To the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Yorkville.

The undersigned Auditors of the Corporation respectfully report that they have carefully audited all the books belonging to the Municipality relating to the financial affairs, for the year ending the 31st day of December, 1867, and have found them correct.

They have Audited the Accounts of the Board of School Trustees for the financial year, and have found them correct.

They have examined the Collector's Rolls from 1859 to 1866 inclusive, on which balances were due; also the Roll of 1867, and found the balances correctly stated.

They have also examined and Audited the Sinking Fund Accounts, and report that the same have been correctly kept.
