

## ROYAI BLUE ORDER.

In this. (as in the other Degrees,) no business donnected with the afficir of the Orrler can be transacted, weept in open Ladge, and guarded by a Tyler; and not los than Five Members hall be comsidered a quornm.

There shall be 'Two 'Tyrus in this Order-one, mbose por shall bo nut-ike. and the other inside the Lodge Room done.

The duty of the [msint Tyler shall be to put the Test mall who. (after having previously given the Annual to the Outsidn Tyler.) ©nter the rom after the Lodge is opened.

The Tylers shall in all cave be examined by the Minster, to sce if thy are properly qualified to receive or rejet those applying for udmission.

The Master and Brethren being assembled, and havinf tainen their satis; and the Tylers duly placed, the

Test, (which shall be the proper division of the Entrance Pasword) shall be put to them, beginning by the Secretary; on the right, and the Treasurer on the left hand, cuch Brother pasing the Test till it reaches the last Brother on each side; when both shall give their proof to the Deputy Master, who shall rise and say to the Master, "Worshipful,-all present are true brethren of the Order."

The Brethren then shall, at a call from the Master, all ri-e, and cach with his right hand and left arm in the proper position, stand [strictly silent,] while the Chaplain, Master, or Brother appointed, proceeds to open. the Lodee, by reading the following portions of Scripture :
"I shall see Him, but not now. I shall behold Him, bat not nigh; there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a secritre shall rise out of Isreal, and shall smite the cmers of Moab, and destroy all the children of Gath.Num. c. xxiv. v. 17.

And the Lord spake unto Moscs, say ying: Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make frinwes in the borders of their garments, throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borter a Ribbond of Blue. That ye may remember and do all My commandments, and lie holy unto sour God. I an the Lord your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt to be your God; I am the Lord your ciod.

Then shall the Chaplain, Master, or Brother appointed, reat the following Prager:
O, Alvigiry and Everlasting God! who art $: \therefore$ strength of all them who put their trust in Thee, withos.s whom nothing is strong, nothing is holy, look upon :I. hearty desires of Thy humble servants, and stretchenth the right hand of Thy Majesty, to te our defence as: :all our encmics. Enable ths to lowi and serve Then : we ought. Remder worthy to inherit the rest prepad for all them that fear and love Thee. Teach us to wo.. and prepare for the coming of the day of judgment, in that we may worthily enter into Thy kinglom, as a ... s of Glory in the House of Israel. Giant these and :] ,ther mercies which Thou secst we stand in need $0^{2}$ : in the sake of Thy doar Son, our Kavigur, Jews (hro ?Amen.

Ths Jaster shall thea sty:
I now dechare this Royal Blue Lodge opened i: $:=$ form, strictly prohibiting any langriage or conduct ihat may tend to disturb the harmony of the Brethren.

The Members then resume their seats, and the busiee:
the Lodge shall proceed in the following order:
The Lecture to be repeated.
Minutes of former Mecting reed.
Nenbers to bo Initiated.

Members to be proposed, and previous Proposals to be considered.

Public Business connected with the principles, honour or prosperity of the Institution discussed.

Lecture repeated.
Dues collected.
Lodge closed with Prayer.

## RITUAL OF INTRODUCTION.

The preparation of the Candidate is to take place in the Ante-Ronm, as follows:-He is to be stripped of his cuat and vest, and his left arm barred to the shoulder, and a Blue Ribband tied round that elbow. All being ready, the Candidate shall be led to the Lodge Room door, when a sudiden alarm shall be made by the Spousers, and they shall knock.
Master.-What alarm is there; what strangers are at our gates?

Tylers-
(Opening the door and communicating with those witbout,) then asks:
-What strangers are there?
Aponsors-Travellers from the East.
rejers-
Repeats this anacuncement to the Master.

Master.-If they have their guides and sureties, let them enter.

The door is theu opened, and the Candidates, (having the Bible in his baud,) shall be introduced between his two Sponsors, each bearing in his hand an Orange Rod, decorated with a Blue Ribband, and one, carrying, also, the Blue Book of the Lodge, with the Obligation thereon and open, and the other an inkstand; ho shall then be conducted to the side of the room, and then East, tuwards the Deputy Master, before whom shall be burning one bright hght; and before the Master there shall be placed Eleven caudles, in a semi-circle, and also onr: candle placed in the centre of the circle. The eleren candles are not to be lighted until the Candidate has reached the Deputy Master ; the one in the centre is not. to be lighted.
The Chaplain, or Master, shall then proceed, as follows:
"Now, when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judna. in the days of Herod the King, behold there came win. men from the East to Jerusalem, saying, where is be that is born King of the Jews; for we have secn hix Star in the East, and are come to worship him. And lo! the Star which they saw in the East went befor: them, till it came and stood over where the young child was. When they saw the Star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy, and when they were come into the house, they saw the young child, and fell down and worshipped him; and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts: gold and frank incense
and myrrl." -Matt. c. ii., $\mathrm{V}^{\prime} .1,5,9,10,11$. Here the Candidate pays bis Initiation fee.
The Candidate shall then subscribe his name in the Lodse Book, the Deputy Master saying to him-
Thou hast inseribed thy name amongst the faithful, $\because$ and prove thy faith still farther.
The Candidate shall then be led to the left side of the Master.
Wester.-What carry ye in your hand?
sumars.-Emblems of the mysteries about to be commanicated to this our friend.

