The amounts of the stoppages for provisions issued on account of regiments, accounted for to Secretary at War, as regards the year 1835-36, and the sums paid over as the value of provisions, forage, and fuel, for the subsequent years, viz. 1836-37 to 1842-43, have been obtained by the Treasury from the Secretary at War; and the amount of stoppages paid into the Commissariat chest on the spot, together with the amount of regimental stoppages and value of supplies for regimental services (obtained from the War Office), have been deducted in the Abstract from the gross amount of supplies furnished to Canada in the year, whether by purchases on the spot, or shipments from England.
