The Chancellor or Registrar having signed the required Declaration to be administered by the Lord Bishop as Dean,

Will move in Procession of choir and clergy to the West Front of the Cathedral over the flor of the nave through the West Door.

The Chancellor or Registrar will occupy stalls on the North or South side of the main aisle just inside the West door.

After the Processional Hymn,

The Bishop, his chaplain and other members of the Chapter will receive the Chancellor and Registrar at the West Door, and conduct him to his appointed stall in the choir —and setting him down in his stall he shall say—

Mr. Chancellor, or Mr. Registrar, you having signed the required Declaration, making you a member of our Cathedral Chapter, we now install thee into the stall assigned for thee in thy office as Chancellor or Registrar of this our Diocese, In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holv Ghost, Amen.

Then he shall add-

The Lord keep thy coming in, and thy going out from this time forth and forevermore. Amen.

Here the office of Evensong shall follow.