Mastur.-Do you beliere that he has strintly conformed to the Rules aud Regulations of the Orters he has heretofre received in our denciation?

Answer.-Wc do.
Bister-(Aderesine the Candidite,)-Is it your desire and humble petition to be alvanced to the desme of Loyal Blue?

C:andilate.-It is.
Master.-Friend, kneel down.
The ('audidate knects, (his hands on the Bible,) the Chal. lain, or Master, shall say:-
-Let us Praj.
All baceling:
O. Lord Gol, Judge of the World, who hath commanded that creation should come forth to judgment. we cotreat Thee to wrut us life, grace and pardon.-


Thou, 0 Lord, holdest forth the lamp of righteousnes. for good to mankind, and to Thy honor and glory nattions are made righteous. Thou incribest our wond deeds in the Book of Life, and Thy mercy is shown forth in our lives. As the morniney star bringeth joy to the awakening world, so Thou, O Lord, by thy Son, our Reduomer, awakened in the souls of thy servants joy and everlasting life-Amen.
Here the Obligation shall be administered by the Master.

## ROYAL BLLE OBLEATEN.

I, $A$. $B$., do shemaly and woutarily swear. that I will never disclose, either in whole or in part, the sime, mysteries, or sjmbols, of the Order of the Royal Blue, except I shall be duly authorized to commumicate them by the proper authorities of this Institution. So help me God.

Here invest the Candidte with the Emblems.
The Candidate shall then rise up, and the Chaplain, or Mat. ter stall read-
O, give thanks unto the Lord, fir he is srod, for His mercy endureth for ever. Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy; and gather them out "f the lands from the Eist and from the West, from the North and from the routh. -Psalm 107.

I was glad when they said to me, let us go into the house of the Lord. Our feet shall stand within thy gates, 0 Jerusalem. Jerusalem is builded as a city that is compact together.-Psalm 122.

Behold, bless ye the Lord, all ye servants of the Lord, which by night stand in the house of the Lord. Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, and bless ye the Lord. The Lord, that made Heaven and Earth, bless thee out of Zion.-Psalm 124.

The Signs, Passwords, and Mysteries of the Order shall then he communicated to the new Blue Brother, after which the Master shall deliver the following charge:
Bhother,
I congratulate you upon your admission to this Order, because it calls upon you for the exercise of greater activity and a nobler zeal. It is to prove to you a beacon of hight; to keep your passions and prejudices under proper subjection.

The bearing of the Order is to bring your mind to the consideration of eternity. It is to prove to you by the Star in the East, the course of which was arrested over Bethlehem, how small beginnings can, by the decree of an all wise Providence, have great and glorious terminations. It is to teach you the duty of being satisfied with your lot, when you remember your Saviour's nativity, and his high destination. Reflect that, however, humble your lot, however ungolished your habits. by a
constant life of virtue and faith, by industrion and zcelous habits, you may arrive at as near a state of pertu:tion as sinful man can expect to attain.

It now becomes your duty, narrowly t:- wath jeur Prethren. You me mildly to correct their erems, and t., remonstrate with them upon their approach to and evil action, and thus prove to them the worth and valis. of your exalted station. You must, at all times, exes: yourself to keep our ghorious Institution from ham, and not allow the procicts of the Star to be desectated. By your submission to your seniors, you vill cemvine yos inferiors of their duty to do likewise; and, althongh you are particularly to see the sufferings and wants uf you: Brethren relieved, yet, by the virtue of that brilliant guide, which you have assumed, you most feel that your benevolence sould be universal. Lostly, you are to obserre, with serupulous exactitude. the secrecy of the Degree just conferred; and you are to atwent yura from any Lodge which does not faithfully carry out in, principles we teach. By doins all of which, yua will prove that our confidence has not been misplaced.

The Choplain, or Brother appointed, shall say:
Moreover, te Lord spoke unto Ahaz, saying, ask tis: a sign of the Lord thy God, ask it either in the depth, or in the height above. But Ahaz said, I will not asiz neither will i tempt the Lord. And he said, hear, ye now, $O$ House of David, it is a small thing for you to weary men, but will you weary my God also? There-

fore the Lord himself shall give jou a sign; behold, a Virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call his name Immanuel.-Isaiah, c. vii., v. 10, 11, 12, 1:, 14.
fod be merciful unto us, and bless us, and cause IIs f:ce to shine upon ur. That Thy name may be known rpousarth. Jiet the people praise Thee. O, let the nations be glad and sing for joy; for Thou shalt judge the loople rightcousiy, and govern the mations upon earth. bet the people maise Thee, $O$ God: let all the people prise Thee. Then chall the earth yield her increase, and Giol, cren our nwn Goul shall bless us. God shall bless us, and all the ends of the earth chall fear him.-Psalia $5 \%$.
The Initiation Fee of this Order siall not be less than Three Shillings and Nure pence.
fu closing the Lodge, the Brethren shall stand in the same position as in opening the Lodge, while the Chaplain, Master o: Brother appointed, sha!l say the Lord's prayer.
Our Patier., which art in Heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy hingdom come. Thy will be done in bith as it is in Hoaren. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive them thi.t trecpass against us. And lead us not into tempta. tien; but deliver us from evil ; for Thine is the lime Tom, the power and the glory, for ever and cver.- Amen. The Laster shall then say:
I now declare this Royal Blue Lodge closed in due form.
