CONTRACT WITH A DRIVATE DIVERGIAN



NOTE—Accounts arising under this Contract will be paid by the Treasury Department only. They must be sent in duplicate to the Surgeon General, with the cortificate of the Commanding Officer and Medical Director, that the services have been satisfactorily performed, and the surgical instruments furnished as required, and stating whether the services were rendered at a station or in the field.

Upon this certificate the account will be passed in this office, and a Treasury warrant, payable by any disbursing Medical Officer, be sent to the physician entitled to receive it.

A duplicate of the Contract must invariably be sent to the Surgeon General when the Contract is entered into, or the account will not be paid.

When instruments are furnished by the United States, the fact will be stated.
