know that this is the spot where their friend the Wind will send along their food.

But Trout are also lured by combination of colored flies that do not resemble any kind of known insects. The lures cause certain reflections of color that attract the Trout and they will strike at them in play.

Salmon or Lake Trout are simply feeders. All lures used for them are made to resemble some kind of a Minnow. The most successful are the wabbling type that resemble an injured Minnow. The Salmon will go after it more readily as they know that an injured Minnow is easier to catch.

The Atlantic Salmon strike all manner of flies of gorgeous colors, not for feed, however, as when opening Salmon caught in fresh water we never find any food in them, they simply kill the fly and spit it out—unless it has a hook attached, then they start the battle.

We urge all anglers to do everything possible to increase the number of fish in our fishing waters. If there are 5,000 over-the-limit bass in a lake, your chances of getting fish are five times better than if there are only 1,000.

The average fisherman with rod and line does not get enough fish when he goes fishing and more of an effort should be made to increase his catch than to keep him from catching more fish.

In the first place, the breeding should be protected. Fish should be allowed to breed before being taken. Natural breeding ground should be maintained and not allowed to be spoiled by drainage or pollution. The enemies of game fish should be kept down and all waters restocked as often as possible. Of course, you should join a protective association, put back the small fish and discourage all illegal fishing. YOU GET PLEASURE, RECREATION AND HEALTH from fishing; IT'S WORTH WORKING FOR BETTER FISHING.

True sporting instinct will not allow an angler to take undersized fish or to kill needlessly. To release a fish after booking, be sure and wet your hand before handling, remove hook as carefully as possible and slip the little chap gently back into the water. He may grow into a big fellow and give you some real thrills another day.

There is much difference of opinion as to whether fish have a sense of hearing. We do know, however, they are sensitive to the slightest vibration, scattering immediately if you stamp your feet in the bottom of a boat or on the bank of a narrow stream, or if you wade about with a big splash—move about quietly.

BAIT CASTING

The knack of casting an artificial lure with a short rod and multiplying reel is only acquired by practice. It is neither as simple as it looks—nor as difficult as some people say. There are no hard and fast rules so that bait casting is likely to be an individual method.

Bait casting differs radically from fly casting, and has been compared in principle to throwing an apple from the end of a stick. The main object is to place the bait where the fish are supposed to be. This calls for accuracy and distance, but accuracy is first.

To cast, take your position facing the point where you want to place the bait, draw out a few inches of line, grasp the rod firmly with the reel on top but slightly inclined to the left, with the ball of the thumb pressed firmly on the spooled line. Raise the rod slowly, just fast enough to keep the bait extended—carrying it back over

the shoulder until it reaches a position between 45 degrees and the horizontal-45 degrees is 2

Bring the rod forward slowly at the beginning of the cast and gradually but quickly accelerate the speed until it reaches an angle of 45 degrees forward. During the forward motion, the arm should be so closely held to the side that a newspaper can be held against the body by the elbow.

Also, during the cast, the thumb should be held against the spooled line tightly, until the forward cast is begun; then loosely, with just enough pressure to keep the reel spool from running ahead of the line which is running out; then just before the bait strikes the water, press tightly enough to instantly stop the reel. Then with a slight jerk, to start the bait moving, the



rod is transferred to the left hand, with the butt resting against the body, and the right hand is free for reeling in the line.

Figure 1 shows the back position just as the forward cast is being started; Figure 2 the position at the end of the cast; Figure 3

shows the proper position of hand and reel during the cast.

In practicing casting the beginner should strive first for accuracy and when able to place the bait with accuracy at 30 or 40 feet, should gradually add distance but only as fast as it can be done with accuracy.

As in any other sport, "form" is important. Graceful motion, good form means efficiency and less fatigue.

CASTING A FLY

There are two distinct varieties of cast, and two only. First, the cast commonly known as the overhead, which consists of two distinct efforts of casting, backwards and forwards. Second, what is known as the switch cast, which consists of a steady lift of the rod, free from any jerk, followed by a true cast forward. Of this latter there are such variations as the Spey and double switch, but they are merely amplifications of the switch to meet certain contingencies. Now the overhead and switch cast have certain points in common; indeed, except for the timing, they are practically identical. The following principles should be read, marked, learnt and inwardly digested:—

1. The hold of the rod should be with the fingers as far as possible and not in the palm of the hand. Thumb always at the back of the rod.

2. The grip should be easy, as it is in holding a cricket ball or stone in the act of throwing.

3. The actual course of the rod should be confined to a quarter circle in the back cast or lift, and also in the forward cast.

4. The course of the rod should always be in a plane backwards and forwards, though the forward cast may be in a separate plane to the back cast or lift.

5. Whatever the conditions avoid effort and try to realize that the cast which is most effective in a dead calm is also the most effective when contending with a wind, because the resistance of the air is the main obstacle, and it is merely a question of degree.

6. Considering the horizontal position of the rod to be the normal one when fishing, and the rod in that position to be pointing to IX o'clock, then in the vertical position the rod points to XII. Thus from IX to XII represents the course of the rod top through the quarter circle. On reaching XII o'clock, however, the rod may be carried back as far as is necessary and convenient in lifting a long line, but it must in this case never be allowed to fall towards I o'clock, or below a line passing through XII o'clock parallel with the ground. It may be raised but never lowerd behind the caster.

