The Secretary of State, in pursuance of a resolution of the House of Representatives, of the 19th ultimo, directing him to report to that House a copy of the maps and so much of the reports of the Commissioners under the Treaty of Ghent, for ascertaining the northern and northwestern boundary between the United States and Great Britain, as will exhibit those parts of said boundary which are already decided upon; has the honor to report the accompanying copies of a part of a series of maps, which have been communicated to this office, exhibiting surveys and delineations of so much of said boundary line as is believed to be required by the resolution of the House; and respectfully to refer the House to the decision, dated 18th June, 1822, of the Joint Commissioners under the 6th article of the said treaty, published at the end of the acts of the second Session of the Seventeenth Congress, in the seventh volume of the Laws of the United States, for a further and full explanation of the said boundary line, as agreed upon and established.
