

When this war is over Canada will not have many favours for those who could have worn service uniform and did not.

That is the way of the world. But all bank managers and professors and manufacturers and physicians and merchants can not go overseas, and must be content to do what they can in money giving, and serving in home defence corps like St. Andrew's Rifles. The man who stays at home sitting in his armchair just as in peace time, who does not try to improve his physique or his shooting, is a much more sorry object than he who would wear kharki, and cannot.

SHOOTING