7. The pause at the top of the back cast is equal in length to the time taken to cast the line back.

8. The main cast or speed in casting both forwards and backwards takes place between halfpast X and XII o'clock, but the entire cast forwards and backwards should be perfectly smooth throughout, and entirely free from jerk or effort.

9. The cast should always be made from the top or back position and forward, not down.

10. While the line is extending behind, the rod must be allowed to remain steady and not brought forward in the slightest degree. Failure to observe this rule is one of the commonest faults, and in every case the result is shown, in that the line does not straighten out on the water.

11. If No. 6 hint be read again and compared with usual practice, it will be noticed that the line when cast forward straightens out at right angles to the position the rod is in at the commencement of the cast. If this rule be observed and the rod point not lowered behind, the actual cast forward will occur between XII o'clock, or the vertical position and about 10.30. The rod is allowed to follow through to the horizontal position as the line travels forward, until, if the performance has been correct, when the rod is in the horizontal position, it and the line are in one straight line.

12. The cast should always be made forward, not down. Our object is to overcome the resistance of the air and to do this not by the application of force but rather reason. We know that a needle is sharp at the point, also that except for special purposes it is straight, therefore, we require that the entry or forward curve of the line shall be narrow, and that the line following

shall be straight. The cut forward which I advocate means that the tip of the rod travels almost straight during this cut and results in a narrow entry or curve. If, as is usually done, the drive is made downwards we obtain a wide curve or entry, and when casting against a wind it is a question of whether we can apply sufficient force, or in other words whether we or the wind is the stronger.

Also this drive forward ensures that the tip of the rod is used as it should be. To obtain a straight following line it is necessary that the line be fully extended behind in the preliminary back cast, and that the forward cast does not commence with a jerk or kick off. It must be short and quick but absolutely smooth.

13 In practising the switch cast, as I have remarked before, the rod is lifted steadily. This does not mean vertically lifted. Indeed, it should be brought back steadily over the water, raising the point all the time but no more than is required by the length of the line out. As long as the tendency is upward, and the point of the rod never allowed to drop behind, it does not matter how slight this upward tendency is. The general instructions for making the cast after the lift is "thrash down". Avoid this, however, like the plague. Always make your cast forward, not down. By this means shooting the line may be accomplished, which is a thing impossible with a thrash down.

Wrist action or no wrist action? That is the question often asked. Excessive use of the wrist may be condemned at once, as also may a rigid wrist. The joint that should be called into use above all others is the shoulder joint and not only that but the shoulder blade actually plays over the back. This allows the rod top to make the cast almost in a straight line horizontally forward. If the wrist alone is used it is impossible to avoid a circular course taken by the rod point. If the wrist is held rigid delicacy is impossible and in this case the elbow joint is the only one used, making again for a circular course of the rod top. Moreover, it causes a tight grip of the rod. Close your fist tight and you will find that every muscle and joint throughout the body is rigid. This quite bars out easy and graceful action, which is called for in casting a fly as much as in any other game. No! Let every joint and muscle in the body be easy and free all the time.

Keep a can of oil and a pair of pliers with wire cutting device in your tackle box. You will be surprised how useful they are.

ANGLER'S KNOT. The "Turle Knot" Attachment for Eyed Trout Flies.



Pass the end of gut through the eye of hook, then make a running noose or slip-knot as Figure A, then draw the knot tight and pass the loop over the hook and wings of fly as Figure B. Then draw the loop tight around head of fly as Figure C, cut off the spare end of gut, and knot is complete.





PROPER CARE OF A REEL.


A good Reel is always a pleasure—to successful bait casting it is essential —Take good care of it. Keep it clean. It should be cleaned after every fishing trip. Be especially careful to prevent sand and grit getting inside the reel. Keep an oiled cloth in your tackle box.

After taking reel apart for cleaning and oiling be careful to put it together again properly, otherwise you may grind or break some important part and render the reel useless.

Do not cast with the click on—It is not intended for that purpose. The click is simply there to announce a strike when trolling and it also serves to prevent your line from running out when you don't want to give it play.

THE CARE OF RODS.

It is important after a day's fishing that the rod should be taken to pieces, carefully cleaned and placed with its case; not left outside against a wall or tree, (as is generally done in every camp) for the damp atmosphere and rain to act upon its timber and ferrules. A rod carefully used will last a lifetime, whereas, if its owner is careless, it will get out of condition, become warped, and eventually lose its suppleness and power. As a last word of advice, never put a rod in a damp bag.

PUTTING RODS AWAY FOR THE WINTER.

After the season's fishing is over, look over your rods. If the ferrules need to be tightened, wood needs varnishing, etc., do it or send them to us at once and next Spring your rods will be ready. Put your rods in a room where there is no heat, (steam heated rooms will loosen all the ferrules) and hang up the joints separately by short pieces of wire or strings, which have been tied to the smaller ends of the joints. If some of the joints have become warped, tie a small weight at the bottom of the joints and you will find when you put your rod together next Spring that it is perfectly straight.
