PREFATORY NOTE.

So great has been the demand for a superior class of prize books during the last year or two, that this Catalogue has been prepared chiefly with a view to bring before the School Trustees and others, the names of such new books as have been added to the Prize list since the last Catalogue was published. The list on pages 4-6 of the Catalogue has been provided to meet a special want which has been felt in our best Grammar and Common Schools, and which has frequently been brought under the notice of the Department. In order to facilitate the prompt despatch of prizes, and to economise time in the Depository, a series of assorted packages of prize books suited to various classes in a School has been carefully selected in the Department. The list, with the price of each package, will be found on page 4. Where parties prefer it, and to aid them in the selection of prize books for Grammar and Common Schools, the book adapted to each kind of School has been distinguished by the asterisks, (*) (**) prefixed to the title of each book. The rule adopted in regard to these books will be strictly followed.

A selection of books will always be made when the local

School authorities desire it, subject to their approval.

PUBLIC LIBRARY BOOKS, SCHOOL MAPS, APPARATUS, AND PRIZE BOOKS.

The Chief Superintendent will add one hundred per cent. to any sum or sums, not less than five dollars, transmitted to the Department by Municipal and School Corporations, on behalf of Grammar and Common Schools; and forward Public Library Books, Prize Books, Maps, Apparatus, Charts, and Diagrams, to the value of the amount thus augmented, upon receiving a list of the articles required. In all cases it will be necessary for any person acting on behalf of the Municipal or Trustee Corporation, to enclose or present a written authority to do so, verified by the corporate seal of the Corporation. A selection of Maps, Apparatus, Library and Prize Books, &c., to be sent, can always be made by the Department, when so desired.
